TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Römer-Thermen Thermal Baths** — Bad Breisig's signature attraction: warm mineral water drawn from 600 m deep fills indoor and outdoor pools (28–34°C)...
- **Schloss Rheineck** — A hilltop castle with 12th-century origins (rebuilt in Romanesque-revival style in the 1830s) towering above Bad...
- **Andernach Cold-Water Geyser** — The world's highest cold-water geyser erupts periodically near Andernach, about 12 km south.
- **Maria Laach Abbey** — One of Germany's finest Romanesque churches, this Benedictine abbey sits on the shore of the Laacher See crater lake...
- **Brohltal Narrow-Gauge Railway (Vulkan-Express)** — A narrow-gauge railway operating since 1901 (steam and diesel) climbs nearly 400 m from the Rhine valley into the...

BEST WALKS

- **Rhine Promenade & Spa Park Stroll** 1.5 km · Easy · 30-40 min — Walk the pedestrianised Rhine promenade from the dock, passing the spa gardens (Kurpark) and the Römer-Thermen, then loop back through...
- **Schloss Rheineck Hill Walk** 3 km round trip · Moderate · 60-80 min — From the promenade, follow signed footpaths up through vineyards and woodland toward Schloss Rheineck (privately owned, viewed from...

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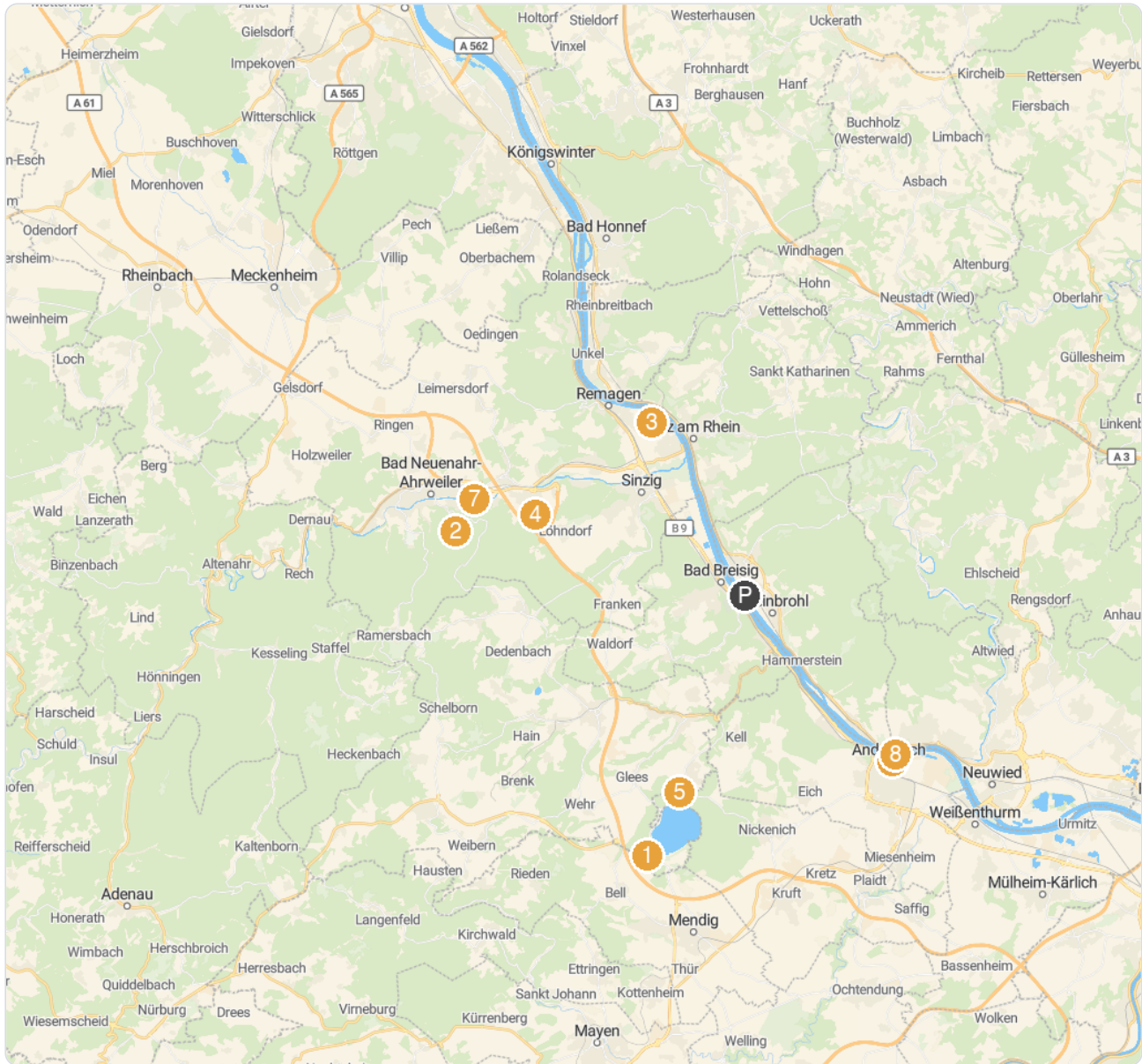
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Historic Benedictine abbey by a volcanic lake.

A peace chapel housing the revered Black Madonna statue.

A historic lookout tower with panoramic views of the Rhine.

7 Lenné Park

A beautifully landscaped historic park designed by Lenné.

2 Forest Adventure Treeclimbing Park Bad Neuenahr

An adventure park for tree climbing and ropes courses.

4 Sitzbank XXL

A giant, oversized wooden bench offering scenic views.

6 Schlossgarten

A beautiful castle garden perfect for a leisurely stroll.

8 Andernach Bollwerk

Historic medieval city wall and defensive tower in Andernach.
