GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Direct at Tindekaia pier, town center; up to 330 m vessels

Walk to center: ~500 m from gangway to main street

Best For: Mountain scenery, scenic railways, fjord hiking

Don't Miss: Romsdalen Gondola or the Rauma Railway round-trip

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  ~100 NOK base + 15 NOK/km

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Trollstigen Mountain Road** — Eleven hairpin bends zig-zag up a near-vertical cliff face alongside a thundering waterfall.
- Romsdalen Gondola** — An electric cable car departs from a base station 5 minutes' walk from the pier, rising to the Nesaksla summit (708 m)...
- Rauma Railway Scenic Round-Trip** — Ranked among Europe's most beautiful rail journeys, this scenic round-trip (about 2.5 hrs) through Romsdalen valley...
- Norwegian Mountaineering Centre** — A sleek museum at the water's edge chronicles Norway's rich climbing history with interactive exhibits, Norway's...
- Full-Day Geiranger & Eagle Road** — The longest day-trip combines Trollstigen with a drive over the Eagle Road (Ørnevegen) to Geiranger village and the...

BEST WALKS

- Pier to Gondola & Town Loop** 1.5 km | Flat | 20–30 min — From Tindekaia pier walk along the waterfront to the Romsdalen Gondola base station, then continue into town past the Rauma Railway...
- Rampestreken Viewpoint (via Gondola)** 1.5 km ridge walk from gondola top | Moderate | 45–60 min each way — Ride the gondola to Nesaksla summit, then follow the signed path along the ridge to Rampestreken — a steel viewing platform that...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book the Rauma Railway early. Seats sell out; use Vy.no or buy at the station first thing — trains fill before 9 AM on ship days.
- Layer up. Mountain weather changes fast. Bring a waterproof jacket even if it looks sunny at the pier.
- Norway is cashless. Cards (Visa/Mastercard) accepted almost everywhere; you rarely need NOK cash for a shore day.
