TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Taj Mahal at Sunrise** — The 17th-century marble mausoleum built by Emperor Shah Jahan for Mumtaz Mahal is the defining image of India.
- **Agra Fort** — This massive red sandstone fortress served as the main residence of Mughal emperors for generations.
- **Tomb of Itimad-ud-Daulah (Baby Taj)** — This exquisite Mughal mausoleum across the Yamuna was commissioned by Empress Nur Jahan for her father.
- **Fatehpur Sikri Day Trip** — Emperor Akbar's extraordinary abandoned Mughal capital, built entirely of red sandstone, sits about 40 km west of Agra.
- **Mehtab Bagh & Yamuna Boat Ride** — The Moonlight Garden directly across the Yamuna River from the Taj offers the classic rear view of the monument at...

BEST WALKS

- **Taj Mahal Complex Walk** 1-2 hrs | Easy | Flat paved gardens — Enter via the East Gate (recommended) and walk through the grand gateway (Darwaza-i-Rauza) to the iconic reflecting pool, then circle...
- **Agra Fort Ramparts Walk** 1-1.5 hrs | Moderate | Uneven stone — Enter at Amar Singh Gate and walk the interior courtyards — Diwan-i-Am, Diwan-i-Khas, Khas Mahal — finishing at the Musamman Burj...

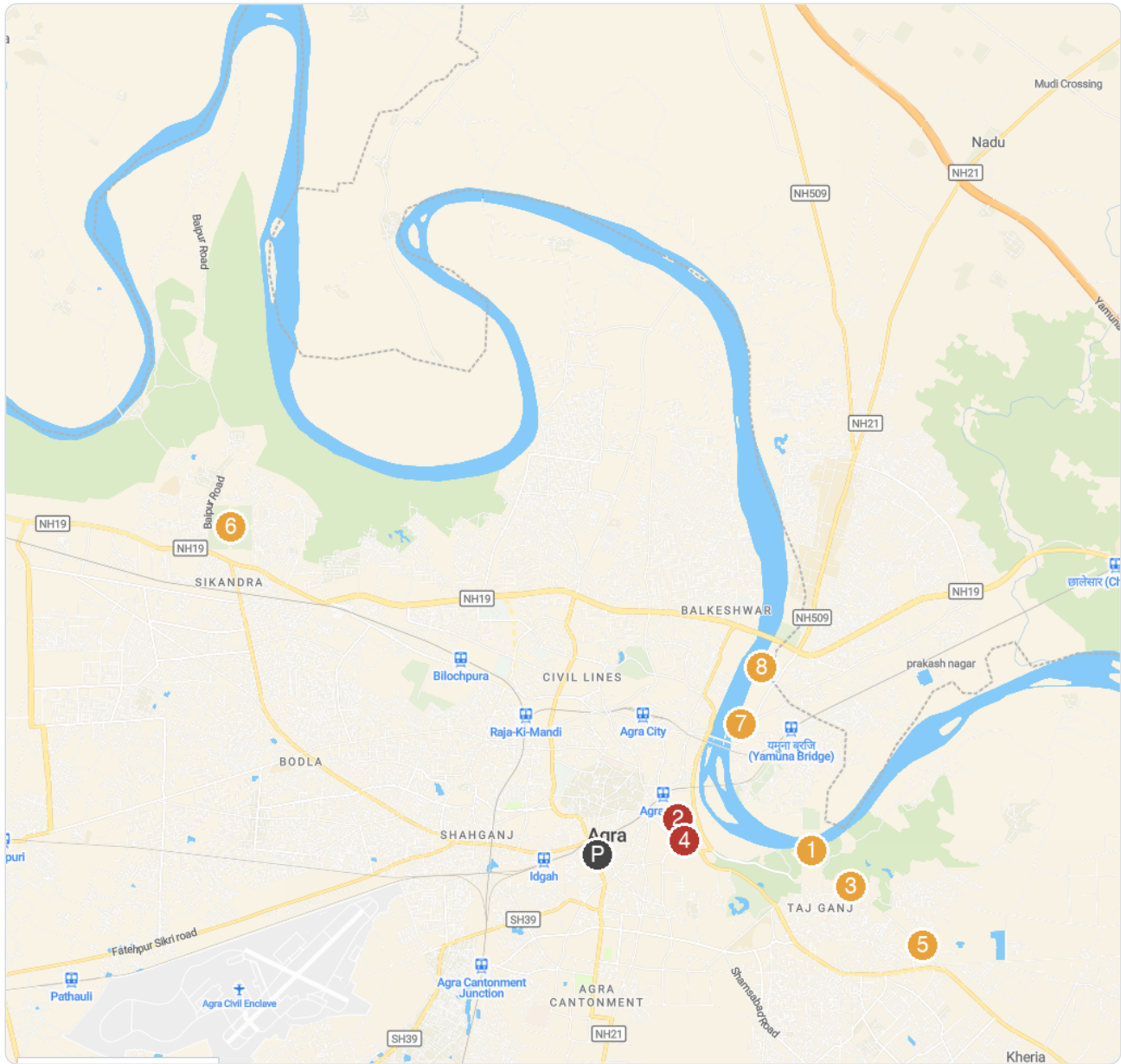
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Taj Mahal is closed Fridays. Plan your visit for any other day; the monument is open from sunrise to sunset. Weekends and Indian public holidays are significantly more crowded.
- Go early. Arrive at the Taj Mahal gate before 7 AM for the best light, thinner crowds, and the full sunrise-over-marble experience.

- 1 Taj Mahal** Iconic white marble mausoleum, a symbol of eternal love.
- 3 Taj Nature Walk** A green forest area offering distant views of the Taj Mahal.
- 5 Kalakriti cultural and convention centre** Venue for cultural shows, including 'Mohabbat-the-Taj' live performance.
- 7 Itmad-ud-Daula** Exquisite white marble Mughal tomb, often called the 'Baby Taj'.
- P Cruise port / terminal**

- 2 Agra Fort** Historic red sandstone Mughal fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- 4 Amar Singh Gate** The grand main entrance gate to the historic Agra Fort.
- 6 Tomb of Akbar** The grand sandstone mausoleum of the great Mughal Emperor Akbar.
- 8 Chini Ka Rauza** A unique Persian-style tomb adorned with glazed tile work.
