GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor in Akaroa Harbour; 15–20 min ferry to Drummond's Jetty (tender landing while the main Akaroa Wharf is rebuilt, ~2026–2027)

Best For: Wildlife (Hector's dolphins, penguins), scenic harbour cruises, French-heritage village strolling

Walk to Centre: Steps from the tender jetty to village cafes and shops

Don't Miss: A harbour wildlife cruise — Hector's dolphins are unique to New Zealand and abundant here

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  Metered (local taxis); Uber app ·  **Rideshare**  Uber ·  **Hop-on hop-off**  Hop-on hop-off

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Hector's Dolphin & Wildlife Harbour Cruise** — Board a catamaran to search for Hector's dolphins — the world's smallest and rarest, found only in New Zealand.
- Swim with Hector's Dolphins** — A handful of licensed operators offer in-water experiences with wild Hector's dolphins in the harbour.
- Sea Kayaking in the Marine Reserve** — Paddle beneath volcanic sea cliffs, through sea caves, and past fur seal colonies in the Akaroa Marine Reserve.
- Little Penguin & Banks Peninsula 4WD Safari** — Head into the rugged Banks Peninsula hills by 4WD to visit the Pohatu Marine Reserve — home to the largest little...
- The Giant's House Garden & Akaroa Village Walk** — Stroll Rue Lavaud past French colonial cottages to The Giant's House — a historic homestead with a fantastical garden...

BEST WALKS

- Harbourfront Promenade — Jetty to Village** 1 km · 15 min · Flat · No gear needed — Walk south from Drummond's Jetty along Beach Road past heritage buildings, the Akaroa Museum, and waterfront cafes.
- Rue Lavaud Heritage Walk** 1.5 km · 20 min · Flat · Self-guided — Follow Rue Lavaud from the waterfront up through the heart of the French-settled village.

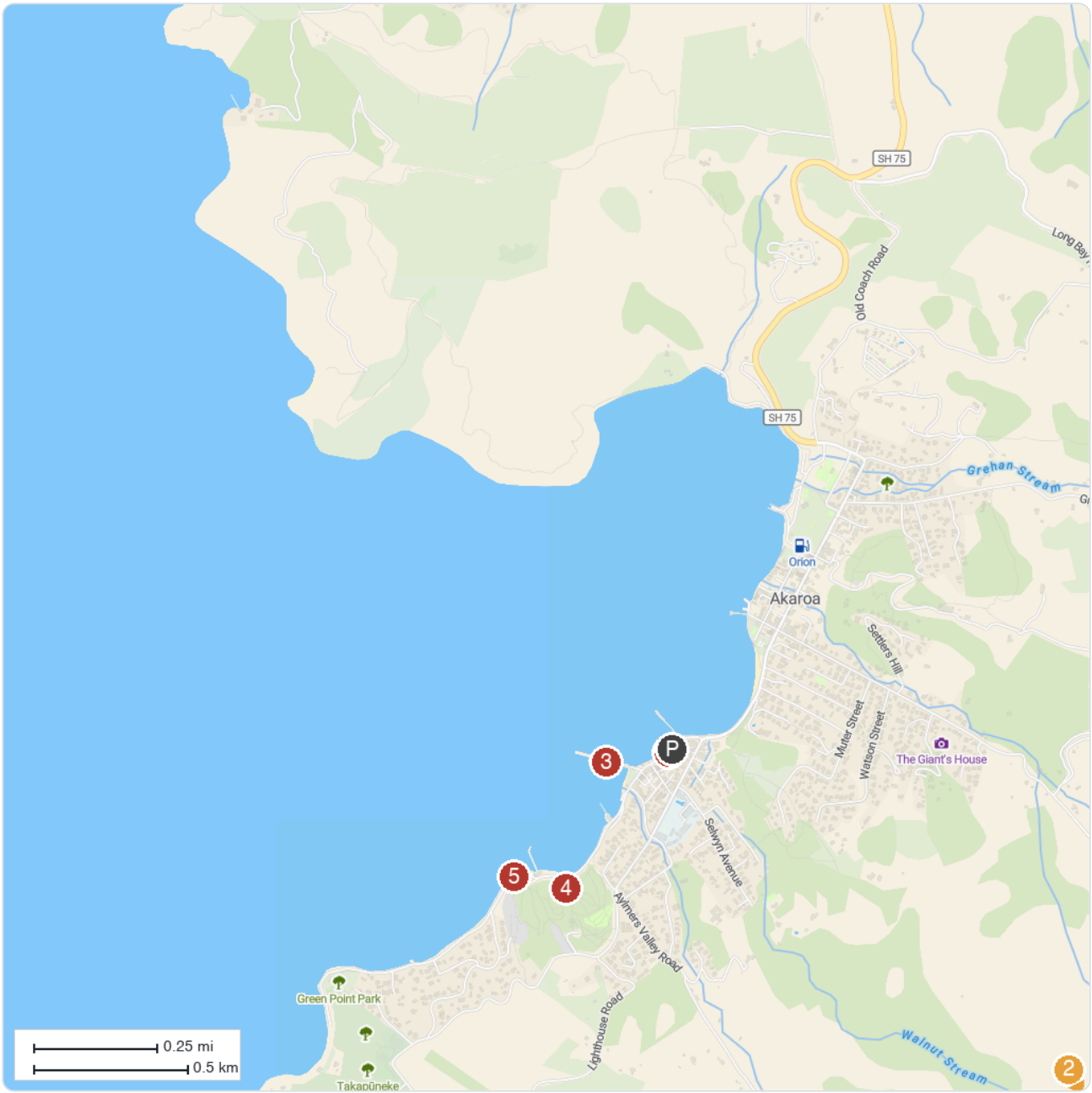
