

Andernach, Rhineland-Palatinate, Germany

One of Germany's oldest cities, Andernach packs medieval walls, the world's tallest cold-water geyser, and a landmark 16th-century stone crane into a compact Rhine riverfront — and Koblenz is just 20 minutes away.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River cruise ships dock at the Rhine quay (Rheinpromenade) — no tender, town center is a 5-minute walk

Best For: Medieval architecture, the Geysir Andernach boat excursion, day trip to Koblenz

Walk to center: ~5 min on foot from the dock to the Alter Kran and Old Town

Don't Miss: The Geysir Andernach — CO₂-driven cold-water geyser erupts up to ~60 m skyward from a Rhine peninsula; boats run roughly every 1.5–2 hours

 Getting around:  Taxi  ~€8–€15 for short local rides

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Geysir Andernach Boat Trip** — Board an excursion boat from the Andernach waterfront to the Nemedyer Werth river peninsula, where a CO₂-driven...
- **Runder Turm & Medieval City Walls** — The Runder Turm (Round Tower) is one of the largest and best-preserved medieval defensive towers in Germany, built in...
- **Alter Kran (Old Crane)** — This 16th-century stone treadwheel crane (built 1554–1561, replacing an earlier wooden one) on the Rhine riverbank is...
- **Liebfrauenkirche & Market Square** — The Church of Our Lady (Liebfrauenkirche) is a handsome late Romanesque and Gothic parish church in the center of the...
- **Day Trip to Koblenz** — Koblenz, just ~18 km south, sits at the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Waterfront Loop** ~2 km | 45–60 min | Easy | All paved — From the dock, walk to the Alter Kran on the riverbank, then follow the Rhine promenade north before turning inland toward the Runder...

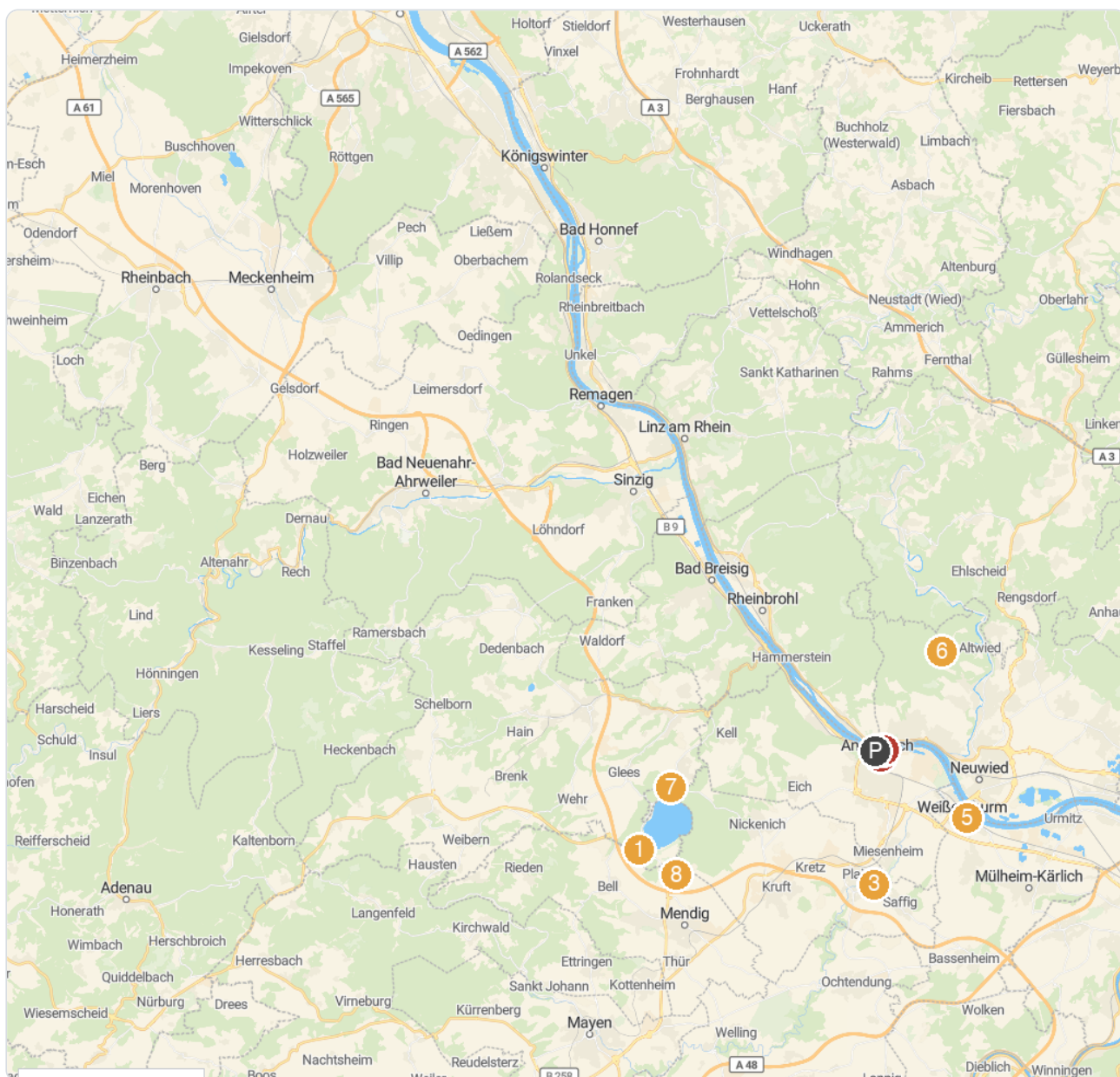
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book the geyser early. The Geysir Andernach boat trip is the highlight of the port and sells out on busy call days. Check your ship's excursion desk or book via the pier booth...
- Cash is useful. Germany is still heavily cash-oriented outside tourist centers. ATMs are available near the market square; bring some euros for the geyser boat ticket, café stops
