## GETTING ASHORE

**Docking:** Pier 1, western edge of historic downtown — no tendering

**Best For:** History buffs, craft-beer lovers, scenic photography

**Walk to center:** 5-10 min along the Riverwalk to Commercial St shops

**Don't Miss:** Astoria Column views + Columbia River Maritime Museum

## TOP THINGS TO DO

- Astoria Column** — Climb 164 spiral steps inside this 125-foot hilltop tower to panoramic views of the Columbia River, Pacific Ocean, and...
  - Columbia River Maritime Museum** — One of the best maritime museums on the West Coast, sitting right on the waterfront.
- Fort Clatsop / Lewis & Clark National Historical Park** — A replica of the fort where Lewis & Clark and the Corps of Discovery spent the winter of 1805-06 before returning east.
  - Fort Stevens & Peter Iredale Shipwreck** — The rusting skeleton of the 1906 four-masted steel barque Peter Iredale is one of the most photogenic shipwrecks on the...
  - Craft Brewery Tour** — Astoria has an outsized craft brewing scene.

## BEST WALKS

- Astoria Riverwalk** 1.5 miles one-way · Flat · 30-40 min — Follow the old railroad bed along the Columbia River from Pier 1 through downtown to the east end.
- Historic Downtown Astoria** 0.5 miles · Flat · 1-2 hrs with stops — Head up 14th Street from the Riverwalk to the Flavel House Museum (stunning 1885 Queen Anne mansion), then along Commercial Street for...
