GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Cruise ships dock at the Port of Albany commercial terminal in Princess Royal Harbour; occasional anchor-and-tender in strong winds

Best For: ANZAC history, dramatic coastal formations, whale watching (May–Oct), Great Southern wine region

Walk to Centre: ~1.5–2 km (20 min walk); free shuttle buses run to York Street near Albany Visitor Centre

Don't Miss: National Anzac Centre on Mount Clarence and Discovery Bay Historic Whaling Station

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **National Anzac Centre** — This award-winning interactive museum on Mount Clarence tells the stories of individual ANZACs who departed from Albany...
- **Discovery Bay Historic Whaling Station** — Australia's last operating whaling station, now an interactive museum.
- **The Gap & Natural Bridge, Torndirrup National Park** — Stand on a suspended platform 40 m above the Southern Ocean at The Gap, where swells thunder through a granite chasm...
- **Whale Watching (May–October)** — Albany is one of Australia's best whale watching spots.
- **Great Southern Wine Region & Denmark** — Albany sits within one of Australia's premier cool-climate wine regions.

BEST WALKS

- **York Street Heritage Stroll** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — From the Albany Visitor Centre on York Street, walk south along the historic main street past the Town Hall and colonial shopfronts...
- **Foreshore Footbridge to Town** 0.5 km · 10 min · Easy — Walk the 250 m footbridge directly from the port precinct across to the CBD waterfront — the quickest route between ship and town...

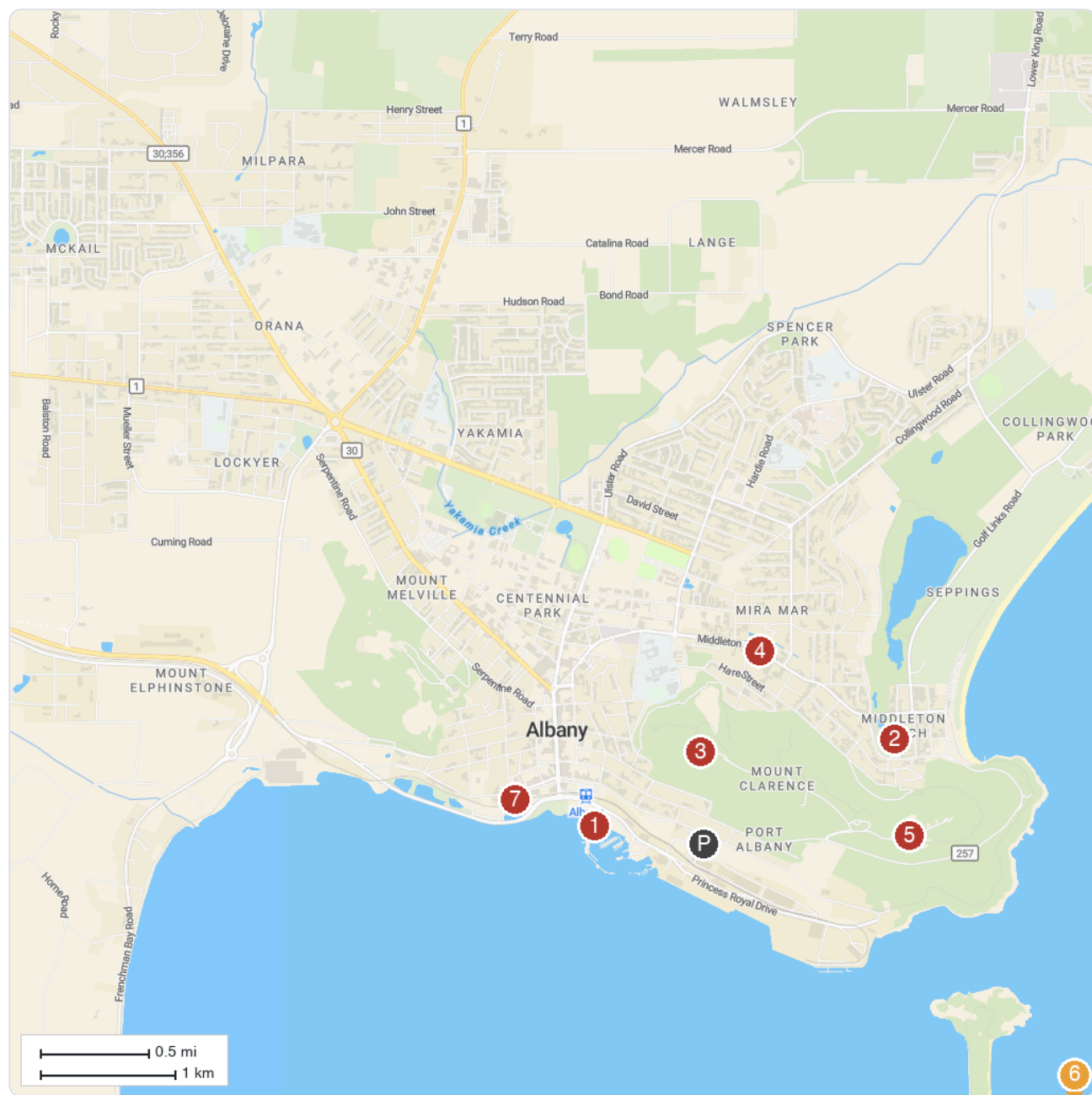
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
