- **The Mummies of the Chinchorro** — Visit the San Miguel de Azapa Archaeological Museum to see the world's oldest artificially mummified remains, predating...
- **El Morro de Arica** — Ascend the coastal cliff for panoramic views of the city and the Pacific Ocean.
- **Playa Chinchorro Promenade** — Stroll the revitalized seaside promenade at Playa Chinchorro, enjoying ocean views, local seafood, and artisan markets...
- **Azapa Valley** — Explore the fertile green oasis of the Azapa Valley, known for its agriculture and local markets selling fresh olives...

BEST WALKS

- **City Center Stroll** City Center, Plaza de Armas, Local Markets — Walk from the port to the Plaza de Armas, exploring the local shops and the colonial architecture of the city center.
- **El Morro Walk** El Morro, Coastal Cliff — Walk from the port to the base of El Morro and climb the stairs to the top for a view of the Pacific Ocean.
- **Arica Port** Terminal Portuario de Arica — The main hub for cruise passengers, providing easy access to the city's main attractions.

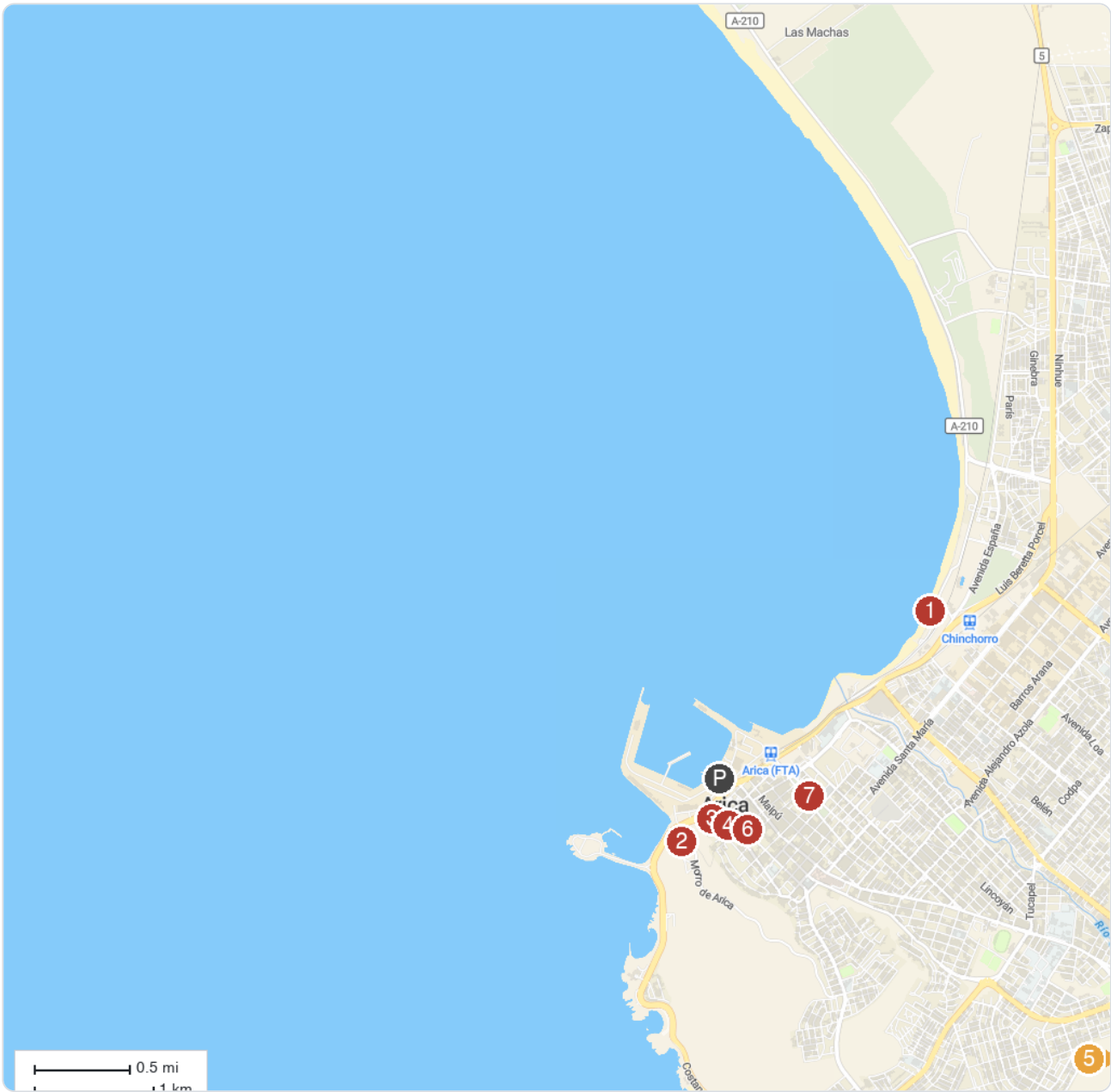
