GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships dock at Port d'Alger (Gare Maritime) — central, no tender

Best For: History lovers, architecture fans, adventurous independent travellers

Walk to centre: ~15 min on foot to Grande Poste / Casbah entrance

Don't Miss: The Casbah UNESCO labyrinth and a taxi ride to Notre Dame d'Afrique

Getting around: **Taxi** 200–500 DZD (~\$1.50–4 USD)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Casbah of Algiers UNESCO Walking Tour** — Wind through centuries-old alleyways past Ottoman palaces, traditional courtyard homes, and ancient mosques in this...
- Notre Dame d'Afrique & Bay Views** — A short taxi ride climbs to this 19th-century basilica perched on a cliff above the Bay of Algiers.
- Tipasa Roman Ruins Day Trip** — Drive 70 km west to Tipasa, a UNESCO World Heritage site where Roman temples, a basilica, and a theatre tumble...
- French Quarter & Grande Poste Stroll** — Walk the broad Haussmann-style boulevards around Rue Didouche Mourad, admire the Neo-Moorish Grande Poste building, and...
- Jardin d'Essai du Hamma** — One of the oldest botanical gardens in Africa, established in 1832, with enormous century-old trees, rare plant...

BEST WALKS

- French Quarter Loop** 2 km · 45 min · Easy — Start at the port gate and head up to the Grande Poste building for photos of its striking Neo-Moorish façade, then stroll Rue...
- Casbah Entrance & Lower Quarter** 1.5 km · 1–2 hrs · Moderate (steep, uneven) — From the port walk north to the lower Casbah entrance near Place des Martyrs.

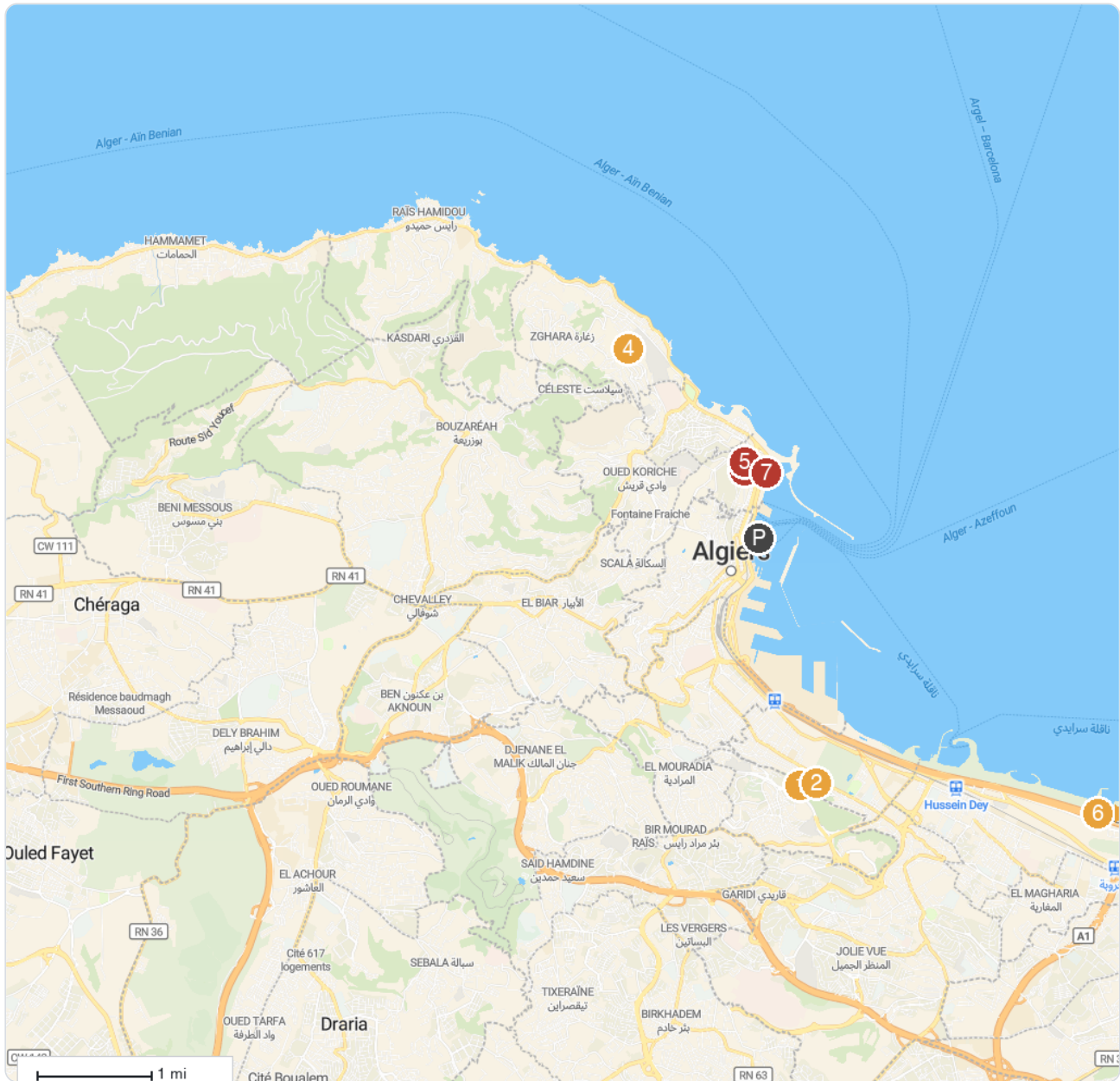
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
