Docking: Tender only — small local boats from river ship to simple village landing

- Village Walking Tour** — A guided stroll through Angkor Ban's lanes, past century-old wooden houses built on stilts with distinctive blue doors...
 - Buddhist Temple & Monk Blessing** — Visit the village's colorful Buddhist temple, admire traditional Khmer murals, and — if timing allows — receive a...

- Village School & Community Visit** — Some itineraries include a stop at the local school, where passengers meet children and teachers and donate school...
 - Mekong Riverbank & Rice Paddy Walk** — Wander the village edges to watch fishermen cast nets on the Mekong, farmers tending rice paddies, and the slow...

- Village Loop Walk** 1.5 km · Easy · ~45 min — From the landing, walk through the main village lane past stilted wooden houses, past the Buddhist temple, and loop back along the...

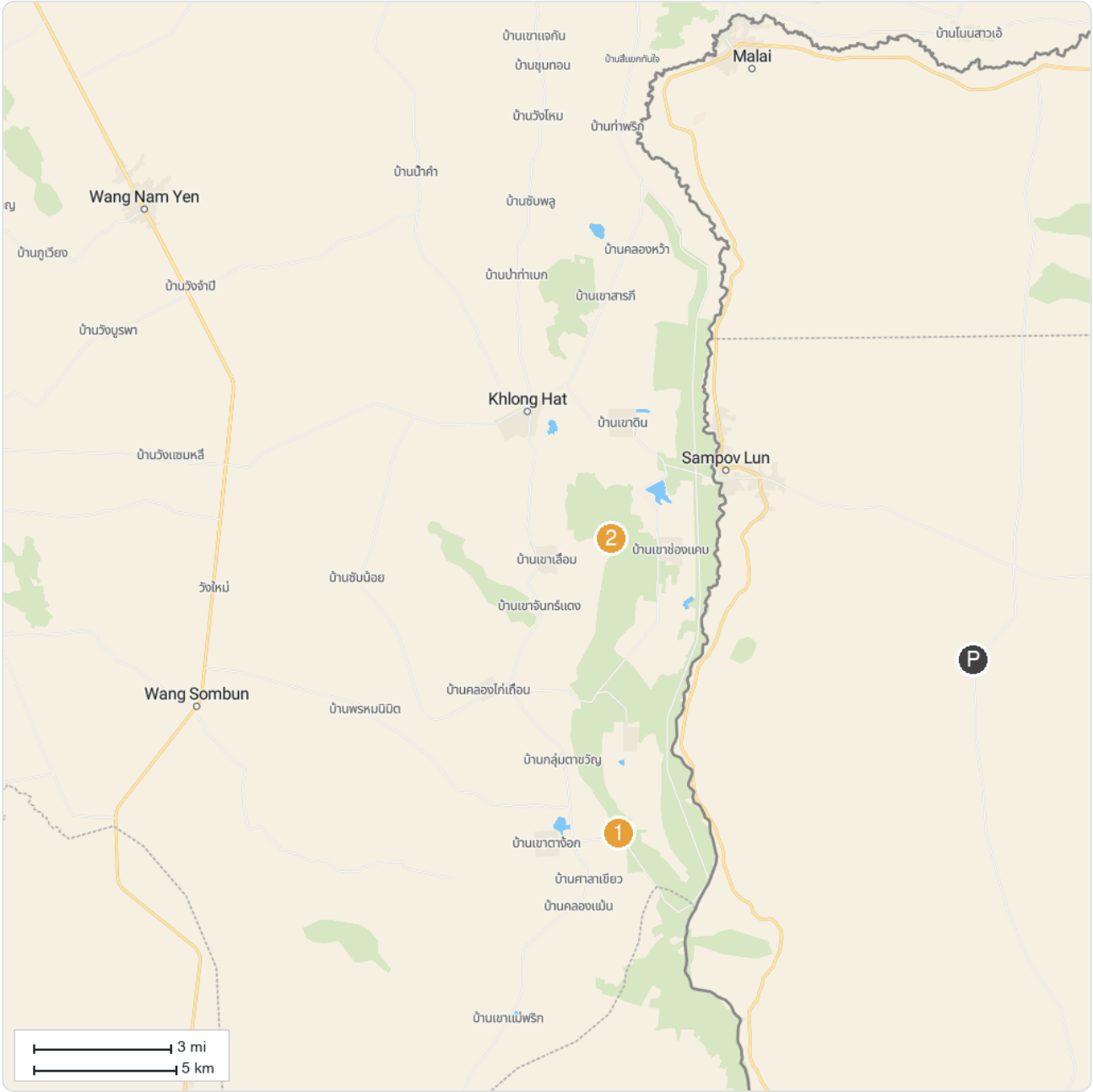
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Cash only, no ATM. Bring USD in small bills (\$1, \$5) or Cambodian Riel. USD is widely accepted in Cambodia. There is nowhere to exchange money in the village.
- Dress modestly. Shoulders and knees should be covered, especially when visiting the temple. Lightweight linen is ideal for the heat and humidity.
- Wet season (June–October) = muddy paths. Sturdy closed-toe shoes are essential year-round; sandals will not serve you on unpaved village tracks.
