TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Whale Watching in the Salish Sea** — The waters around the San Juan Islands are among the best orca habitat in the world.
 - **Deception Pass State Park** — Washington's most-visited state park sits 30 minutes north.
 - **Sea Kayaking — Fidalgo Island** — Paddle calm Fidalgo waters on a guided kayak tour.
- **Washington Park Loop** — A scenic 2.25-mile paved loop at the west end of Fidalgo Island frames views of the San Juan Islands and Olympic...
 - **Downtown Anacortes & Commercial Avenue** — Anacortes's arts-forward downtown is packed with galleries, boutiques, and brewpubs.

BEST WALKS

- **Cap Sante Marina to Commercial Avenue** 0.3 miles · 10 min · Easy — A short stroll from the marina through the heart of downtown Anacortes.
- **Tommy Thompson Trestle Walk** 2-4 miles round trip · 1-1.5 hrs · Easy — A car-free trail along the waterfront with views of Fidalgo Bay, Mount Baker, and ferry traffic.
- **Washington Park Loop** 2.25 miles · 45-60 min · Easy paved — A paved scenic loop at the island's western tip with panoramic San Juan Islands views, beach access, and tide pool platforms.

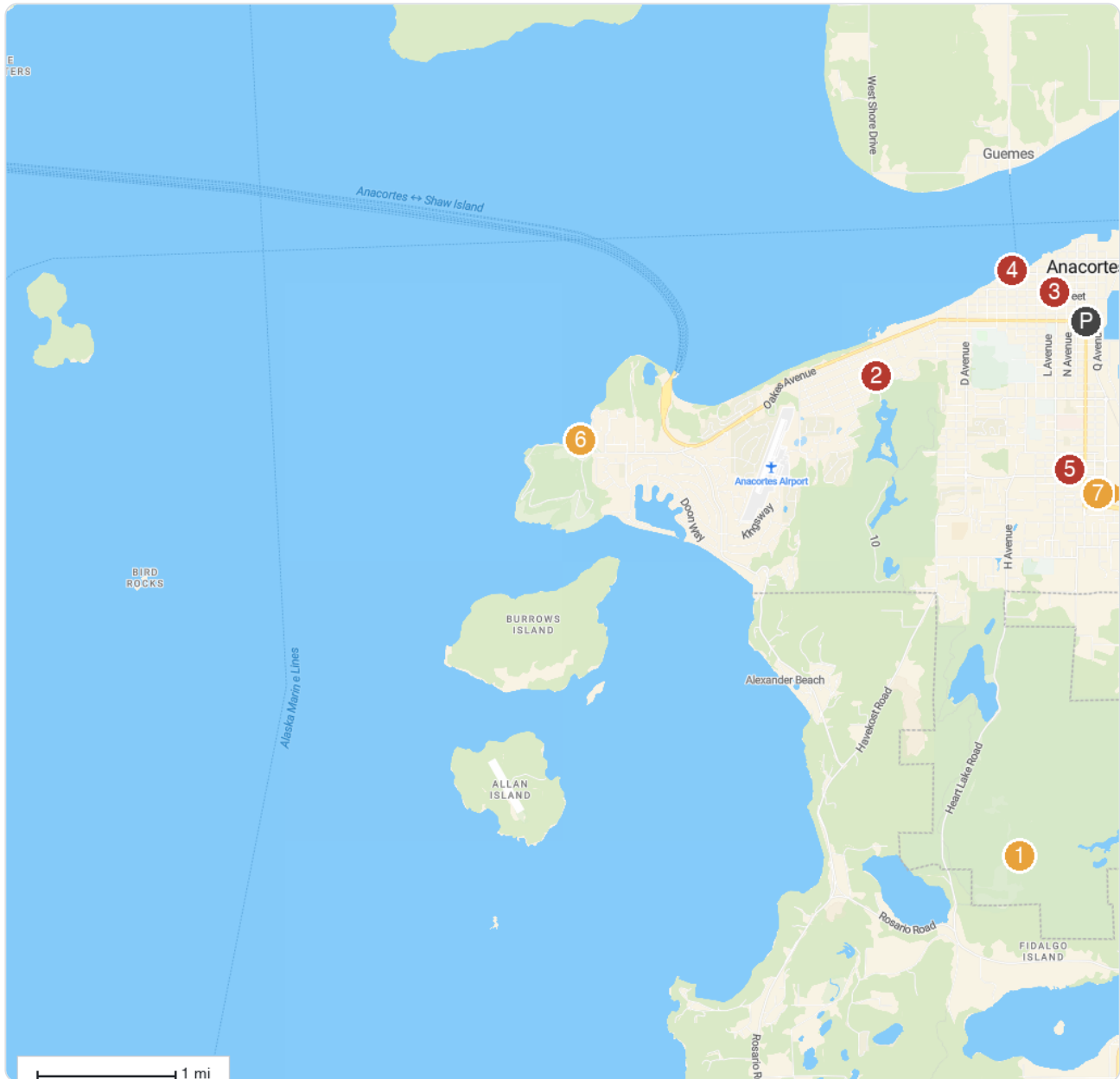
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
