

Algeciras, Andalusia, Spain

Straddling the narrowest point between Europe and Africa, Algeciras punches well above its size — a working port city that hands cruisers a remarkable menu: the Rock of Gibraltar, a fast ferry to Tangier, kite-surf mecca Tarifa, or simply the old quarter's sherry bars and Moorish walls.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: All ships dock — no tendering. Large ships use the 1,000 m North dock (free shuttle to centre); smaller vessels berth at Isla Verde Interior Quay (~10-min walk to town).

Best For: Gibraltar day trips, Morocco ferry, Tarifa wind sports, dolphin & whale watching

Walk to centre: 10-15 min on foot from the North dock via free port shuttle; Isla Verde quay is walkable in ~10 min.

Don't Miss: The Rock of Gibraltar's Barbary macaques and St. Michael's Cave; or a fast ferry to Tangier

 Getting around:  Taxi  €5–€7 ·  Rideshare  Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Rock of Gibraltar** — Catch a bus to La Línea de la Concepción (45 min, ~€3) then walk across the border into Gibraltar.
- **Tangier Day Trip by Ferry** — FRS and Baleària run ferries from Algeciras to Tangier MED port (ferry port, ~35 min) or from nearby Tarifa to Tangier...
- **Tarifa: Wind, Whales & the Southern Tip** — Tarifa (22 km south, 45 min by hourly bus, ~€2-5) is Europe's southernmost point and the world capital of windsurfing...
- **Bay of Gibraltar Dolphin & Whale Watching** — The Strait of Gibraltar is one of Europe's richest cetacean corridors.
- **Algeciras Old Quarter Walking Tour** — Algeciras's compact historic core is walkable from the port.

BEST WALKS

- **Historic Algeciras: Port to Plaza Alta** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy — A short stroll through the city core, taking in the Merinide Walls archaeological park, Parque María Cristina, and arriving at Plaza...
- **Gibraltar Frontier Walk (La Línea)** ~1 km at border · Easy — After the bus drops you at La Línea de la Concepción bus station, walk south through town to the frontier, cross on foot (passport...

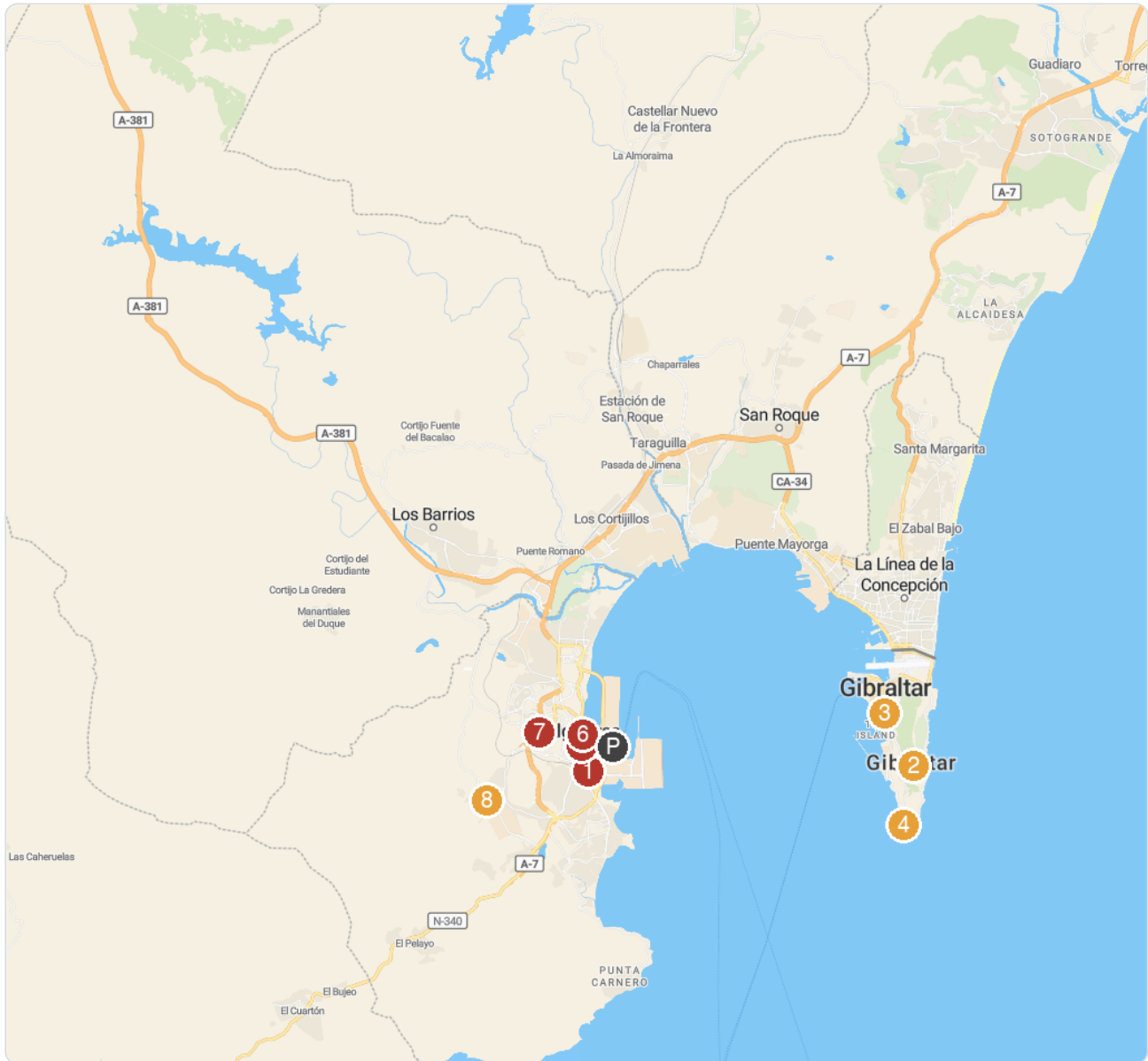
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
