GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — expedition ships anchor offshore; large cruise ships visit via shore excursion from Le Havre or Cherbourg

Best For: WWII history, D-Day beaches, sombre reflection, coastal walks

Walk to centre: Tender lands at the seafront, beach and museum within 5 min walk

Don't Miss: Mulberry Harbour remains at low tide and Arromanches 360 Circular Cinema

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Musée du Débarquement (D-Day Landing Museum)** — The museum sits right on the seafront and tells the story of the Mulberry B harbour through scale models, original...
- **Mulberry Harbour Remains (Port Winston)** — The concrete caissons (Phoenix units) of the Allied artificial harbour are still visible in the bay and on the beach.
- **Arromanches 360 Circular Cinema** — A 360° panoramic cinema screens 'The 100 Days of Normandy', blending archival D-Day footage with modern shots of the...
- **Omaha Beach & Normandy American Cemetery** — A 20-minute drive west brings you to Omaha Beach and the Colleville-sur-Mer cemetery, where nearly 10,000 American...
- **Pointe du Hoc Ranger Memorial** — The cliff-top promontory where U.S.

BEST WALKS

- **Seafront to Mulberry Harbour Walk** 1.5 km • Easy • 30–45 min — From the tender pier, walk east along the promenade past the Musée du Débarquement, then continue along the beach to view the Mulberry...
- **Seafront to Arromanches 360** 0.5 km • Short uphill • 10 min — From the seafront, follow Rue du Lieutenant Colonel Hewitt uphill to the Arromanches 360 Circular Cinema on the clifftop.

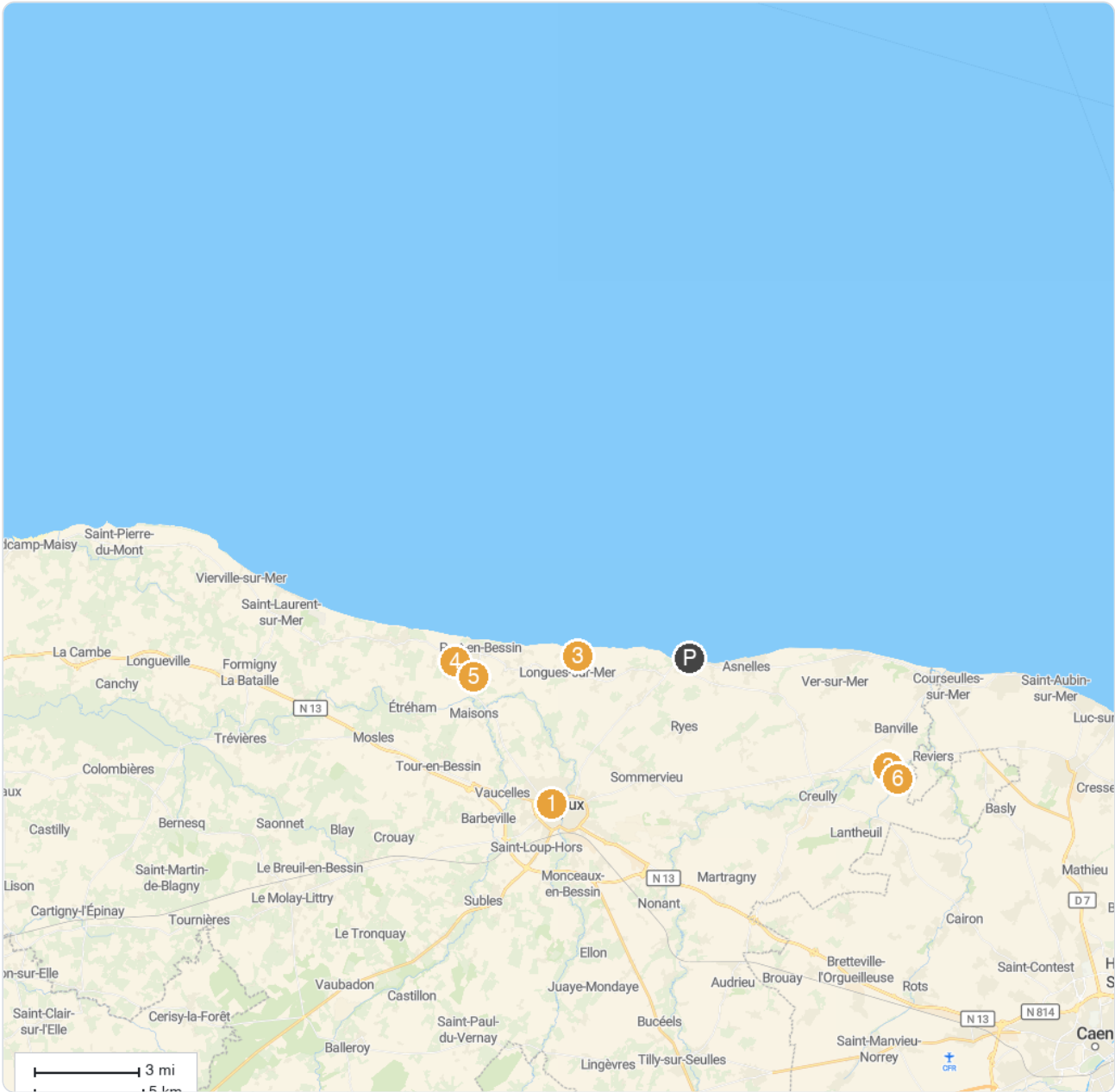
