- **Colonial Historic Center Walk** — From the tender pier, stroll Rua do Comércio past Igreja de Santa Luzia (1632) and the baroque Convento do Carmo — both...
- **Praia do Dentista Beach Stop** — Gipóia Island's famous Praia do Dentista — a sheltered white-sand cove with calm, streets, whitewashed Portuguese...
- **Day Trip to Paraty** — About 90 minutes by road, the UNESCO-listed colonial town of Paraty offers cobblestone streets, whitewashed Portuguese...

BEST WALKS

- **Historic Center Stroll** 1-2 km · 30-45 min · Easy — From Estação Santa Luzia pier, walk northwest along Rua do Comércio to Igreja de Santa Luzia, then continue to Convento do Carmo...
- **Waterfront to Praia Grande** ~3 km one way · 45-60 min · Easy — Head east along the waterfront from the pier past the naval academy complex (Colégio Naval) toward Praia Grande.

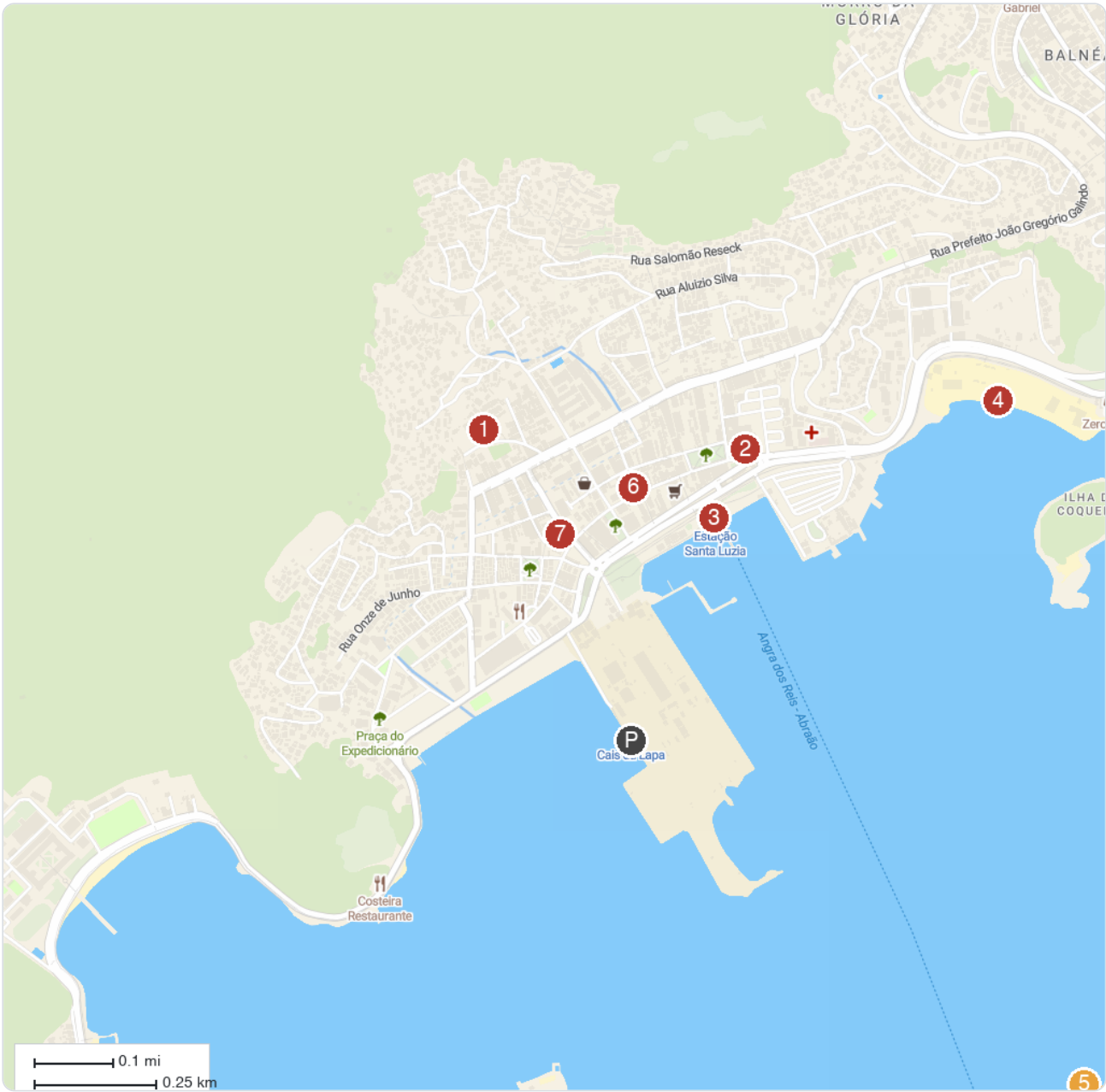
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Get a tender ticket early. Queues for tenders can be long after 9 AM — get on the first or second run to maximize island time.
- Bring Reais or a card. USD/EUR are rarely accepted. ATMs are available in the city center; most tour boats prefer cash for extras.
- Shoulder-season showers are brief. The Costa Verde is humid year-round — bring a light rain layer; squalls pass quickly and the sun returns fast.
