GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River ships tie up at the MYC Mittelland marina on the Mittelland Canal, ~1.5 km from the historic town center.

Best For: Half-timbered architecture, castle day-trips, spa culture, canal cycling, and dinosaur tracks.

Walk to center: ~20-minute flat walk or short taxi from the canal quay to the market square.

Don't Miss: The 150-million-year-old dinosaur tracks at Barkhausen (a district of Bad Essen) and the moated Schloss Hünnefeld.

 Getting around:  Taxi  €10–€20

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Historic Old Town Walk** — Stroll the market square and surrounding streets to admire well-preserved half-timbered buildings that place Bad Essen...
- **Schloss Hünnefeld** — A moated castle first documented in 1146, with a late-Renaissance manor house (built c.1600–1614) and a round dovecote...
- **Dinosaur Tracks at Barkhausen** — One of Germany's most unusual day-trip attractions: 150-million-year-old sauropod and theropod footprints preserved in...
- **Schloss Ippenburg Garden Exhibition** — A neo-Gothic aristocratic estate (the current house built 1862–1867 on older foundations) celebrated for its gardens...
- **SolePark & Brine Pools** — Bad Essen's spa heritage is on full display in the SolePark, where salty brine trickles over blackthorn hedges to...

BEST WALKS

- **Marina to Market Square** 1.5 km · ~20 min · Flat — Walk from the MYC Mittelland marina along the canal path, then turn south toward the town center.
- **Old Town Timber-Frame Loop** 2 km · ~30 min · Flat — From the market square, follow the signed German Timber-Frame Road route through the historic core.

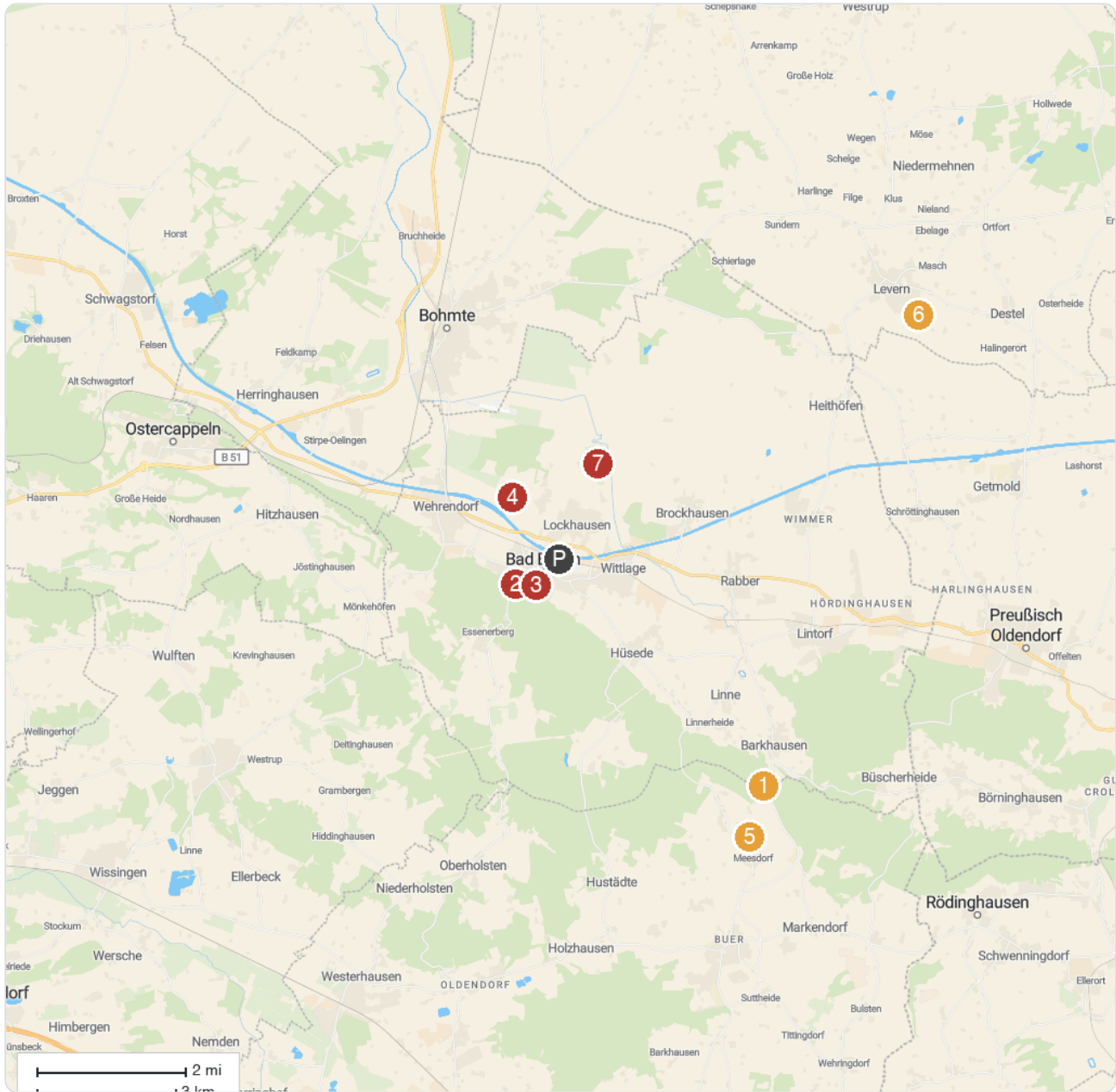
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
