GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Deep-water pier; ~1.5 km (20-min walk) to downtown. Free shuttle buses from terminal.

Best For: Whale watching, dam tours, Sainte-Amélie frescoes, boreal nature.

Walk to Center: 20 min along Pioneer Promenade; flat and easy.

Don't Miss: Sainte-Amélie Church — a vast ceiling fresco by Florentine-trained master Guido Nincheri.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **St. Lawrence Whale Watching** — The confluence of the St. Lawrence and Saguenay Rivers is a prime whale habitat. (2.5-hour drive).
- **Sainte-Amélie Church Fresco Tour** — This Baie-Comeau landmark is crowned by one of North America's largest church frescoes — a roughly 1,500 m² ceiling...
- **Manic-5 Daniel-Johnson Dam Tour** — The world's largest multiple-arch-and-buttress dam sits 214 km north of town
- **Boisé de la Pointe-St.-Gilles Park** — A 432-acre urban forest right in town with groomed and wild hiking trails.
- **Gardens of the Glaciers (Jardin des Glaciers)** — An immersive multimedia attraction retracing the last ice age — glacier simulations, geological exhibits, and the story...

BEST WALKS

- **Pioneer Promenade to Downtown** 1.5 km · 20 min · Flat — Follow the waterfront Pioneer Promenade from the cruise pier to Pioneer Park, then continue into downtown Baie-Comeau along Boulevard...
- **Church Walk: St. Andrew's to Sainte-Amélie** 1 km · 15 min · Flat — Start at St. Andrew's Church.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Take the free shuttle. The terminal is 1.5 km from downtown — the free shuttle bus saves the walk and drops you right at the action.
- Book whale watching early. St. Lawrence whale tours are the top excursion and sell out quickly in summer. Reserve before your cruise.
- Manic-5 is a full-day trip. The Daniel-Johnson Dam is 214 km away (2.5 hrs each way). Only do it if your ship offers an organised excursion.
