GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside on the Main River — bayernhafen pier or Floßhafen municipal pier, both near center

Don't Miss: Schloss Johannsburg and the Pompejanum side by side on the riverbank

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Schloss Johannsburg** — This imposing red-sandstone Renaissance palace (1605–1614) was the seat of the prince-bishops of Mainz.
 - **Pompejanum** — A full-scale replica of a Pompeian villa commissioned by King Ludwig I of Bavaria, perched above the Main with a...
- **Stiftsbasilika St. Peter und Alexander** — Aschaffenburg's collegiate church dates to the 10th century and blends Romanesque and Gothic styles.
 - **Schönbusch Palace & Park** — Bavaria's oldest English-style landscaped park (est.
 - **Aschaffenburg Old Town (Altstadt)** — Wander cobbled lanes past half-timbered houses from around 1600, the Baroque Church of Our Lady, the municipal theatre...

BEST WALKS

- **Palace & Riverfront Stroll** 2 km · 30–40 min · flat — From the pier, walk upriver to Johannsburg Palace, then continue through the Schlossgarten to the Pompejanum.
- **Altstadt Loop** 2.5 km · 40–50 min · flat — Head into the Old Town from the pier past the Stiftsbasilika, explore Dalbergstraße and the market square, then loop back along the...

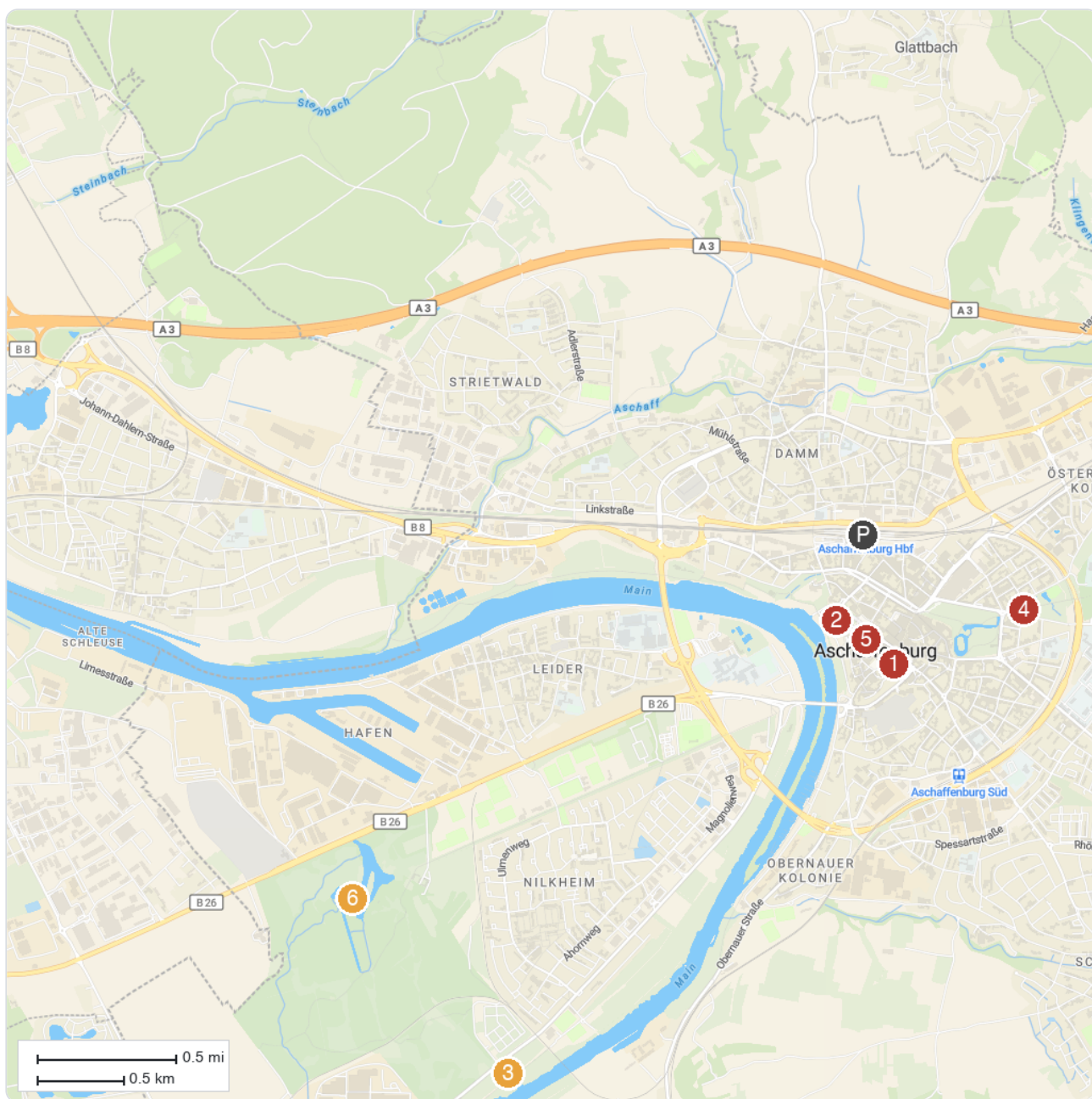
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
