GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside at Gare Maritime, Quai L'Herminier — city center is a 5-minute walk

Best For: Napoleonic history, Corsican cuisine, beaches, Italian Renaissance art

Walk to Center: ~5 min to Place Foch; Maison Bonaparte another 5 min into the old town

Don't Miss: Palais Fesch — France's largest collection of Italian paintings outside the Louvre

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Maison Bonaparte & Old Town Walk** — Napoleon's birthplace at 1 Rue Saint-Charles is now a national museum.
- **Palais Fesch — Napoleon's Art Museum** — Cardinal Fesch, Napoleon's uncle, assembled Italy's finest Renaissance paintings outside Paris.
- **Sanguinaires Islands Boat Trip** — Half-day cruise to the red-granite Sanguinaires Islands at the mouth of the Gulf of Ajaccio, crowned by a 19th-century...
- **Calanques de Piana Scenic Drive** — A UNESCO-listed stretch of rose-pink granite cliffs along the west coast, about 70 km north.
- **Porticcio Beach by Ferry** — A 20-minute ferry from the port drops you at the long golden-sand beach of Porticcio across the gulf — sun loungers...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Napoleon Loop** 1.5 km · ~45 min · Easy · Fully flat — A gentle loop through Ajaccio's historic core taking in the main Napoleonic sites.
- **Pointe de la Parata Coastal Walk** 4 km round-trip · ~2 hrs · Moderate · Bus to trailhead — Take bus line 5 to the end of the line at Pointe de la Parata, then walk the rocky headland trail for sweeping views of the...

- Buses are cheap and easy. Lines 5 and 8 stop right outside the terminal. Line 5 reaches Plage Trottet (beach) for €1.50 — far
