GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Port of Fernandina deep-water pier (1,200 ft), central to town

Best For: Victorian architecture, Civil War history, beaches, nature walks

Walk to centre: ~5-10 min walk from pier to Centre Street historic district

Don't Miss: Fort Clinch State Park & the Palace Saloon (Florida's oldest)

Getting around: Taxi \$10–\$25 · Rideshare Uber, Lyft

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Fort Clinch State Park** — Explore a remarkably intact 19th-century brick fort garrisoned during the Civil War and Spanish-American War.
- Historic Downtown Fernandina Beach** — Stroll 50 blocks of Victorian-era architecture recognized on the National Register of Historic Places.
- Amelia River & Cumberland Island Cruise** — Amelia River Cruises runs narrated tours between Amelia and Georgia's wild Cumberland Island — spot wild horses...
- Horseback Riding on the Beach** — Amelia Island State Park on the southern tip of the island offers guided horseback rides along a wide, uncrowded...
- Main Beach Park & Egans Creek Greenway** — Main Beach Park offers a family-friendly Atlantic beach with a playground, pavilion, and calm surf.

BEST WALKS

- Centre Street Historic District Loop** 1-2 hrs · Flat · Self-guided — From the pier, head south to Centre Street and walk east through the 50-block Victorian historic district.
- Fort Clinch Beach & Fort Walk** 2-4 hrs · Easy-moderate · Bike or ride-share to park — Enter Fort Clinch State Park and tour the brick fort interior, then follow the beach trail south along the Atlantic and Cumberland...

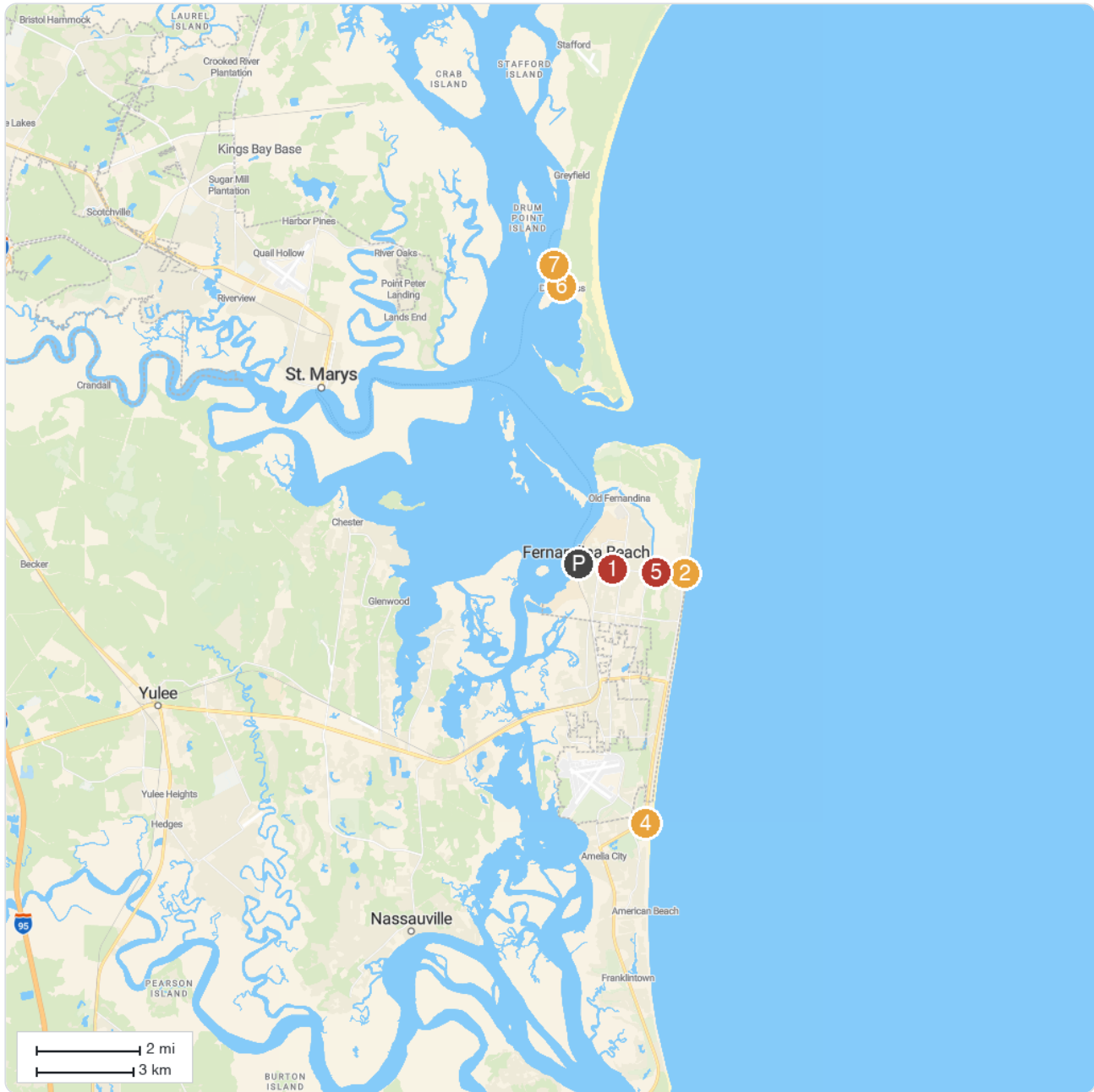
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
