TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Lindholm Høje Viking Burial Ground** — Scandinavia's best-preserved Viking burial site, just north of the city.
- **Old Town Walking Tour** — Stroll from Aalborghus Castle along the waterfront to Jens Bang's House (1624 Dutch Renaissance mansion), Budolfi...
- **Street Art & Waterfront Design Walk** — Aalborg is one of Scandinavia's street art capitals.
- **Kunsten Museum of Modern Art** — A striking building designed by Alvar Aalto houses one of Denmark's finest collections of 20th-century and contemporary...
- **Aquavit & Nordic Food Experience** — Aalborg gave its name to Denmark's most famous aquavit — Aalborg Akvavit was first distilled here in 1846 and the city...

BEST WALKS

- **Historic Core Walk** 2.5 km · 45–60 min · Easy — From the cruise berth, cross to Aalborghus Castle, then head inland past the Utzon Center to the pedestrian streets.
- **Waterfront & Street Art Loop** 3 km · 1 hr · Easy — Head east along the revitalized harbor, spotting murals on the warehouse walls.
