GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor offshore at Fresh Creek or Morgan's Bluff; no dedicated cruise terminal

Best For: Diving, snorkeling, bonefishing, blue holes, unspoiled beaches

Walk to center: 5 min from tender dock to Andros Town; Morgan's Bluff is very small with little within walking range

Don't Miss: The Androsia Batik Factory in Fresh Creek and a snorkel on the barrier reef

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  \$25–\$70 ·  **Rideshare**  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Andros Barrier Reef Snorkel or Dive** — The third-longest barrier reef in the world runs 140 miles along Andros's east coast, with wall dives dropping to 6,000...
 - Blue Holes Exploration** — Andros has more ocean and inland blue holes than anywhere on Earth.
 - Bonefishing on the Flats** — Andros is called the Bonefishing Capital of the World.
- Androsia Batik Factory Tour** — A short walk from the Fresh Creek dock, Androsia is Andros's iconic hand-batik fabric studio.
 - Mangrove Kayak & Wildlife** — Paddle through Andros's vast mangrove creek systems, scanning for flamingos, herons, and (rarely) manatees.

BEST WALKS

- Fresh Creek Waterfront & Androsia Factory** 1.5 km · 30 min · Flat · Easy — From the tender dock, stroll along the creek waterfront past fishing boats and modest homes to the Androsia Batik Factory.

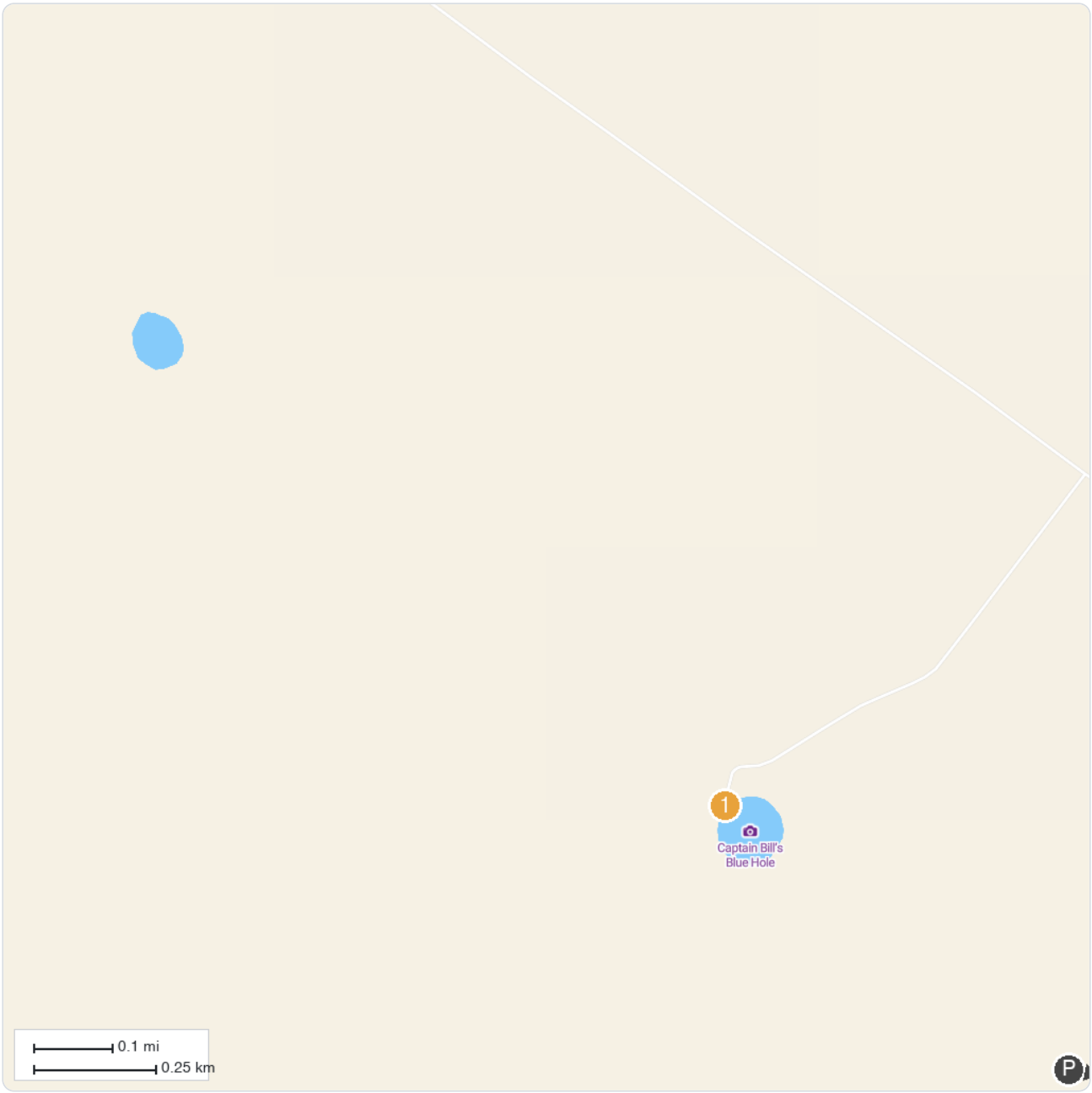

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender discipline matters: Check tender schedules carefully — missing the last tender means a very long taxi to catch your ship at a different anchorage.
- USD works everywhere: The Bahamian dollar is pegged 1:1 to USD. ATMs are scarce on Andros — bring cash from the ship.
- Book reef and blue-hole tours in advance: Andros has few walk-up tour operators. Pre-book through your cruise line or a reputable local operator before sailing.
