GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River pier at Terminal Hidroviário de Almeirim (opened 2021); small ships dock directly

Best For: Rainforest wildlife, Amazon river ecology, off-the-beaten-path Amazon towns

Walk to centre: 5-10 min from the river terminal to Praça do Centenário and the town centre

Don't Miss: Monte Dourado — a mid-century planned American-style company town across the Jari River

Getting around: **Taxi** BRL 5–15

- **Amazon Rainforest Trek** — Join a naturalist guide for a trek into the dense forest surrounding Almeirim.
- **Amazon River Wildlife Boat Tour** — A motorised canoe or small boat excursion along Amazon tributaries and flooded igapó forest — prime territory for pink river dolphins, caimans, and...
- **Monte Dourado — The Planned City** — Hop the passenger ferry across the Jari River to Monte Dourado, a mid-century planned company town built by American industrialist Daniel Ludwig with...
- **Santo Antônio Waterfall (Jari River)** — A full-day excursion up the Jari River to the impressive Santo Antônio waterfall — one of the region's standout natural spectacles and a rewarding...
- **Local Market & Town Walk** — Explore Almeirim's town centre on foot — the municipal market, Praça do Relógio, the historic church, and local street food stalls offering açaí...

- **Almeirim Town Centre Stroll** 1-2 hrs | Easy | Flat riverside streets — Walk from the river terminal through the town centre to Praça do Centenário, past the Igreja Matriz de Nossa Senhora da Conceição, the Praça do Relógio, and the local...

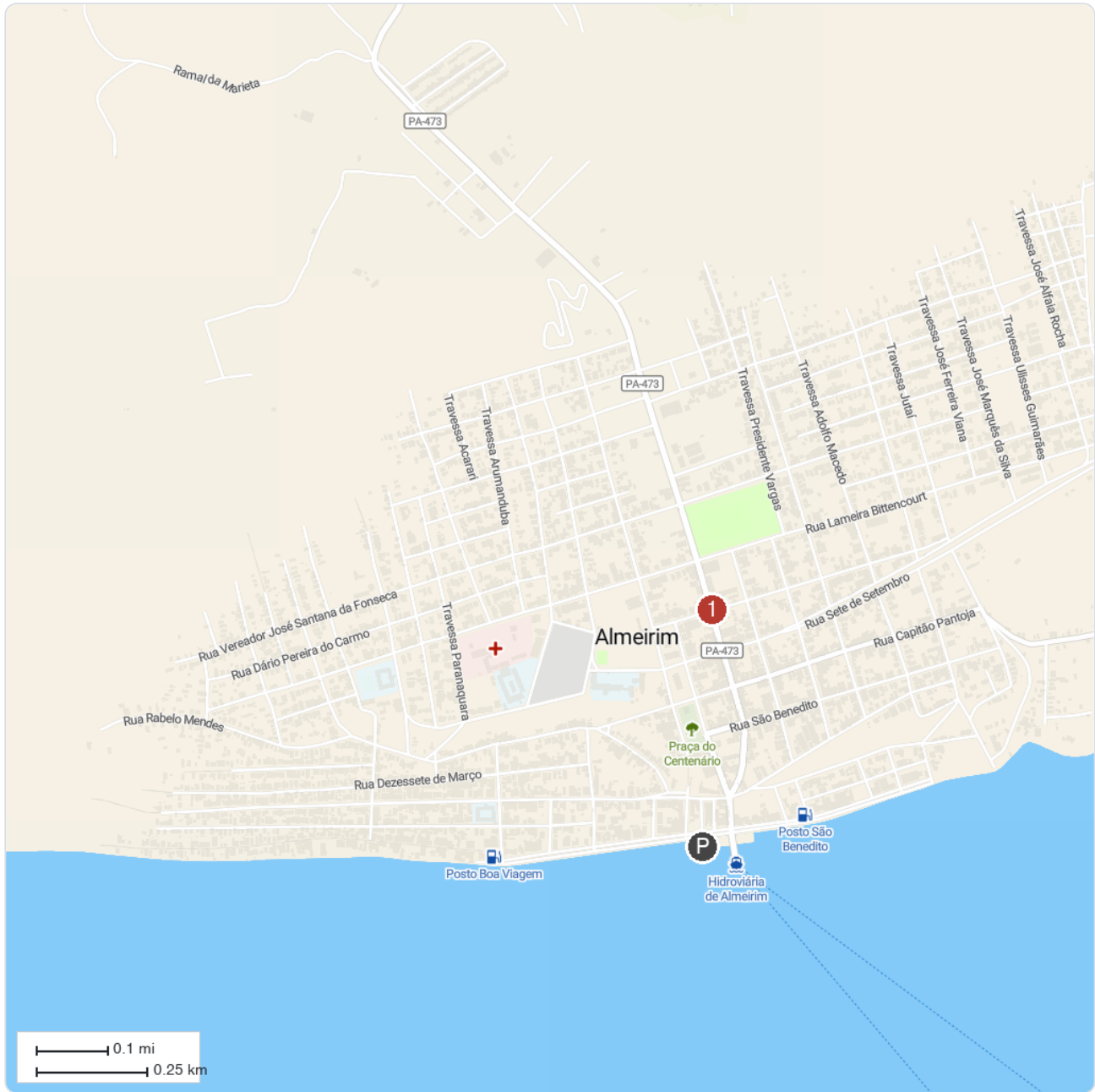
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry BRL cash. ATMs in Almeirim are limited and may not accept foreign cards. Exchange or withdraw money before arriving.
- Expect humidity and rain. The Amazon is tropical year-round; pack light, breathable clothing and a compact rain jacket or poncho.
- Mosquito protection is essential. Bring DEET repellent and consider long sleeves for rainforest treks, especially around dawn and dusk.
- Monte Dourado needs time. The ferry crossing plus exploration takes 3-4 hours — confirm your ship's all-aboard time before crossing the Jari River.
- Try the açaí. Almeirim is in the heart of açaí country — the local version served with tapioca and fish is nothing like the smoothie bowls back home.
- Connectivity is limited. Mobile data and Wi-Fi are patchy in Almeirim. Download offline maps before you disembark.
