GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Berthed at the cruise quay (Muelle 14); free shuttle ~1.5 km to port gate

Best For: History, beaches, tapas, easy day-trips to Elche or Tabarca Island

Walk to center: 15–20 min on foot from port gate; Explanada is the landmark to aim for

Don't Miss: Santa Bárbara Castle — free entry, 360° coastal views (lift ~€3)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Santa Bárbara Castle** — Alicante's defining landmark crowns Mount Benacantil with 360° views over the city, port, and Costa Blanca.
- **Old Town (Barrio de Santa Cruz) & Explanada** — Wander the colorful flower-pot lanes of Santa Cruz, drop into the Gothic Basilica de Santa María, then stroll the...
- **Playa del Postiguet** — Blue-flag city beach just east of the port entrance.
- **Tabarca Island Day Trip** — Spain's only inhabited marine reserve sits 11 nautical miles offshore.
- **Elche & the Palmeral** — 30 km southwest lies Elche, home to the largest palm grove in Europe — a UNESCO World Heritage Site with over 200,000...

BEST WALKS

- **Port Gate to Castle Loop** 3–4 km | 2–3 hrs | Moderate (uphill to castle) — From Plaza Puerta del Mar, walk along the marina to the Explanada de España, then head inland to the Basilica de Santa María.
- **Market & Tapas Stroll** 1.5 km | 1 hr | Easy — A flat, leisurely loop through the city center.

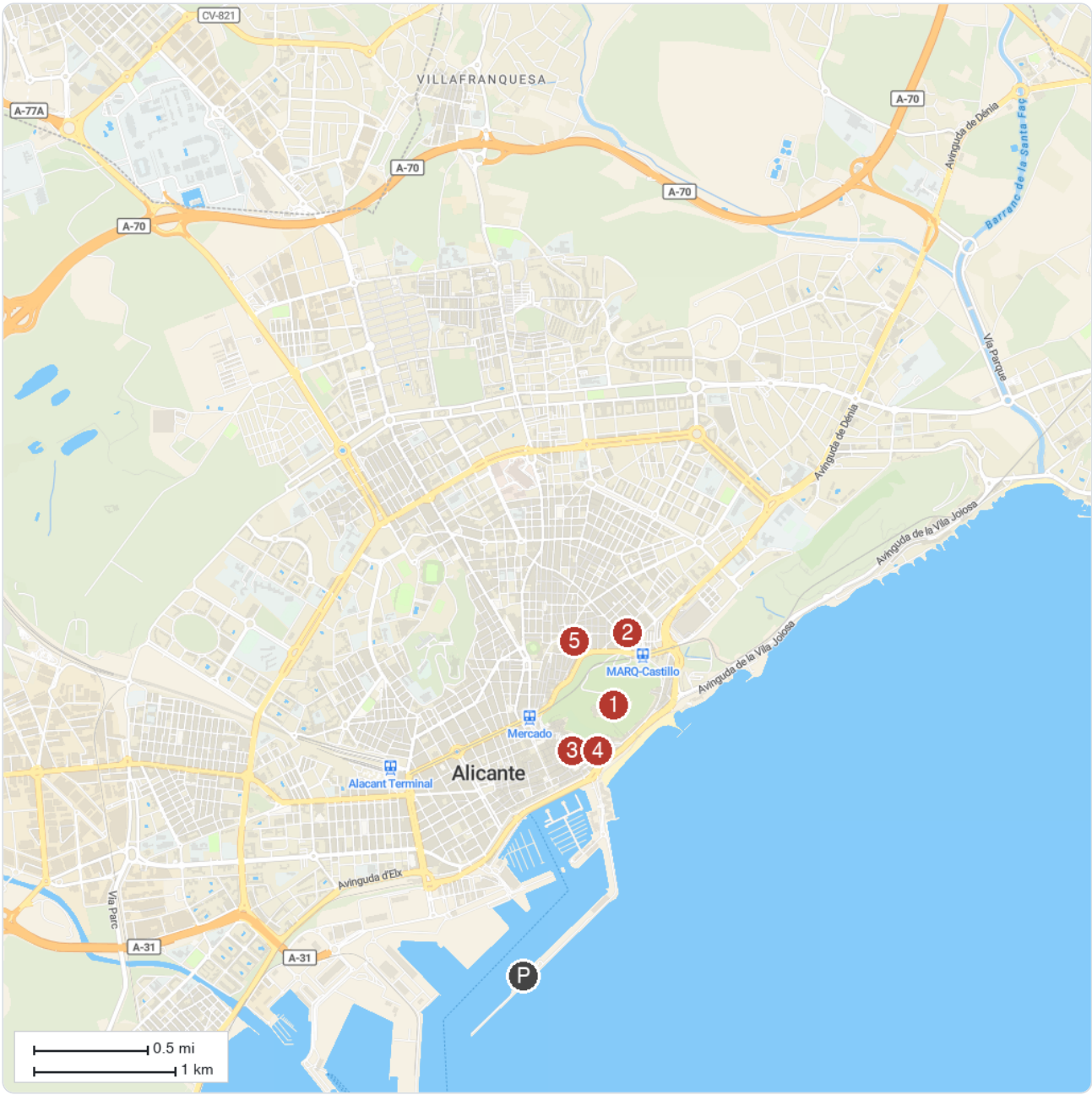
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Free shuttle is your friend. Don't skip it — the walk from the actual ship berth to the port gate along the quay is over a kilometre in open sun.
- July–August gets very hot. Start with the castle early, then cool down at Postiguet Beach in the afternoon. Morning calls are more comfortable than afternoon.
