GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River cruise ships dock along the Maine River quayside, a short walk from the city center

Best For: Medieval history, the Apocalypse Tapestry, Loire wines, and an unhurried French city vibe

Walk to center: 5-10 min on foot to Château d'Angers and the old town

Don't Miss: The Apocalypse Tapestry inside Château d'Angers — 14th-century, around 100 metres of it surviving (originally ~140 m), utterly extraordinary

Getting around: **Taxi** €5–€15 · **Rideshare** Uber, Bolt

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Château d'Angers & the Apocalypse Tapestry** — This 13th-century fortress with 17 drum towers houses the Tapisserie de l'Apocalypse — a 14th-century masterpiece woven...
 - **Old Town & Maison d'Adam** — Wander the historic Quartier de la Doutre and the old town around Place Sainte-Croix.
 - **David d'Angers Gallery & Musée des Beaux-Arts** — The David d'Angers Gallery (in restored Toussaint Abbey)
- showcases monumental plaster casts by Angers' most famous...

 - **Cointreau Distillery Tour** — Angers is the birthplace of Cointreau, the orange liqueur invented here in 1875.
 - **Loire Valley Vineyard & Château Day** — The Anjou appellation produces some of France's finest whites (Savennières, Chenin Blanc) and rosés.

BEST WALKS

- **Quay to Château & Cathedral Circuit** 2.5 km · ~45-60 min walking · mostly flat — From the Maine River quay, walk uphill to the Château d'Angers entrance on Boulevard du Roi René, then continue east along Rue...
- **Old Town & Maison d'Adam Stroll** 1.5 km · ~30 min · flat — Cross into the heart of the old town via Rue Saint-Laud, find the Maison d'Adam on Place Sainte-Croix near the cathedral, then loop...

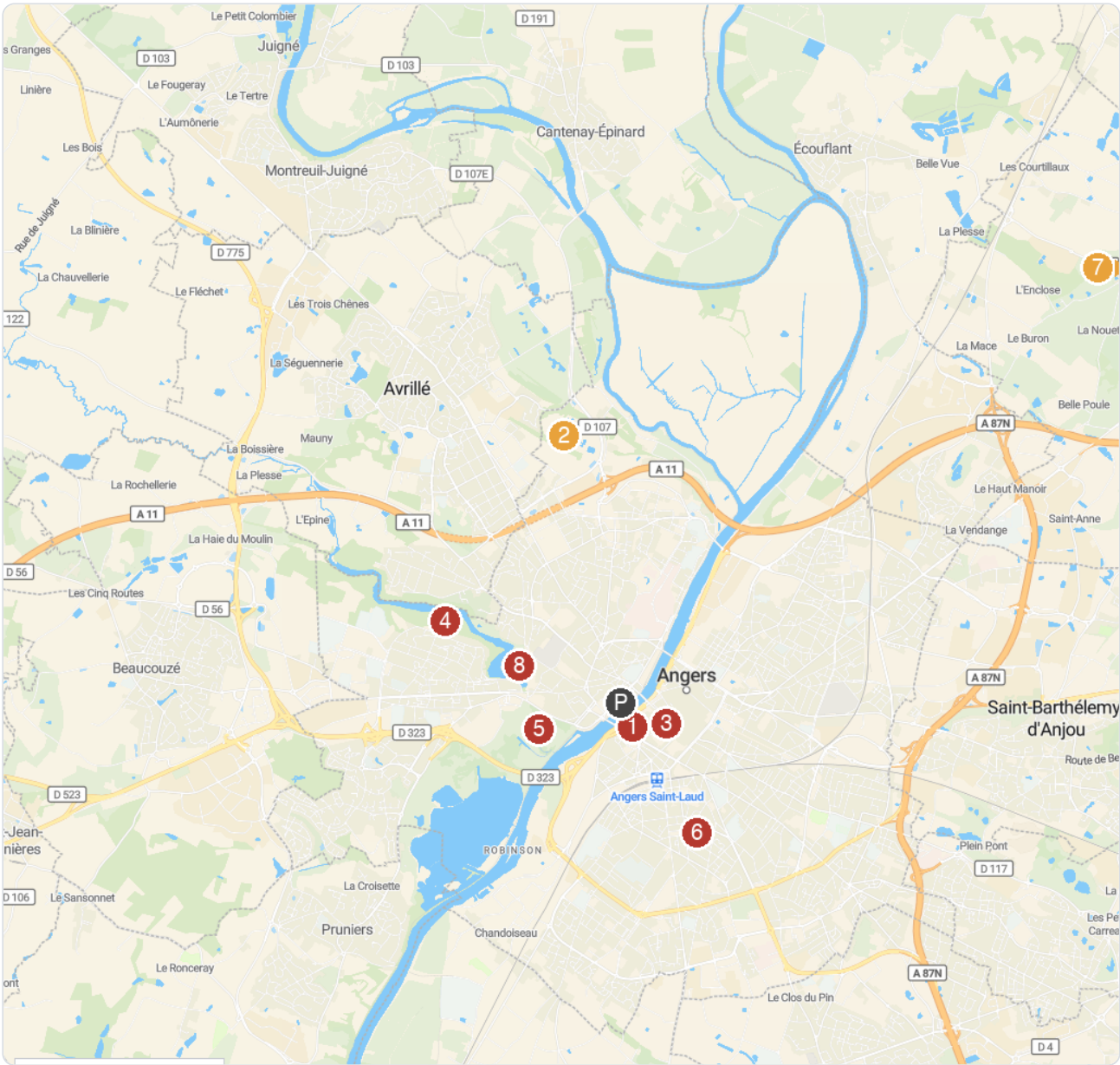
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
