GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Floating steel pontoon, right bank of Danube at km 1380+200; up to 2 river vessels

Best For: Pilgrimage history, Pannonian wetland wildlife, Slavonian food and wine

Walk to center: Pier is in the village — shrine and riverbank are under 5 min on foot

Don't Miss: Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation and a boat tour through Kopački Rit

Getting around: **Taxi** €35–45

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation** — The iconic swan-shaped pilgrimage church rebuilt after the Croatian War of Independence is Aljmaš's spiritual heart.
 - **Kopački Rit Nature Park Boat Tour** — One of Europe's largest and best-preserved floodplain wetlands sits just 25 km from the pier.
- **Vukovar Memorial City** — Thirty-five kilometers downriver, Vukovar carries the visible scars and resilient spirit of the 1991 siege.
 - **Osijek Baroque Fortress (Tvrd̑a)** — Slavonia's largest city, Osijek, is about 25 km west.
 - **Slavonian Fish Lunch & Erdut Wine** — Aljmaš is known for family-run riverside restaurants serving freshwater fish — catfish, carp, and pike-perch — grilled...

BEST WALKS

- **Village & Shrine Loop** 0.5 km · 15 min · Easy — From the pier walk directly to the Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation, circle the church grounds, then stroll the Danube embankment...
- **Aljmaš to Erdut Riverside Path** 10 km one-way · ~3 hrs · Easy — A flat, shaded path follows the Danube bank east through riverside vegetation to the village of Erdut, known for a small hilltop...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Euro accepted widely. Croatia adopted the Euro (EUR) in 2023 — no need to source Croatian Kuna. Cards accepted at most restaurants; cash handy for small stalls.
- Respect the shrine. The Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation is an active pilgrimage site. Dress modestly (covered shoulders/knees).
