- Cristo Luz Monument & City Views** — A towering Christ statue atop a hill illuminates the city at night, but daytime visits offer panoramic views over the...
- Oceanic Aquarium Balneário Camboriú** — One of Brazil's finest aquariums, with sharks, rays, penguins, and a range of Atlantic species.
- Beto Carrero World Theme Park** — Latin America's largest theme park sits about 30 km north near Penha.

BEST WALKS

- Avenida Atlântica Beachfront Stroll** 2-3 km | Easy | 30-45 min — Walk Balneário Camboriú's main seaside boulevard from the pier area along Praia Central's full length.
- Pontal Norte Pier & Skyline Views** 1 km | Easy | 20 min — Stroll out along Pontal Norte pier for the best full-skyline shot of Balneário Camboriú.

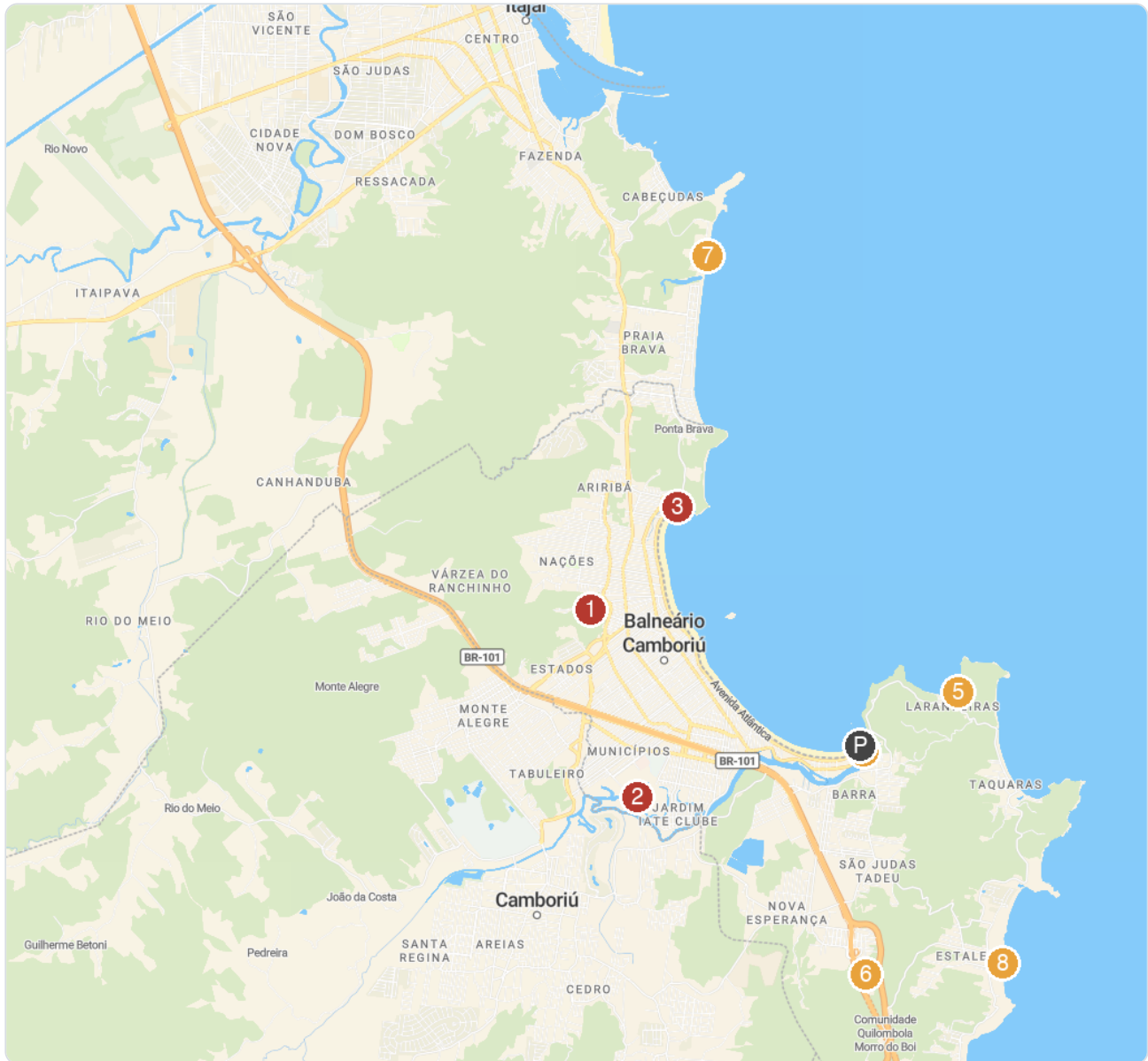
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry local cash. Street vendors, beach kiosks, and smaller cafés work in Brazilian reais; many don't take foreign cards. ATMs are available near the terminal and city center.
- Sun protection is non-negotiable. Balneário Camboriú sits in subtropical Santa Catarina — UV is intense even on cloudy days. Bring high-SPF sunscreen and a hat.
