GETTING ASHORE

Docking: KD landing stage on the Rhine riverfront, Leinpfad — steps from the old town gate

Best For: Medieval architecture, Riesling wine tasting, Rhine scenery, castle hikes

Walk to center: 2 min on foot from the pier to the Marktplatz

Don't Miss: Burg Stahleck for panoramic Rhine views and Wernerkapelle Gothic ruins

Getting around: **Taxi** Minimal (short distances) · **Rideshare** Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Burg Stahleck Castle** — The 12th-century castle above town offers sweeping Rhine Valley views.
 - **Wernerkapelle Gothic Ruins** — The roofless 13th-century Werner Chapel sits on the hillside above town.
 - **Riesling Wine Tasting** — The Bacharacher Riesling is world-class.
- **Rhine Gorge River Cruise** — Board a KD or Bingen-Rüdesheimer day boat for a scenic stretch of the Rhine Gorge toward the Loreley Rock and St.
 - **Vineyard & Town Wall Walk** — The Stadtmauer-Rundweg follows Bacharach's intact medieval walls and towers (Marktturm, Postenturm) through the...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Town Walls Loop** 1 hr | Easy–Moderate | Medieval streets and ramparts — Start at the KD quay and walk through the Markttor (beneath the Marktturm) into the old town.
- **Castle & Chapel Hike** 1.5–2 hrs | Moderate | Castle ruins and panoramic Rhine views — From Marktplatz, follow vineyard paths uphill to the Wernerkapelle Gothic ruins, then continue to Burg Stahleck castle for sweeping...

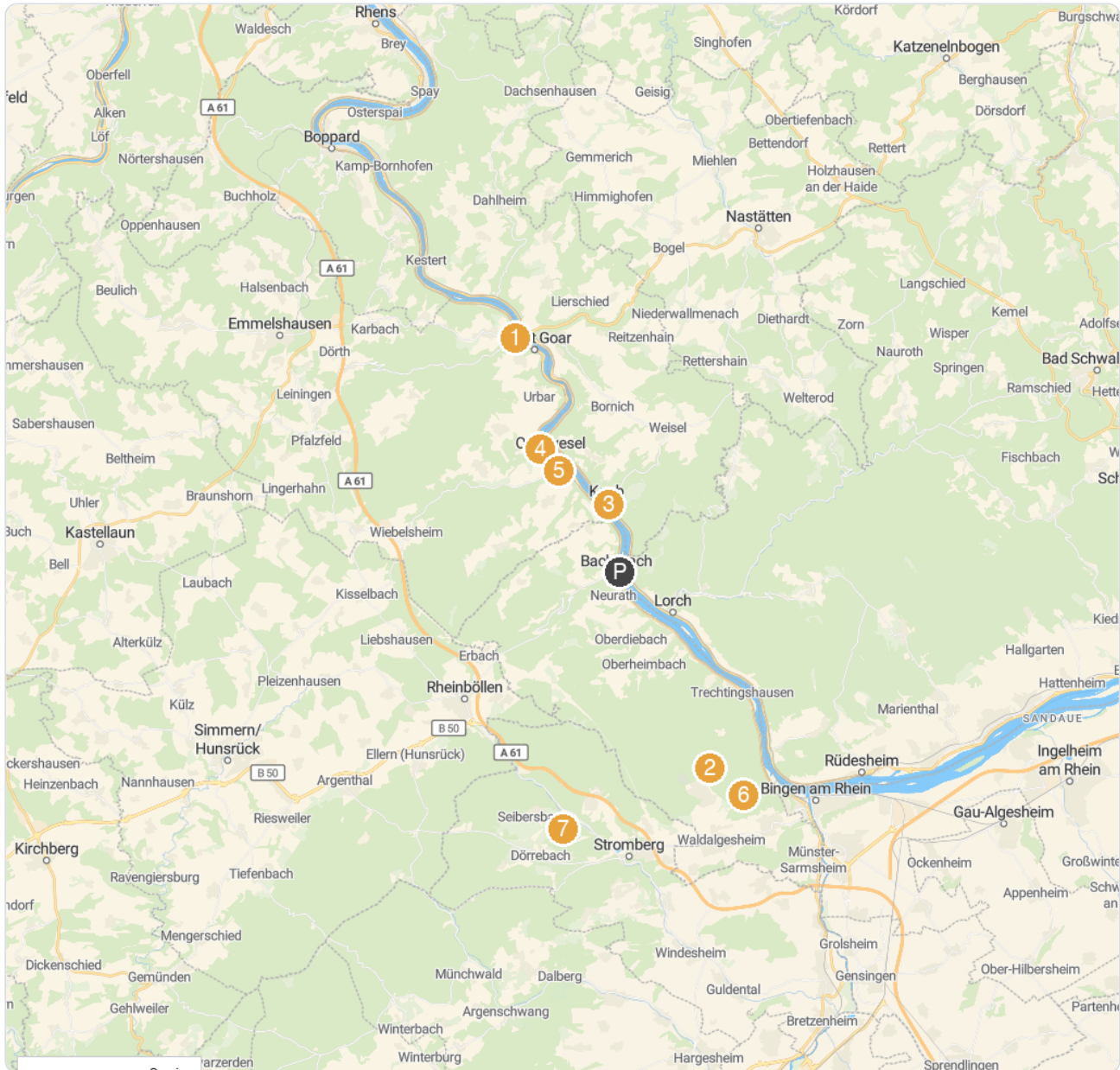
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Compact and walkable: The entire old town fits within a 10-minute stroll. You can see the main sights and still have time for a wine tasting — no transport needed.
- Castle hike is worth it: The 20–30 min uphill walk to Burg Stahleck gives the best views on the Middle Rhine. Wear comfortable shoes; the path is well-marked but steep in spots.
