- Riverfront Stroll** 1 mile · 20 min · Easy — Walk south along the Hudson riverfront from the pier through the Corning Preserve to the downtown waterfront, with views across to the...

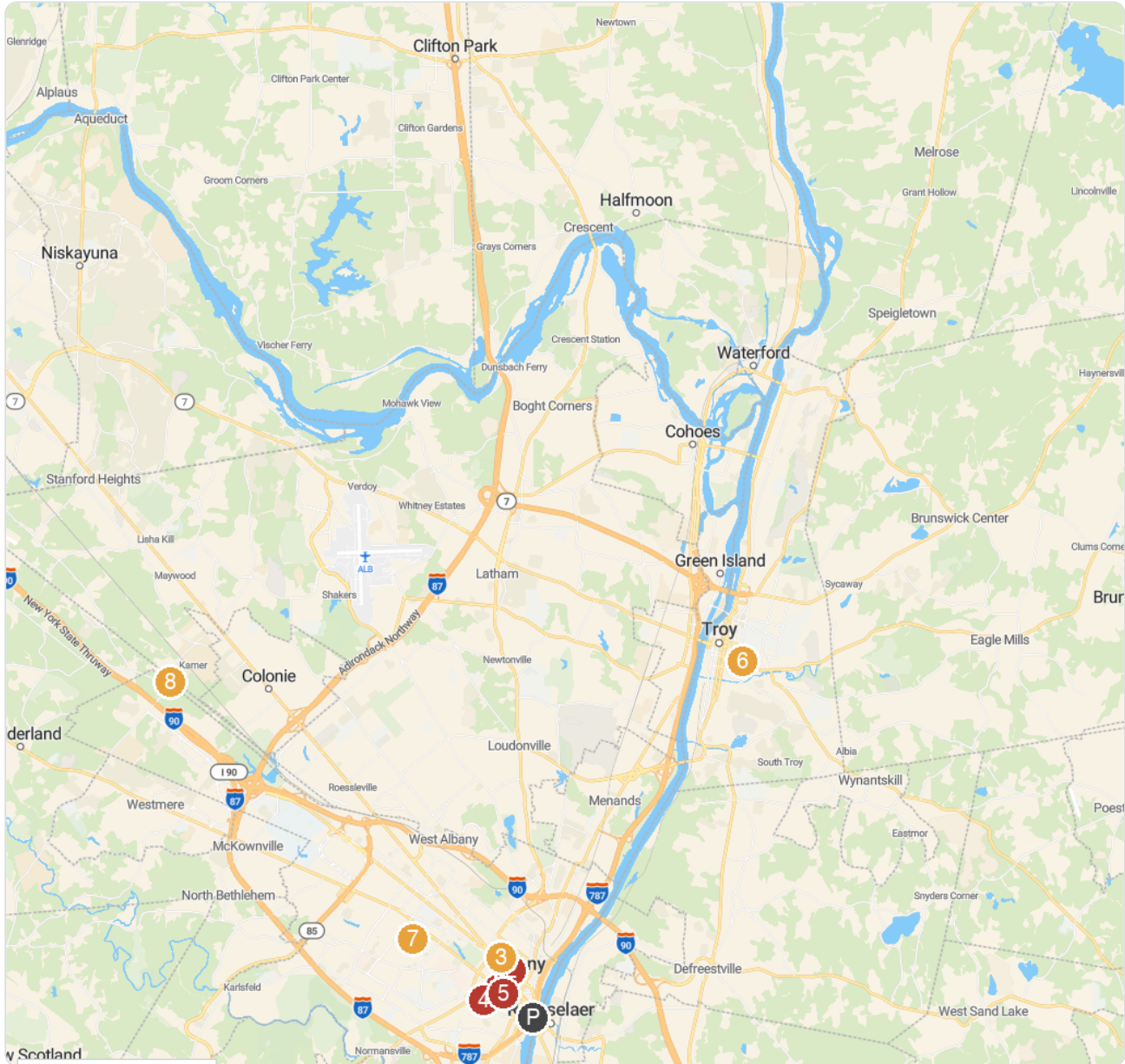
