Docking: Ships berth at Baddeck public wharf, steps from the waterfront

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site** — The world's largest collection of Bell artifacts is right here in the village — a short walk from the wharf.
 - Bras d'Or Lake Boat Tour** — Board the WinStar double-decker tour boat from the Baddeck wharf for a narrated cruise across the UNESCO Biosphere...
- Cabot Trail Scenic Drive** — Baddeck is the traditional gateway to the Cabot Trail, consistently ranked among North America's most scenic drives.
 - Kidston Island Ferry & Beach** — A short passenger ferry from the Baddeck wharf drops you on Kidston Island with a sandy beach, walking trails, and a...
 - Cape Breton Lobster Supper** — Nova Scotia lobster suppers are a regional institution.

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront & Village Loop** 1.5 km · 25-30 min · Easy — Start at the Baddeck public wharf and walk along the waterfront boardwalk toward the Bell Museum on Chebucto Street.
- Baddeck to Bell Estate Viewpoint** 1 km · 15 min · Easy — From the Bell Museum grounds, follow the lakeside path to the viewpoint overlooking Bras d'Or Lake and Bell's Beinn Bhreagh estate...

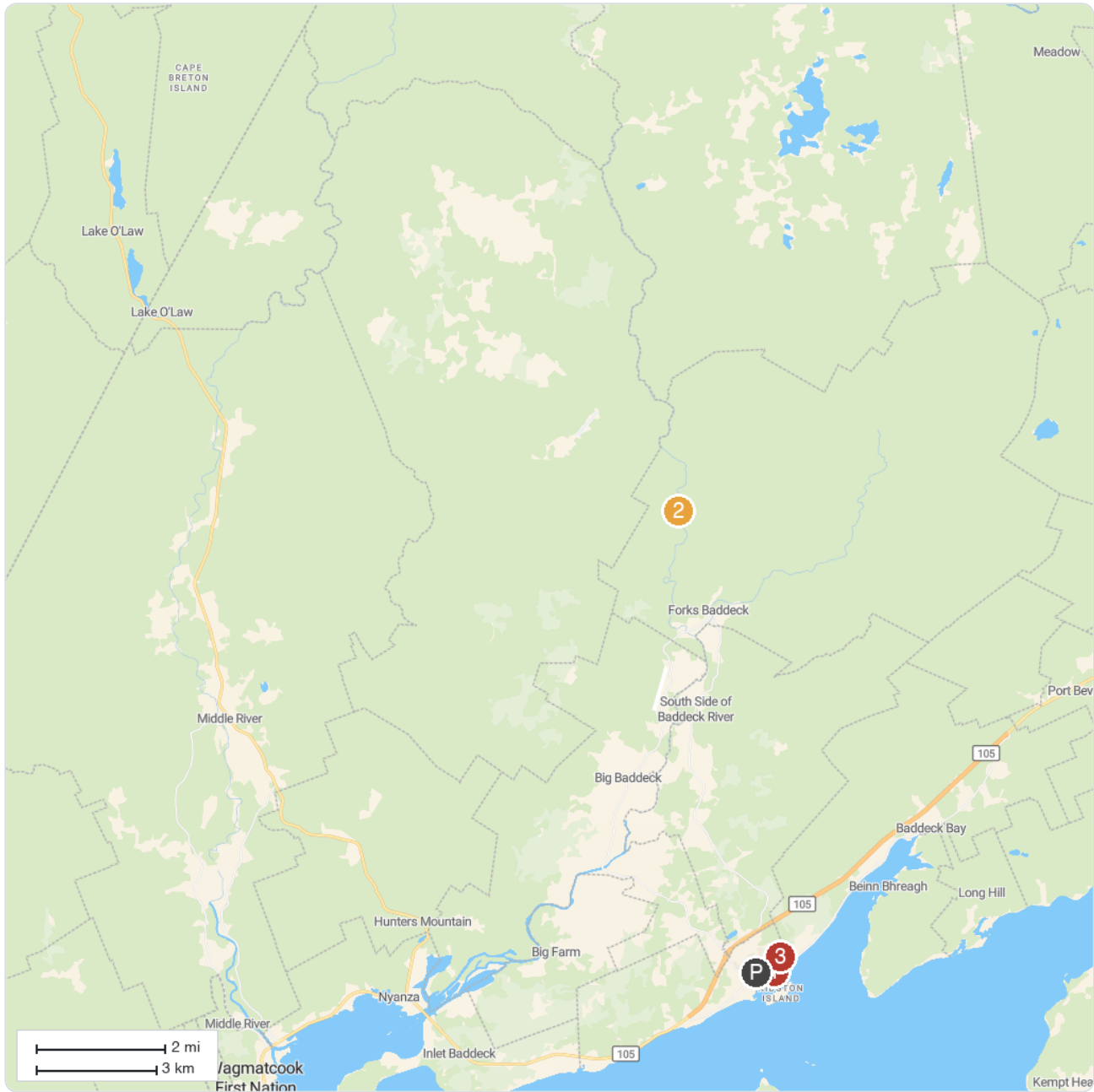
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
