TOP THINGS TO DO

- **La Portada and the Coastal Walk** — Walk along the coastal promenade (Avenida Costanera) and visit La Portada, the iconic natural stone arch offering...
 - **Huanchaca Ruins** — Explore the 19th-century silver refinery ruins that tell the story of Antofagasta's mining boom and the region's...
- **Desert and Coast Exploration** — Take a guided tour into the Atacama Desert, exploring the rugged terrain and the striking contrast between the arid...
 - **City Center and Local Markets** — Explore the downtown area, visiting local markets and tasting traditional Chilean seafood and northern delicacies.

BEST WALKS

- **The Waterfront Promenade** Easy — A flat, scenic walk along the coast, perfect for watching the sunset and observing the local wildlife.
- **Downtown Exploration** Moderate — A walk through the central business district, visiting local plazas and small shops.
- **Hillside Lookout** Challenging — A climb up to the higher points of the city for a bird's-eye view of the port and the desert.

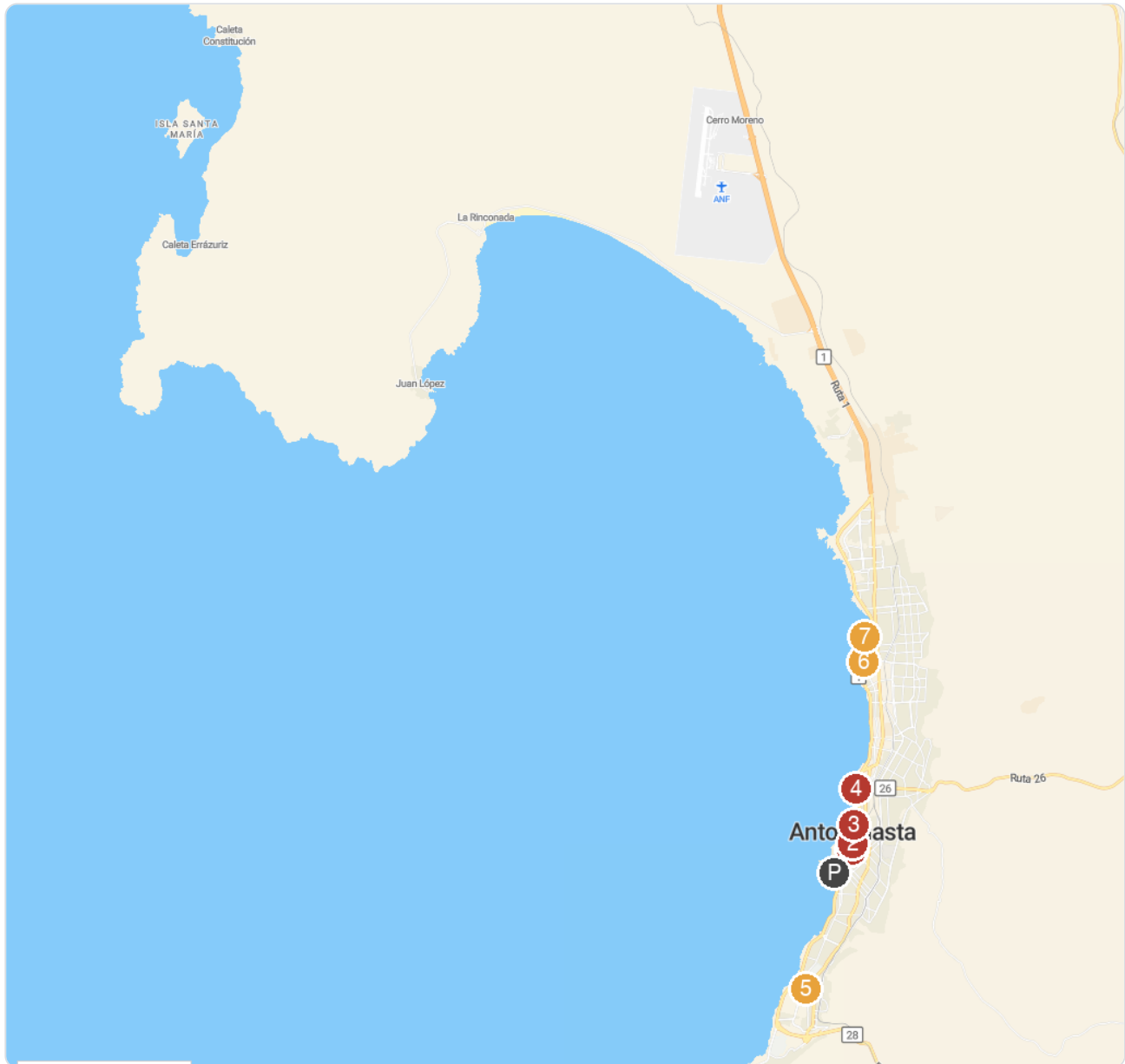
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
