Docking: Semayang Port; cruise ships berth dockside, no tendering required

Best For: Orangutan & sun bear encounters, mangrove tours, beaches

Don't Miss: BOSF Samboja Lestari orangutan sanctuary (~1 hr from port)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Samboja Lestari Orangutan Sanctuary** — Visit the Borneo Orangutan Survival Foundation's Samboja Lestari site, about 1 hour from port, to see rescued...
- Bukit Bangkirai Canopy Bridge** — Swing across suspension bridges strung between 40-meter dipterocarp trees at Bukit Bangkirai eco-forest, about 1.5...
- Margomulyo Mangrove Center** — Explore the Margomulyo Mangrove Center on an 800-meter boardwalk and by boat through dense mangrove forest in West...
- Kemala Beach** — A popular city beach with pale sand, calm bay waters, and seaside warungs (food stalls) serving fresh grilled fish.
- Balikpapan City Highlights** — Hit the Monpera independence monument, stroll Taman Bekapai city park, and browse Pasar Klandasan wet market for local...

BEST WALKS

- Balikpapan Downtown Stroll** ~2 km · Flat · 45 min — From Taman Bekapai city park, walk along Jalan Ahmad Yani past the Monpera monument and toward Balikpapan Bay waterfront.

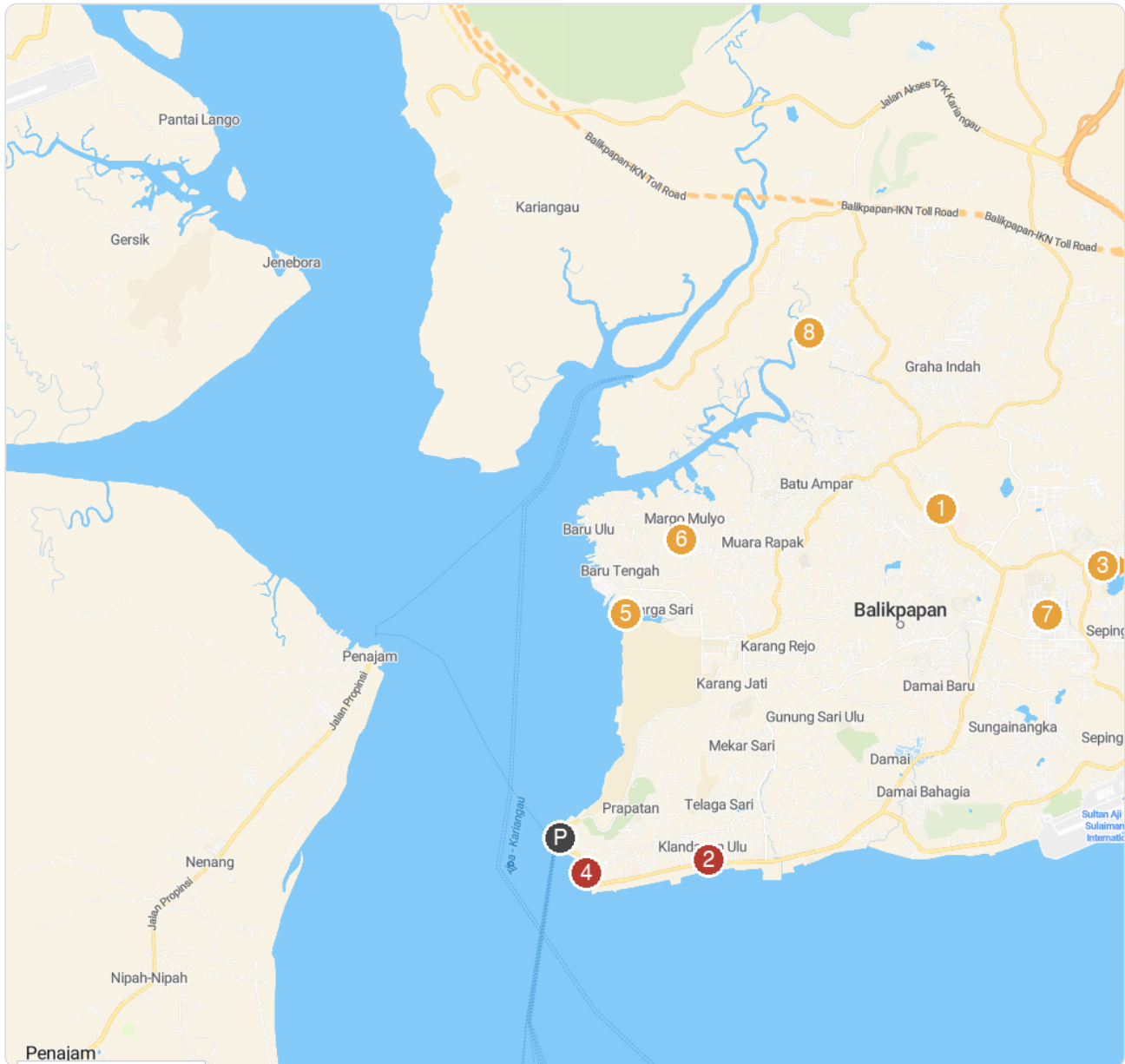
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
