TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Souk El Had** — Visit one of Africa's largest markets, a labyrinth of stalls selling spices, leather goods, leather and traditional...
 - **Agadir Oufella** — Ascend to the ruins of the old fortress on the hill for the most iconic panoramic views of the Agadir bay and city.
- **Paradise Valley** — A scenic trip into the Atlas Mountains to see natural rock pools and waterfalls in a lush valley setting.
 - **Agadir Beach** — Enjoy the wide, golden sands of the Atlantic coast, perfect for sunbathing, surfing, or a seaside stroll.

BEST WALKS

- **City Center Stroll Shopping & Dining** — Take a taxi to the city center and walk through the modern streets, visiting local cafes and boutiques.
- **Beachfront Promenade Beach & Ocean** — Walk along the wide promenade that separates the beach from the city, offering a relaxing view of the Atlantic.
- **Kasbah Agadir History & Culture** — Visit the reconstructed fortress and museum to learn about the city's history and the 1960 earthquake.

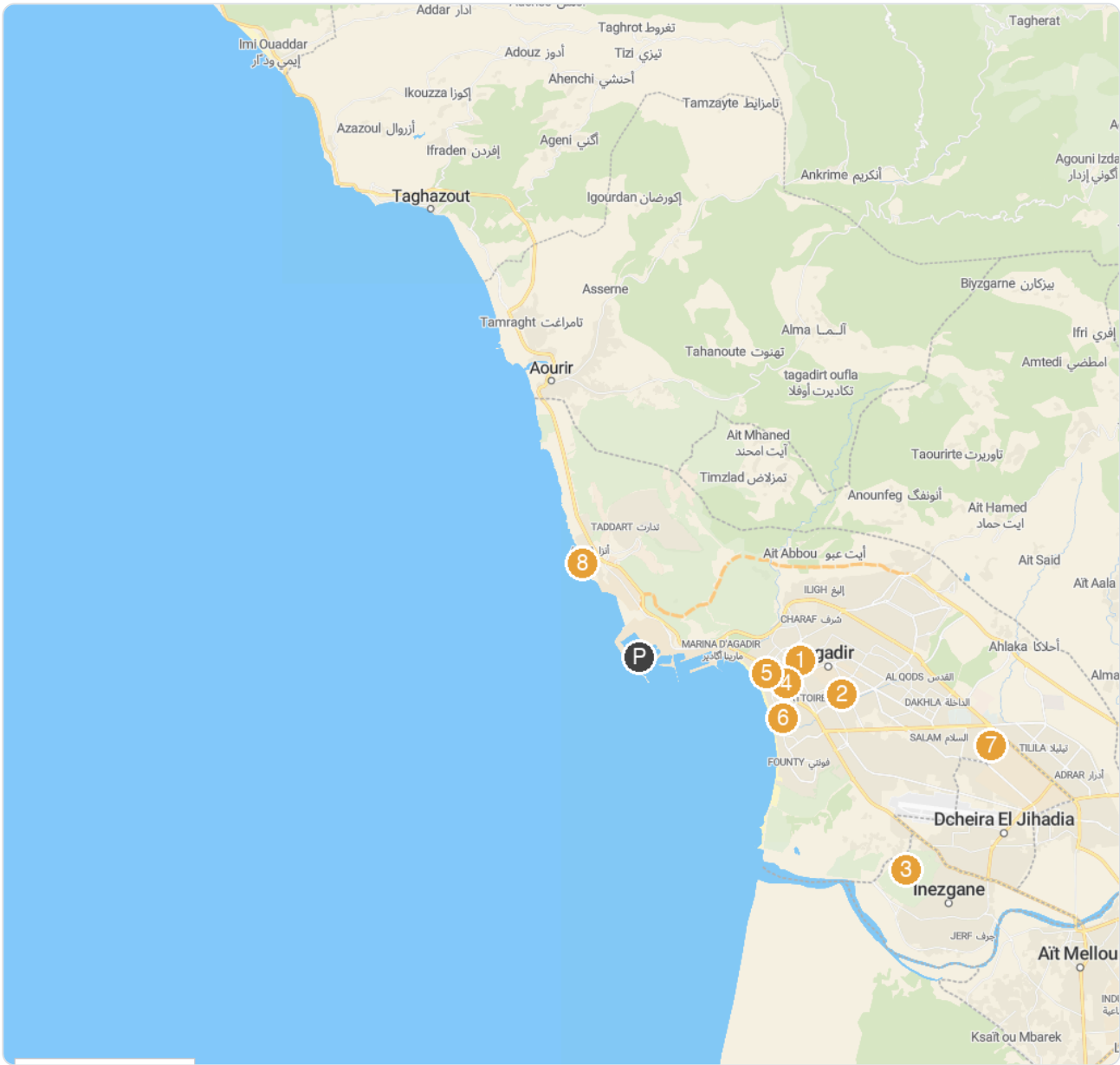
