GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships berth at Port of Abidjan quays in the Vridi Canal, Treichville district. No tendering.

Best For: Colonial history, West African market culture, urban nature, and cuisine.

Distance to Centre: Plateau (city centre) ~6 km by road; taxis and shuttles available at the port gate.

Don't Miss: Grand-Bassam UNESCO historic quarter — 45 min by road, essential for any call here.

- **Grand-Bassam UNESCO Colonial Town** — Côte d'Ivoire's first French colonial capital (1893–1896) is a 45-minute drive east.
- **Banco National Park** — An extraordinary pocket of equatorial primary rainforest entirely within the city limits.
- **Treichville Market & City Tour** — Plunge into the Grand Marché de Treichville — one of West Africa's great urban markets, piled high with textiles...
- **Ivorian Street Food & Maquis Lunch** — Côte d'Ivoire has one of West Africa's most celebrated food cultures.
- **Musée des Civilisations de Côte d'Ivoire** — The national civilisations museum in the Plateau district houses an impressive collection of Ivorian masks, traditional...

- **Plateau District Highlights Walk** 2 km · Easy · 45–60 min — Start at the Plateau waterfront on the Ébrié Lagoon, walk past the CEDEAO building and the modernist towers, then head to St.

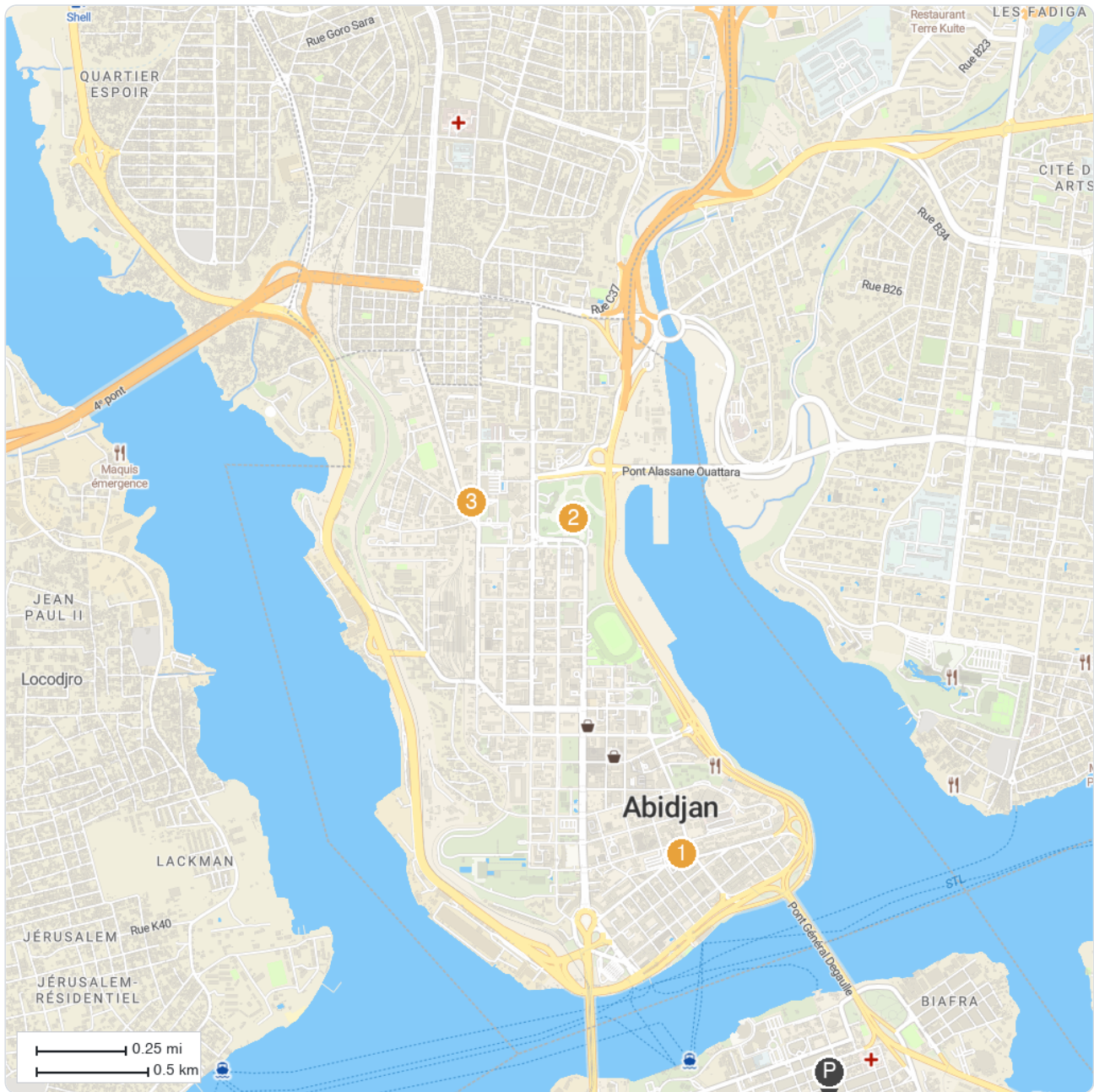
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use XOF cash. Most markets and street vendors are cash-only. Banks and ATMs in Plateau work reliably; airport-style exchange counters near the port gate offer poor rates.
- Agree taxi fares before you get in. There is no universal meter enforcement. Yango app gives fixed pricing and is widely available — download before arrival.
- Heat and humidity are real. Abidjan sits at sea level in the tropics. Light, breathable clothing, sunscreen, and a refillable water bottle are essential.
