GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships tie up directly at Agropoli marina — ~500 m flat walk to town center

Best For: Greek antiquities (Paestum), coastal walks, authentic Campania cuisine

Walk to center: 10 min on foot; old town is uphill with steps

Don't Miss: Paestum temples (UNESCO) — 15 min by train or taxi

Getting around: Taxi €5–€15

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Paestum Greek Temples** — Just 9 km north, Paestum contains three of the world's best-preserved ancient Greek temples (6th–5th century BC), a...
- Cilento Coast Boat Tour** — Depart from Agropoli's own port on a 2-4 hour cruise along the wild Cilento coastline — sea caves, hidden coves, and a...
- Agropoli Medieval Castle & Old Town** — Hike the cobbled lanes to the 15th-century Angevin-Aragonese Castle at the crown of the promontory.
- Mozzarella Farm & Paestum Combo** — The Paestum plain is buffalo country — join a guided half-day combining the temples with a working mozzarella dairy for...
- Castellabate Village Walk** — This medieval hilltop village 15 km south is a UNESCO-listed borgo with sea views, 13th-century walls, and a...

BEST WALKS

- Marina to Borgo Antico (Old Town Loop)** 2.5 km round trip · 45-60 min · Moderate (uphill) — From the marina, follow the promenade north, then climb Via Castello through the medieval gate into the Borgo Antico.
- Waterfront Promenade to Trentova Bay** 3 km one-way · 40 min · Easy (flat) — Head south from the marina along the lungomare past Lido Azzurro beach and continue on the coastal path to Trentova Bay — one of the...

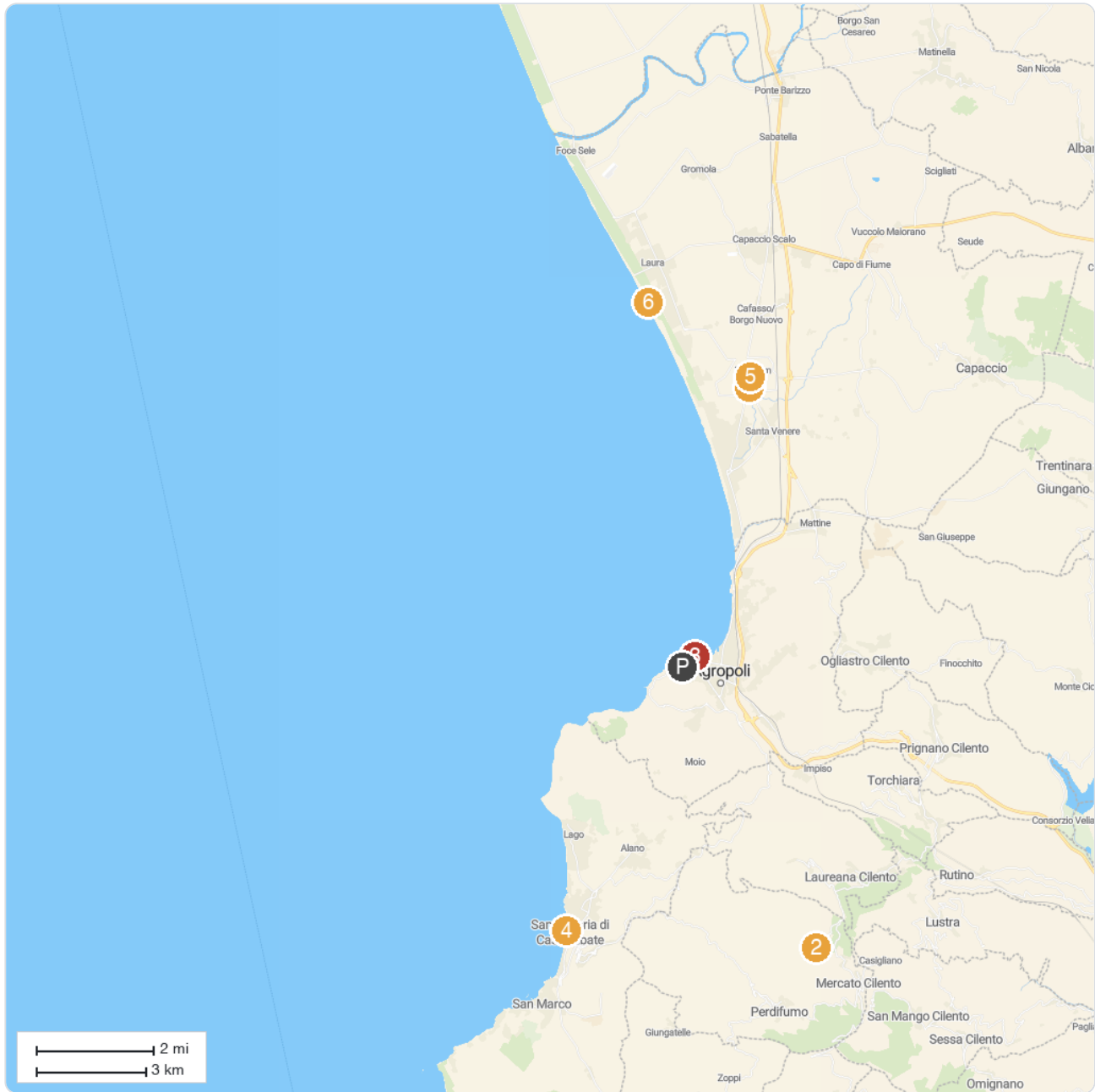
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
