GETTING ASHORE

Docking: All berths alongside — no tender. Larger ships use South Harbour (Balmoral Quay), ~3 km from centre; smaller ships dock at North Harbour, ~1.2 km walk.

Best For: Castle day-trips, Scotch whisky, Royal Deeside scenery, coastal walks

Walk to centre: 15-20 min from North Harbour; shuttle or taxi needed from South Harbour.

Don't Miss: Dunnottar Castle — one of Scotland's most dramatic clifftop ruins, 27 km south by car or tour.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Dunnottar Castle & Stonehaven** — A ruined fortress perched on a sheer 50 m sea cliff south of Aberdeen — one of Scotland's most photographed sites.
- **Royal Deeside & Balmoral Castle** — Drive west into the Cairngorms National Park to Balmoral, the Royal Family's Scottish summer retreat.
- **Aberdeen City Walk: Marischal College & Old Aberdeen** — Marischal College is one of the world's largest granite buildings — its elaborately carved façade is unmissable.
- **Scotch Whisky Distillery Visit** — Aberdeenshire sits on the edge of Speyside malt country.
- **Dolphin & Wildlife Spotting** — Aberdeen Harbour is one of the best land-based bottlenose dolphin viewing spots in Scotland, particularly April–July.

BEST WALKS

- **Union Street to Old Aberdeen** 3 km · 45-60 min one way · Easy — Walk the length of Union Street, Aberdeen's grand granite main street, then continue north through the university quarter to Old...
- **Footdee (Fittie) & Beach Promenade** 2 km · 30 min · Easy — From the North Harbour, walk east to Footdee — a charming 19th-century fishermen's village of brightly painted cottages tucked at the...

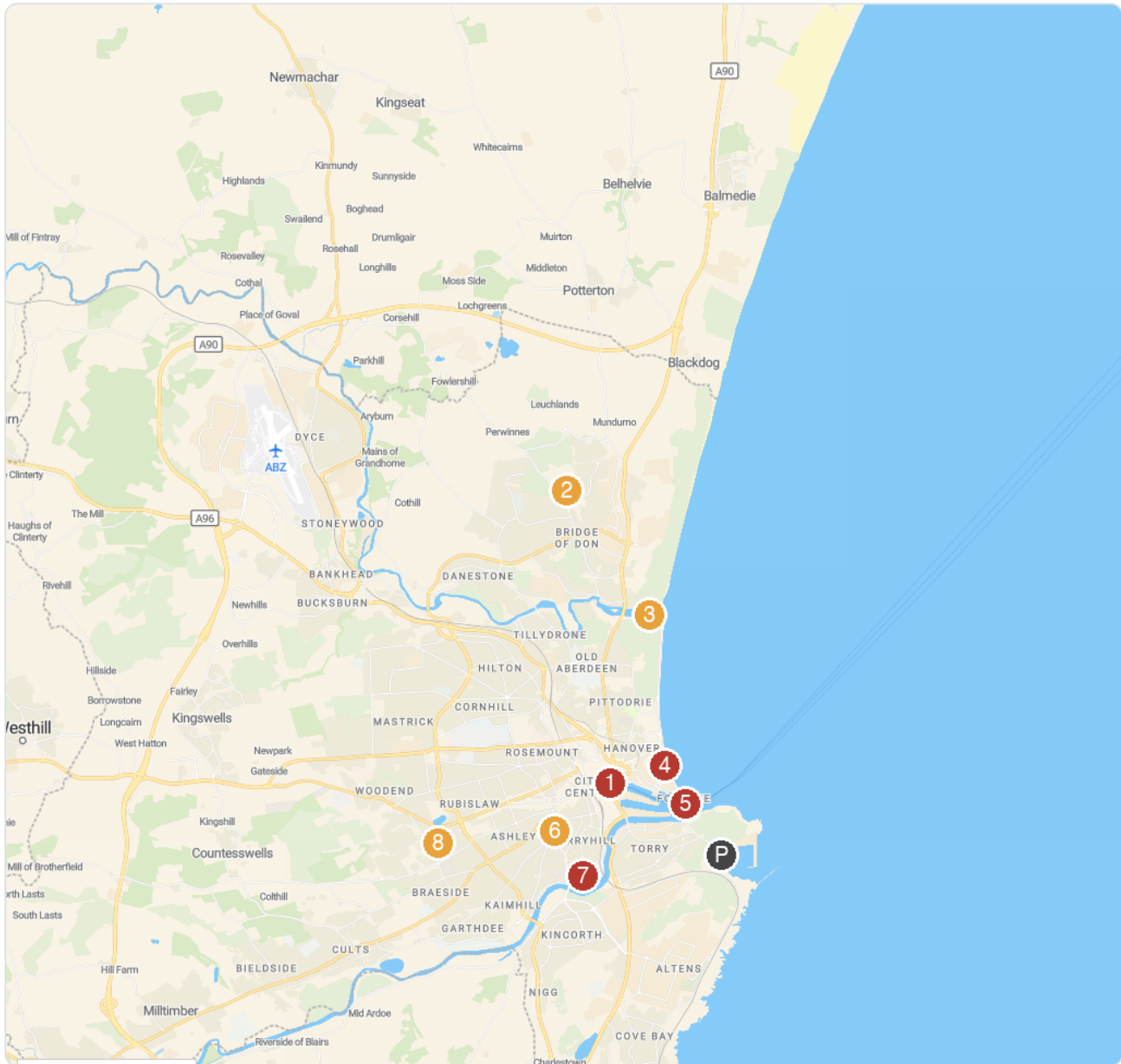
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
