TOP THINGS TO DO

- **ARoS Art Museum & Rainbow Panorama** — Walk the circular rooftop 'Your Rainbow Panorama' by Olafur Eliasson — a 360° ring of colored glass over the city...
 - **Den Gamle By Open-Air Museum** — A 'living' town of 75 historic Danish buildings re-erected with costumed townsfolk — a charming walk through centuries...
- **Aarhus Latin Quarter & Cathedral** — The medieval lanes of cafés, boutiques, and the towering Aarhus Cathedral — Denmark's longest church — at the heart of...
 - **Moesgaard Museum & Coast** — The striking grass-roofed Moesgaard museum of prehistory (home to the Grauballe bog man), with forest and beach trails...

BEST WALKS

- **Cathedral & Latin Quarter** ~2 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — From the harbour to the soaring Aarhus Cathedral, then into the cobbled Latin Quarter's lanes of cafés, design shops, and the old...
- **ARoS & city hall** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — Up to the ARoS museum with its rainbow ring, past Arne Jacobsen's modernist City Hall with its clock tower.
- **Aarhus Å riverside & harbour** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — The reopened river running through the center, lined with bars and cafés, leading down to the modern Dokk1 waterfront library.

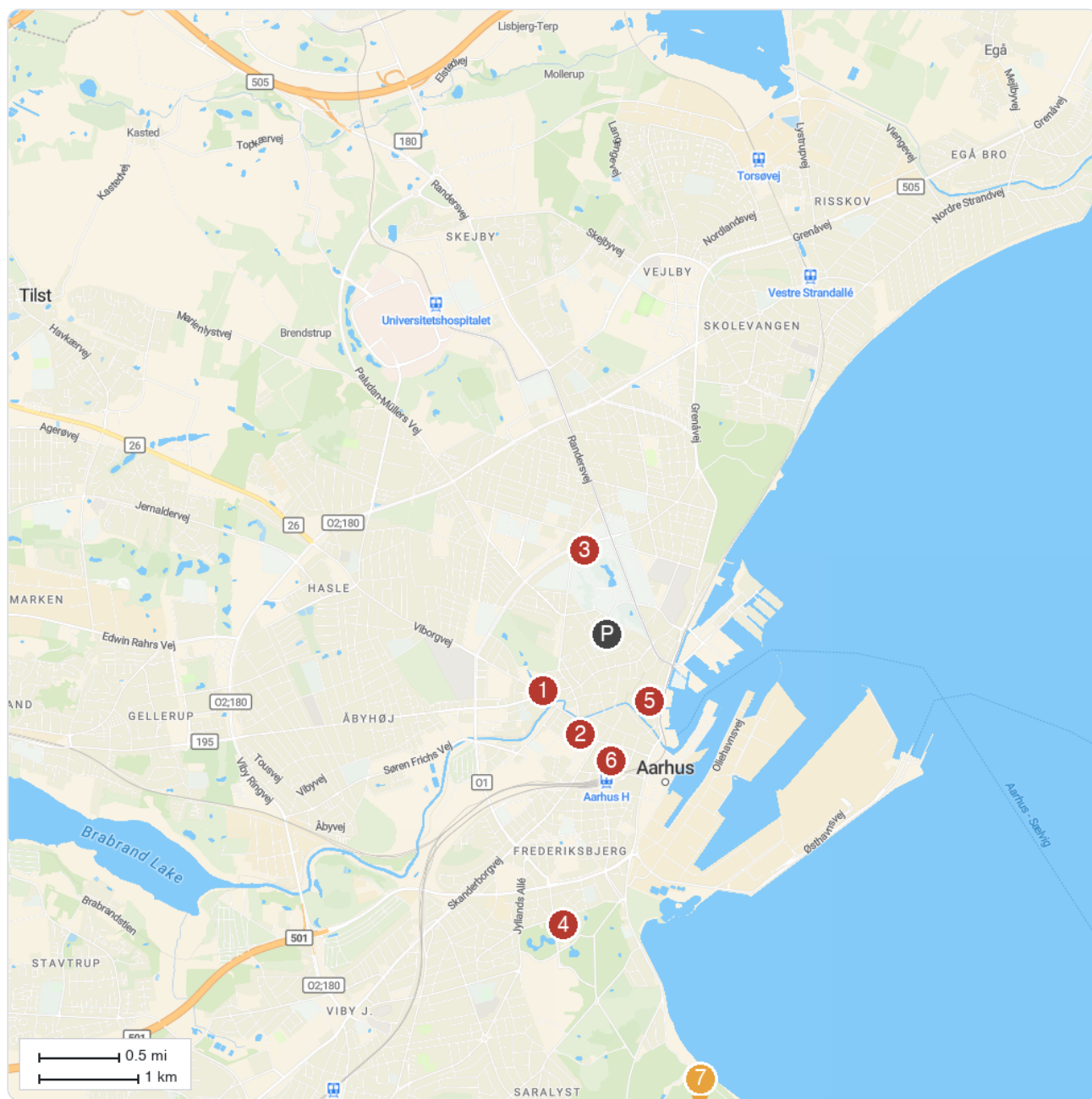
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
