GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Pera Yialos (Skala Bay) — no large-ship pier

Best For: Charming village strolls, castle views, boat trips to islets

Walk to Chora: ~10–15 min uphill on foot from the old port

Don't Miss: Venetian Querini Castle and the row of 8 whitewashed windmills

 Getting around:  Taxi  ~€5–€10 ·  Rideshare  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Chora & Venetian Castle** — Climb the cobblestone lanes of the whitewashed Chora to the 13th-century Querini Castle.
- **Boat Trip to Kounoupa & Koutsomiti Islets** — Day cruise to the uninhabited islets just offshore, with some of the clearest azure water in the Dodecanese.
- **Livadi Beach** — A short walk from Chora (or quick bus ride), Livadi is Astypalaia's most organized beach — crystal-clear water...
- **Self-Drive Boat Hire** — Rent a small motorboat from Pera Yialos (no licence required for under 30hp) and explore Red Rock (Kokkinos Gremos)...
- **Windmills & Village Wander** — Astypalaia's eight restored windmills line the ridge above Chora, painted white with maroon trim.

BEST WALKS

- **Pera Yialos Port to Venetian Castle** ~1.5 km | 30–40 min up | Easy–Moderate — From the tender quay walk up through the lower waterfront, into Chora's winding lanes, past the windmills, and up the final steps to...
- **Chora to Livadi Beach** ~1 km | 15–20 min | Easy (downhill) — A gentle downhill walk from Chora leads to Livadi, the island's most popular beach.

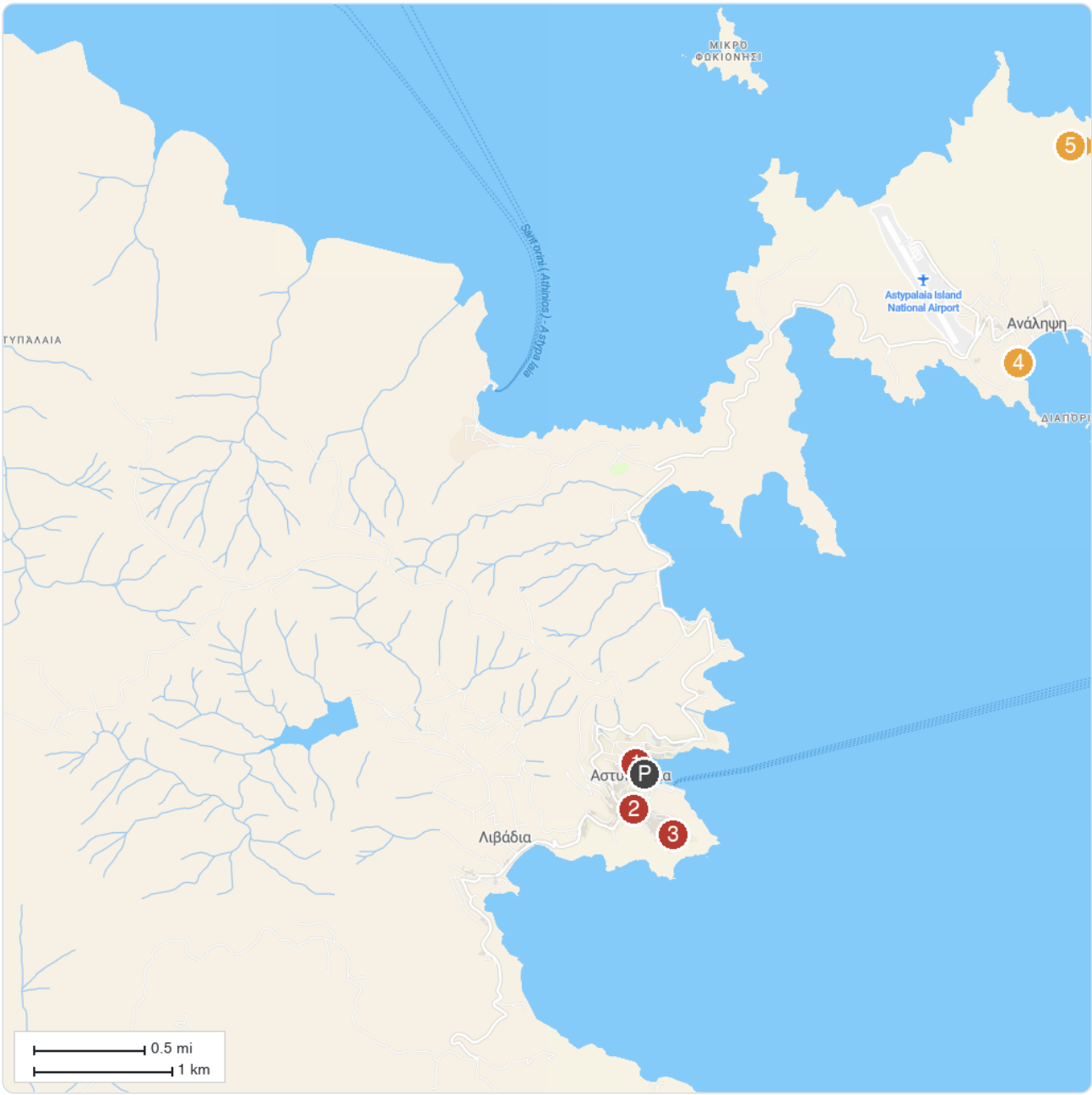
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender timing matters. Astypalaia has no sheltered pier — in choppy Aegean conditions tenders may be delayed or cut short. Check with your ship for the last tender back.
- Bring euros in cash. Card acceptance is limited in smaller tavernas and the boat-hire operators at the port.
- Remote beaches need wheels. Kaminakia and Vatses require a rough dirt road — rent a scooter or 4WD if you want to explore
