Don't Miss: Fort McHenry, National Aquarium, Fells Point waterfront, crab cakes

- **Fort McHenry & the Star-Spangled Banner** — Tour the star-shaped fort that withstood British bombardment in 1814, inspiring Francis Scott Key to write the national...
- **National Aquarium** — One of the country's top aquariums, home to sharks, rays, dolphins, Australian lungfish, and over 17,000 animals across...
- **Washington D.C. Day Trip** — Baltimore's proximity to D.C.
- **Historic Ships in Baltimore** — Explore floating museums at the Inner Harbor: USS Constellation (Civil War sloop), USS Torsk (WWII submarine), the...
- **Fells Point Food & History Walk** — Baltimore's oldest neighborhood is a cobblestoned waterfront district packed with colonial-era taverns, independent...

BEST WALKS

- **Inner Harbor Waterfront Loop** 2 miles • Easy • 45–60 min — Circle the Inner Harbor from the Visitor Center at Light Street past the National Aquarium, Historic Ships, the Harborplace pavilions...
- **Inner Harbor to Fells Point Waterfront Promenade** 1.5 miles one-way • Easy • 30 min — Follow the paved Waterfront Promenade east from the Inner Harbor through Little Italy to Fells Point's Broadway Pier — a flat, scenic...

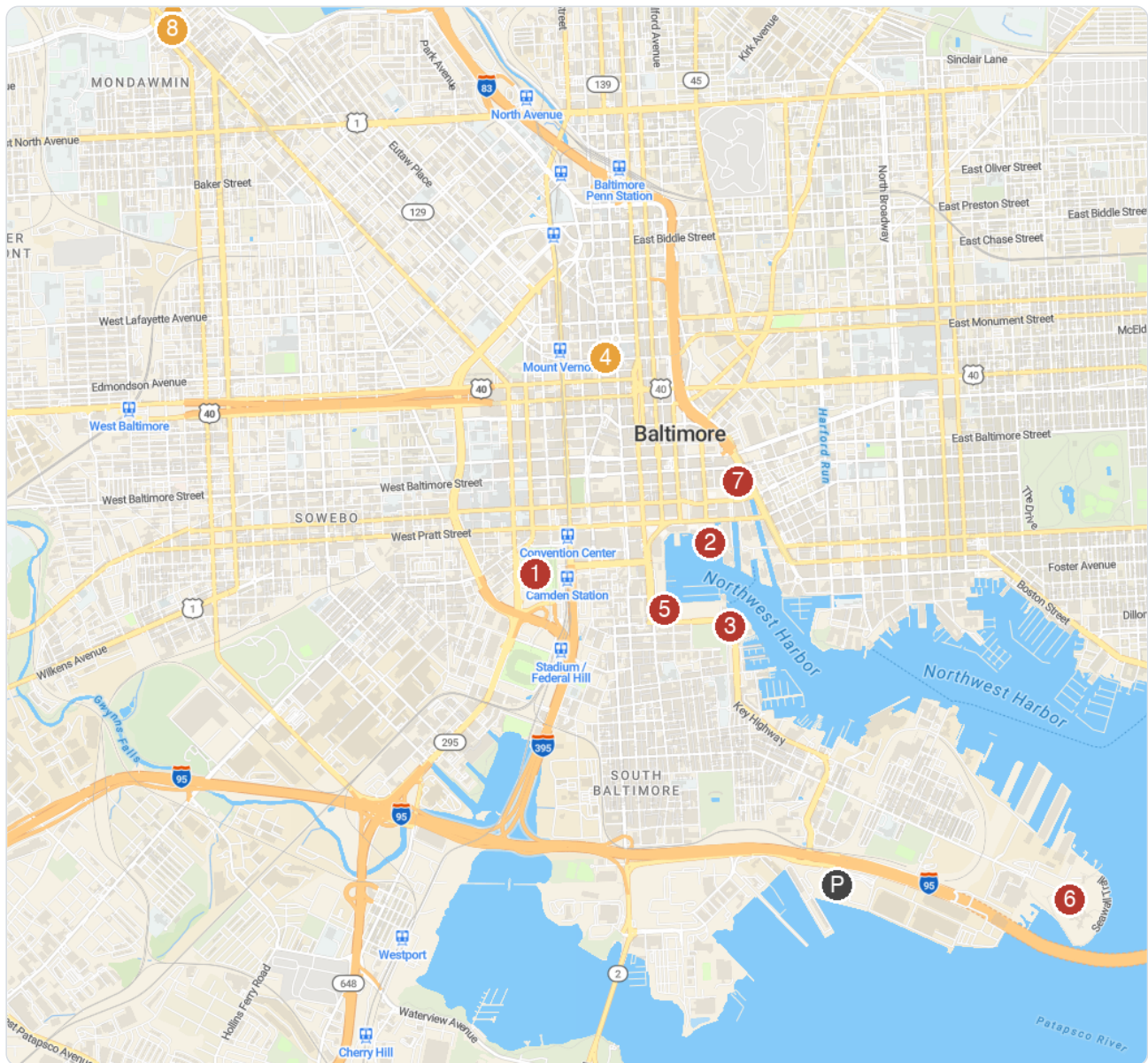
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use the Water Taxi. The Baltimore Water Taxi connects Inner Harbor, Fells Point, Federal Hill, and Fort McHenry for a flat daily fee much easier than rideshare for hopping...
