

Amami Oshima, Kagoshima, Japan

A subtropical island between Kyushu and Okinawa, Amami Oshima packs UNESCO-listed jungle, Japan's second-largest mangrove forest, and pristine coral-fringed beaches into one unhurried cruise call.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Berthed at Naze Port (Nagahama berth, up to 80,000 GT); occasional tender for larger ships

Walk to center: 15–20 min walk to downtown Naze; shuttle buses often provided

Best For: Mangrove kayaking, tropical beaches, Oshima Tsumugi silk, subtropical hiking

Don't Miss: Keihan chicken rice — Amami's beloved local soul food

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  ¥500–¥800 to city center; ~¥6,500–¥7,500 to Mangrove Park (one-way)

- Kuroshio no Mori Mangrove Kayak** — Paddle through Japan's second-largest mangrove forest at Kuroshio no Mori Mangrove Park, about 30 minutes from Naze.
- Oshima Tsumugi Silk Weaving Workshop** — Oshima Tsumugi is one of Japan's finest silks, hand-woven on Amami Oshima for over 1,300 years using a traditional...
- Kinsakubaru Virgin Forest Walk** — Hike through one of Japan's last surviving subtropical evergreen forests, home to Amami rabbits, Lidth's jays, and...
- Tomori Beach & Snorkeling** — Often ranked Amami's finest beach, Tomori Beach offers white sand, calm turquoise water, and healthy coral reefs in the...
- Tanaka Isson Memorial Museum of Art** — Set within Amami Park, this museum celebrates the painter Tanaka Isson, who moved to Amami Oshima in 1958 and spent 20...

- Naze Port to Downtown & Nazemachi Shopping Street** 1.5 km · 20 min · Flat — An easy stroll from the Nagahama berth along the waterfront brings you to downtown Naze and Nazemachi Shopping Street, where you'll...
- Ogamiyama Park Hilltop Viewpoint** 1 km uphill · 20 min · Easy–Moderate — A short climb from downtown Naze leads to Ogamiyama Park, which crowns a forested knoll with sweeping views over Naze Port and the...

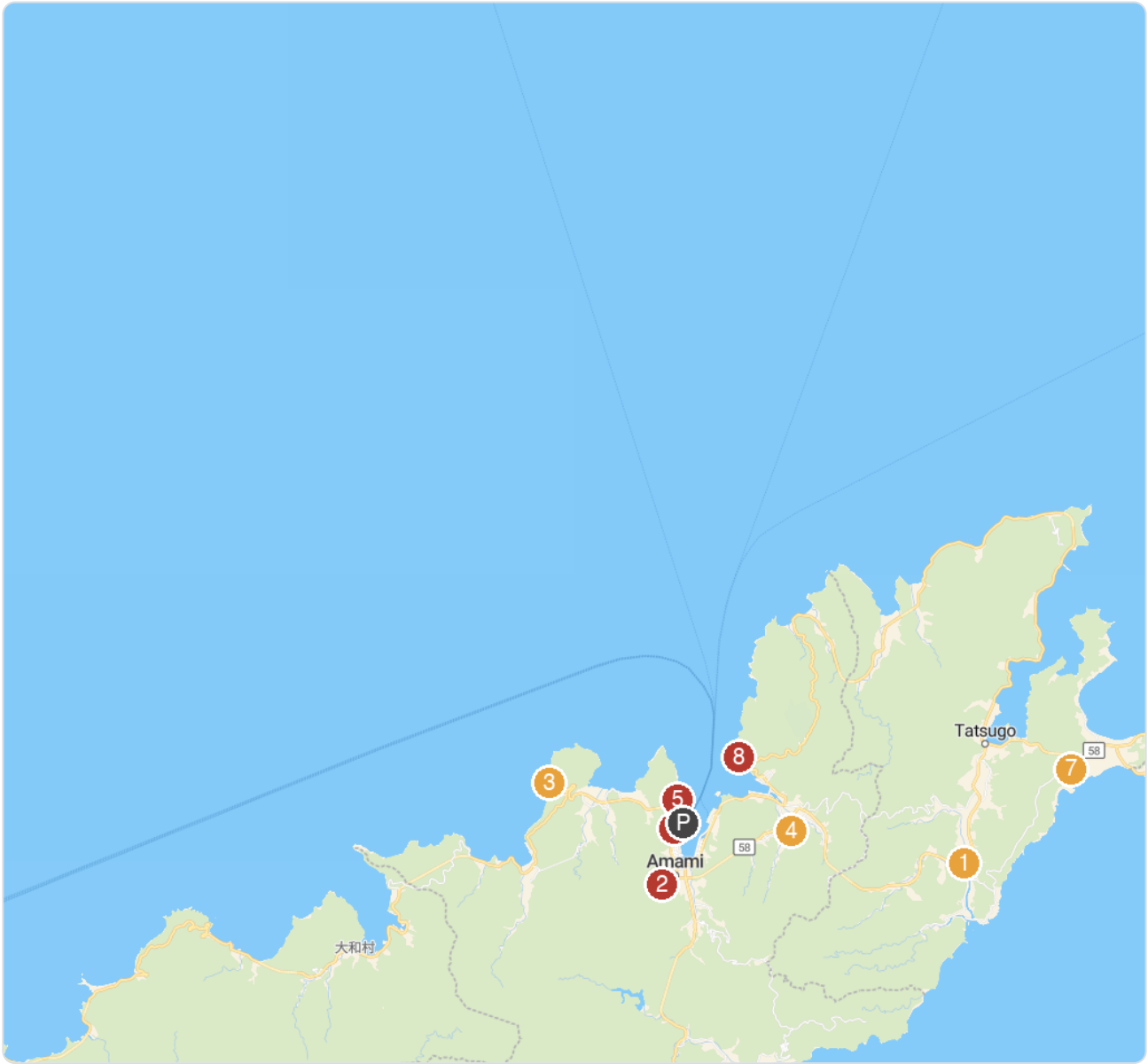
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
