Docking: No cruise pier — expedition ships use Zodiacs or anchor off Garris Landing

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Bulls Island & Boneyard Beach** — Take the ferry from Garris Landing to Bulls Island, a largely undeveloped barrier island inside Cape Romain National...
 - Palmetto Trail — Awendaw Passage** — A 7.1-mile trail through Francis Marion National Forest weaving between longleaf pine forest and salt marsh.
 - Lowcountry Swamp Kayak Tour** — Paddle through the blackwater creeks and bottomland hardwood forest of
- Francis Marion National Forest with guides from...

 - Center for Birds of Prey** — A short drive from Garris Landing, this acclaimed center houses nearly 50 raptor species — eagles, falcons, hawks, owls...
 - Sewee Shell Ring & Visitor Center** — Walk the one-mile Sewee Shell Ring Trail to a 4,000-year-old Native American oyster-shell mound, one of the oldest...

BEST WALKS

- Sewee Shell Ring Trail** 1 mile | Easy | Francis Marion National Forest — A flat, self-guided loop through longleaf pine scrub to a 4,000-year-old pre-Columbian shell mound.
- I'on Swamp Trail** ~2 miles | Easy | Francis Marion National Forest — A historic 1700s-era trail through wet pine flatwoods and swamp edges.

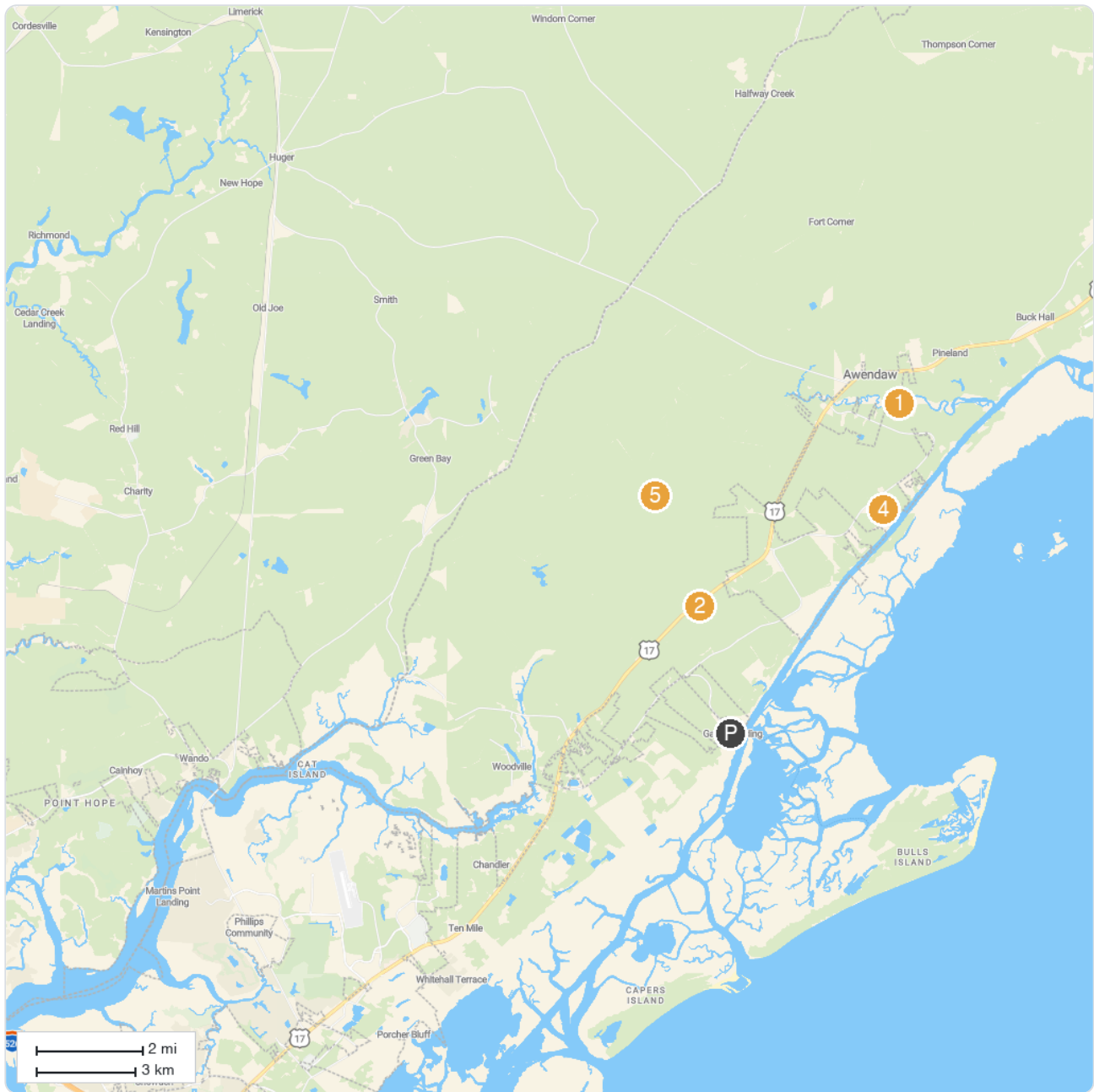
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
