GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Canal mooring at Port d'Occitanie on the Canal du Midi

Walk to centre: 5 min from the canal port to the village centre

Best For: Wine tasting, cycling the towpath, Cathar history, slow travel

Don't Miss: The start of the Grand Bief — a 54 km lock-free stretch of the Canal du Midi

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  €10–20 in village; €45–60 to Narbonne; €75–95 to Carcassonne

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Carcassonne — Medieval Citadel** — The spectacular walled city of Carcassonne is just 33 km away.
- **Minerve — A Village Perché in the Gorge** — Rated one of France's Most Beautiful Villages, Minerve is a dramatic Cathar stronghold perched on a rocky spur above...
- **Minervois Wine Tasting** — The surrounding Minervois AOC produces excellent reds and rosés.
- **Narbonne — Roman City & Cathedral** — Narbonne, about 35 km away, was once the capital of Roman Gaul.
- **Cycle the Canal du Midi Towpath** — The Canal du Midi towpath is flat, shaded by centuries-old plane trees, and ideal for cycling.

BEST WALKS

- **Village & Canal Locks Loop** 45 min · Flat · Canal towpath & village streets — Start at Port d'Occitanie, walk the towpath past the Écluses d'Argens, then climb into the medieval village centre to see Château...
- **Towpath to Lac des Aiguilles** 1.5 hr round trip · Flat · Canal towpath & lakeside path — Follow the canal towpath south from Port d'Occitanie then branch off to Lac des Aiguilles for a peaceful lakeside walk.

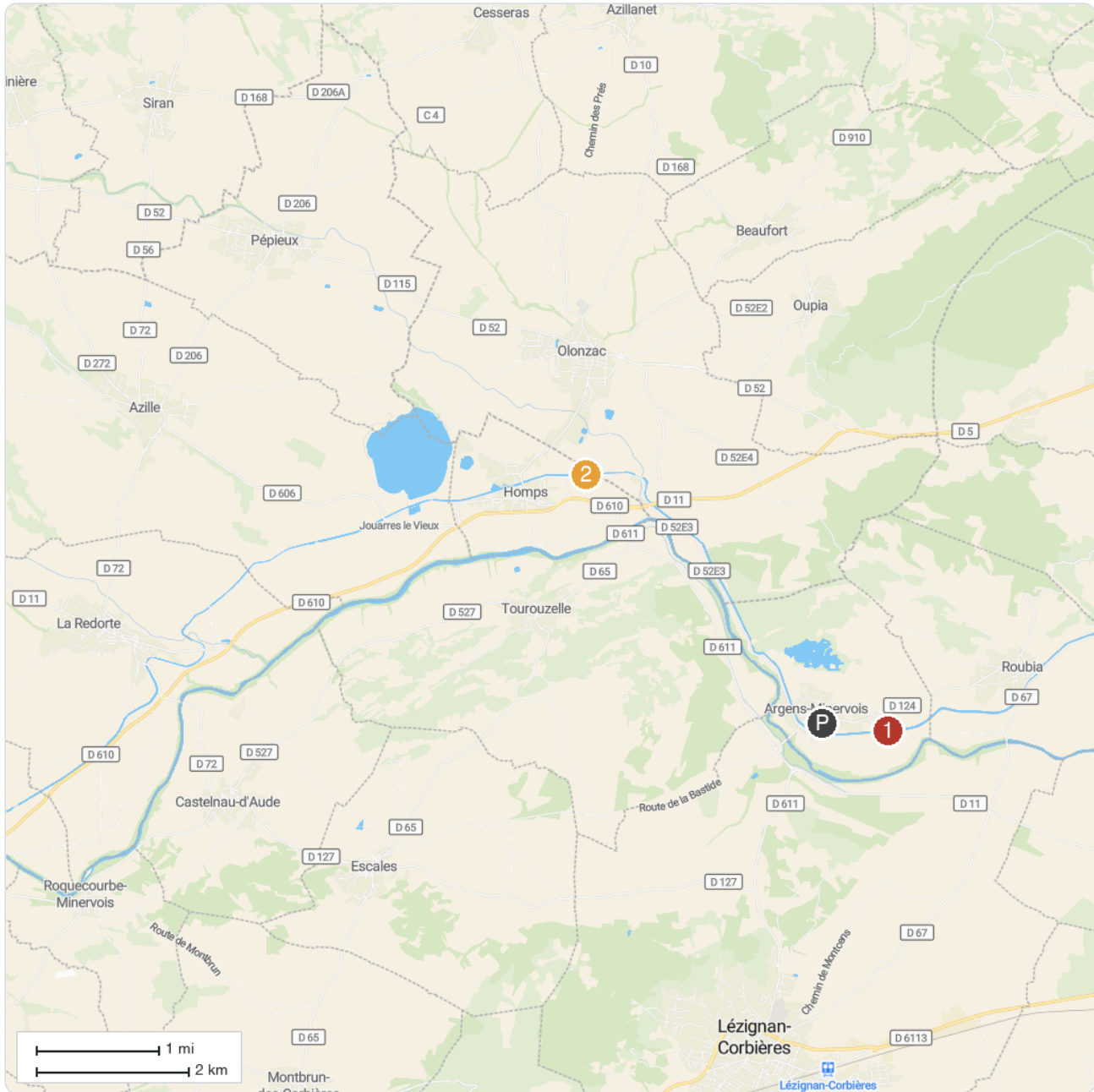
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
