Docking: Tender port — ships anchor offshore; tenders ferry passengers to the village dock

Best For: Indigenous culture, whale watching, totem poles

Walk to centre: Village is immediate from the tender dock; all main sights within 1.5 km

Don't Miss: U'mista Cultural Centre and the 173-ft world's tallest totem pole

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **U'mista Cultural Centre** — The centrepiece of any Alert Bay visit.
- **World's Tallest Totem Pole & 'Namgis Big House** — A 20-minute walk from the dock brings you to the 173-foot 'Namgis totem pole — the world's tallest — adjacent to the...
- **Orca & Whale Watching in Johnstone Strait** — Johnstone Strait is one of the world's premier locations to see orcas, especially from late June through September.
- **Gator Gardens Ecological Park** — A peaceful boardwalk trail winds through ancient cedar and Sitka spruce rainforest, coastal wetlands, and wildflower...
- **Waterfront Path & 'Namgis Burial Grounds** — A 1.8 km waterfront walking path runs nearly the full length of Alert Bay, past heritage houses, 'awakwes' shelters...

BEST WALKS

- **Village Waterfront & Cultural Loop** 2.5 km return | 1–1.5 hrs | Easy | Free — Start at the tender dock, walk to the U'mista Cultural Centre, then continue along the waterfront path past the 'awakwes' ancestor...
- **Gator Gardens Ecological Park** 1 km loop | 45 min | Easy | Free — A signed boardwalk trail through old-growth coastal rainforest, wetlands, and bog.

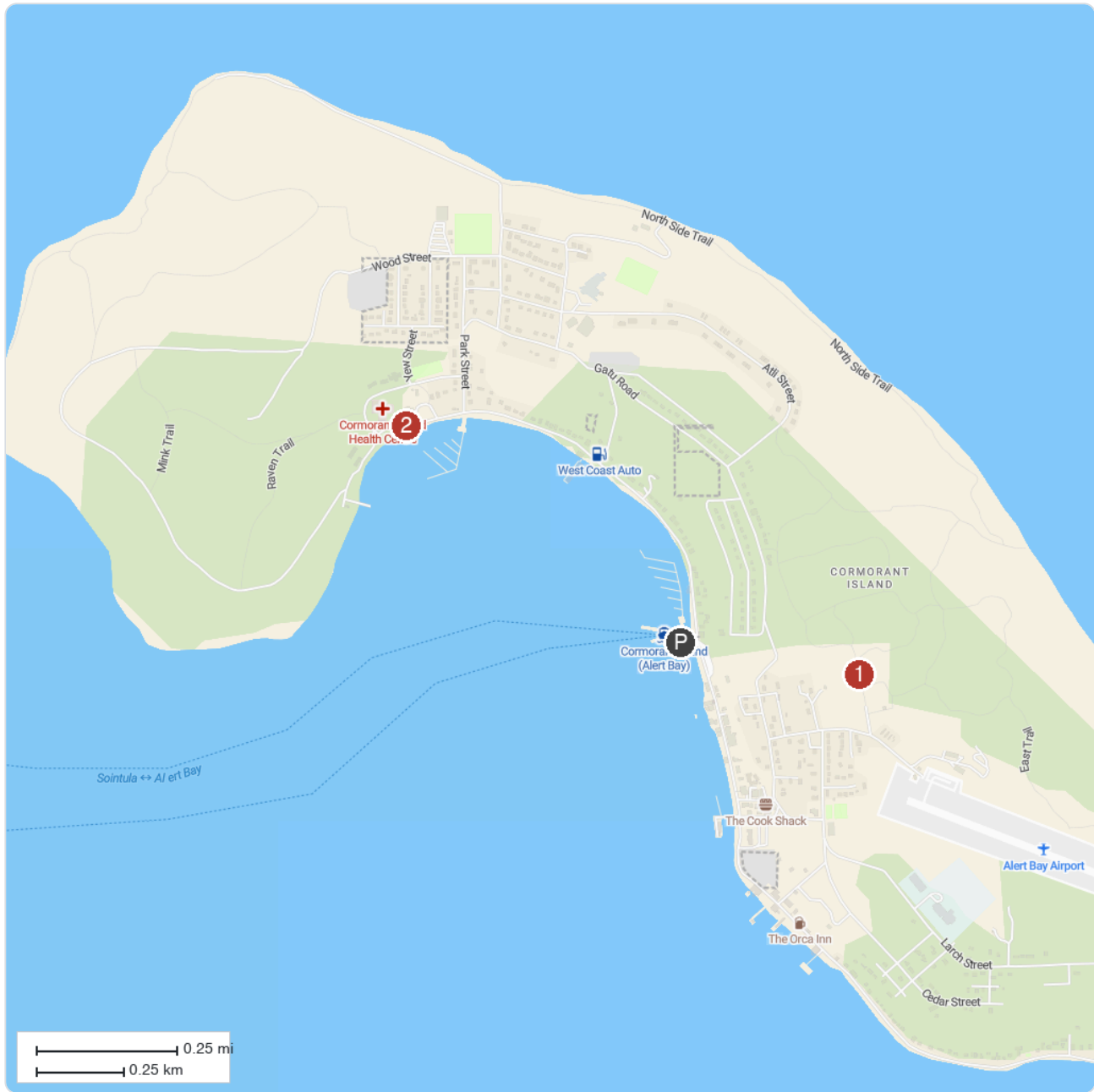
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
