GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small ships berth at Ayia Napa Marina; larger vessels anchor offshore and tender to the marina quayside

Best For: Beaches, sea caves, coastal hiking, boat trips

Walk to center: ~5 min from marina to Ayia Napa town center

Don't Miss: Cape Greco National Park and a boat trip to the sea caves

Getting around: Taxi €5–10 · Rideshare Bolt

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Cape Greco National Park** — Hike or drive the dramatic headland southeast of town: sea arches, the Kamara tou Koraka (Lovers' Bridge), sea caves...
- Coastal Boat Trip — Sea Caves & Blue Lagoon** — Half-day cruises depart the marina to the Ayia Napa sea caves, Cape Greco, Konnos Bay, and sometimes Famagusta's...
- Nissi Beach** — Ayia Napa's most famous beach: powdery white sand, a tidal sandbar linking to Nissi Island, and vivid turquoise shallows.
- Ayia Napa Monastery & Town Center** — The 16th-century Venetian monastery sits at the heart of town — one of the best-preserved on Cyprus.
- Famagusta Ghost Town Day Trip** — Varosha, the abandoned resort district of Famagusta, was partially reopened to visitors in 2020.

BEST WALKS

- Marina to Monastery & Town Square** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy — From the marina, walk into town along the main pedestrian strip to Ayia Napa Monastery and the central square.
- Coastal Path toward Cape Greco** 3-5 km one-way · 1-2 hrs · Easy-moderate — Head southeast along the coastal path from the marina past Makronissos Beach toward the sea caves and Cape Greco headland.

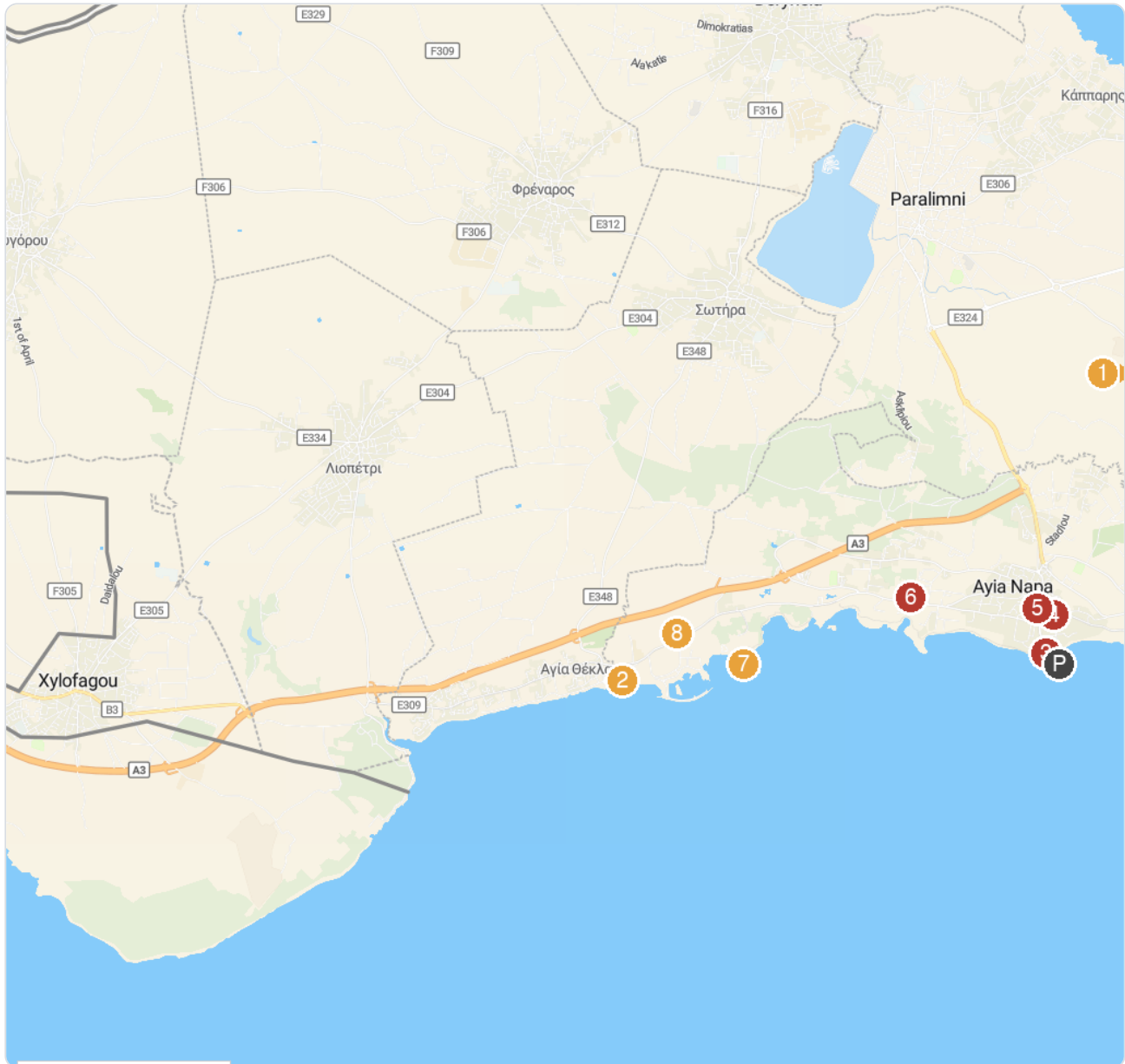
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
