GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small quay in Aegina Town; larger ships tender, smaller cruise ships & superyachts dock stern-to

Best For: Ancient history, pistachio shopping, Greek island atmosphere

Walk to center: Immediate — port opens directly onto the waterfront promenade

Don't Miss: Temple of Aphaia (480 BC) and a bag of fresh PDO Aegina pistachios

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Temple of Aphaia** — One of Greece's best-preserved ancient temples, built around 480 BC on a pine-forested hill overlooking Agia Marina.
 - **Temple of Apollo (Kolona) & Archaeological Museum** — A single standing column from the 6th-century BC Temple of Apollo marks this site just a 10-minute walk from the port.
 - **Moni Island Day Trip** — A 10-minute boat ride from the fishing village of Perdika takes you to uninhabited Moni
- Island — crystal-clear waters...

 - **Aegina Town & Pistachio Shopping** — Wander the harbourfront, the morning fish market, and the backstreets lined with neoclassical mansions.
 - **Paleochora (Medieval Ghost Town)** — Aegina's former medieval capital sits on an inland hill with over 30 Byzantine-era chapels scattered across the hillside.

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Temple of Apollo (Kolona)** 1.5 km round-trip | Easy | 30-45 min — From the port, walk north along the harbour promenade past fishing boats and waterfront cafes to the ancient Temple of Apollo site and...
- **Aegina Town Waterfront Stroll** 1 km | Easy | 30 min — A leisurely circuit from the ferry pier south along the promenade, past pistachio shops, the fish market, and the neoclassical town...

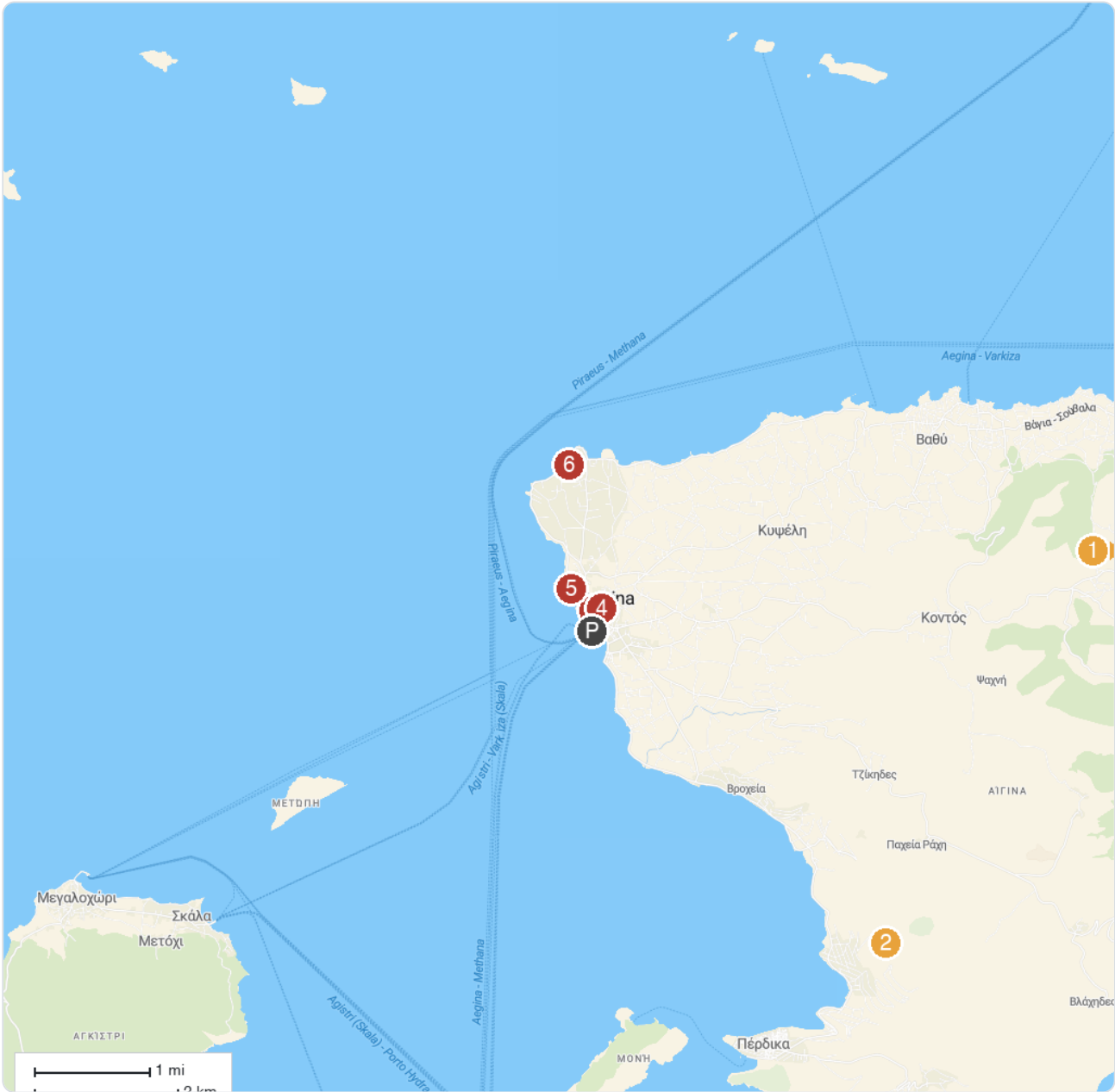
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
