TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Auberge Ravoux — Van Gogh's Final Room** — The inn where Van Gogh lived and died in July 1890.
- **Van Gogh Grave & Village Cemetery** — Vincent and his brother Théo lie side by side beneath simple stone slabs covered in ivy, on a sunlit terrace above the...
- **Château d'Auvers — Impressionist Journey** — A 17th-century château housing an acclaimed immersive multimedia experience on Impressionism — sound, light, and...
- **Church of Notre-Dame d'Auvers & Painting Spots Walk** — Stand in front of the 12th-century church Van Gogh immortalized in 1890 and follow the Artist's Pathway — plaques...
- **Musée Daubigny & Doctor Gachet's House** — The Musée Daubigny showcases Charles-François Daubigny, the Barbizon master who attracted artists to Auvers.

BEST WALKS

- **Van Gogh Village Loop** 2-3 km · 1.5-2 hrs · Easy · Free — From the quay, walk to Auberge Ravoux, then to the Church of Notre-Dame, up to the village cemetery and Van Gogh's grave, and back...
- **Wheat Fields & Château Walk** 3-4 km · 1.5 hrs · Easy · Free — Head uphill from the village center through the wheat fields Van Gogh painted in his last days, swing past the Château d'Auvers for...

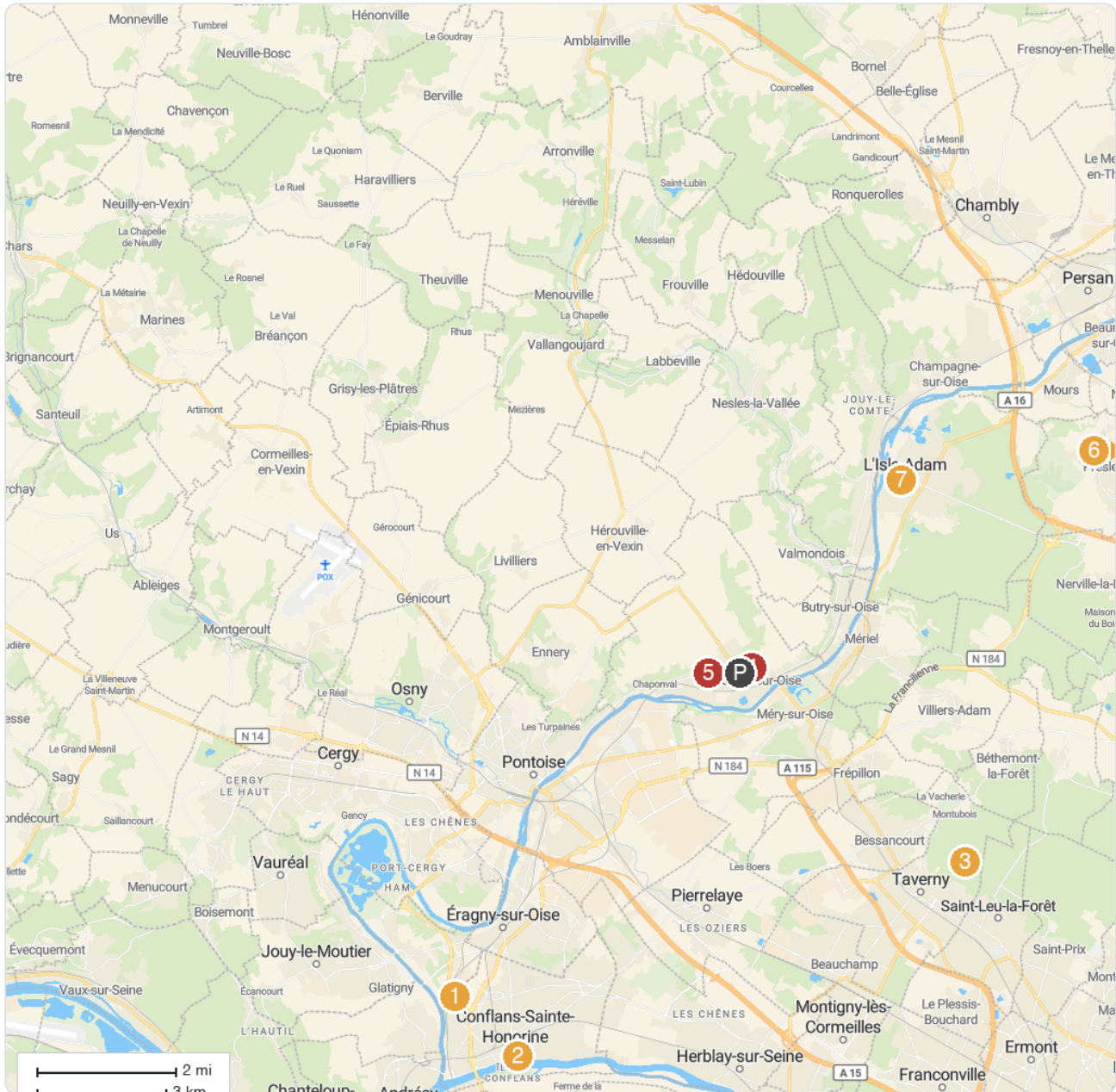
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
