GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Muara Port, 28 km northeast of city — 30–40 min by taxi or shuttle

Walk to Center: Not walkable; taxis ~BND 20–25 or ship shuttle

Best For: Mosques, Kampong Ayer water village, wildlife river cruises

Don't Miss: Sultan Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque & proboscis monkey river safari

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Sultan Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque** — Brunei's most photographed landmark: Italian marble, a 52-metre golden dome, and a ceremonial stone boat moored in the... museum.
- **Kampong Ayer Water Village Tour** — Home to roughly 10,000 residents, this centuries-old stilt village on the Brunei River is the world's largest...
- **Proboscis Monkey River Safari** — Boat through the Brunei River mangroves at dusk to spot the bulbous-nosed proboscis monkeys — endemic to Borneo...
- **Royal Regalia Museum** — The Sultan's coronation chariot, bejewelled regalia, and gifts from world leaders fill this free
- **Ulu Temburong National Park** — Brunei's pristine rainforest reserve features a treetop canopy walk, suspension bridges, and jungle rivers.

BEST WALKS

- **City Centre Heritage Loop** 2 km · Easy · 1–1.5 hrs — A flat riverside stroll linking BSB's major landmarks.
- **Jame' Asr Mosque & Gadong Stroll** Easy · Best by taxi to mosque, then walk Gadong — Take a taxi 4 km north to the Jame' Asr Hassaniil Bolkiah Mosque — Brunei's largest, with 29 golden domes — then walk or taxi to the...

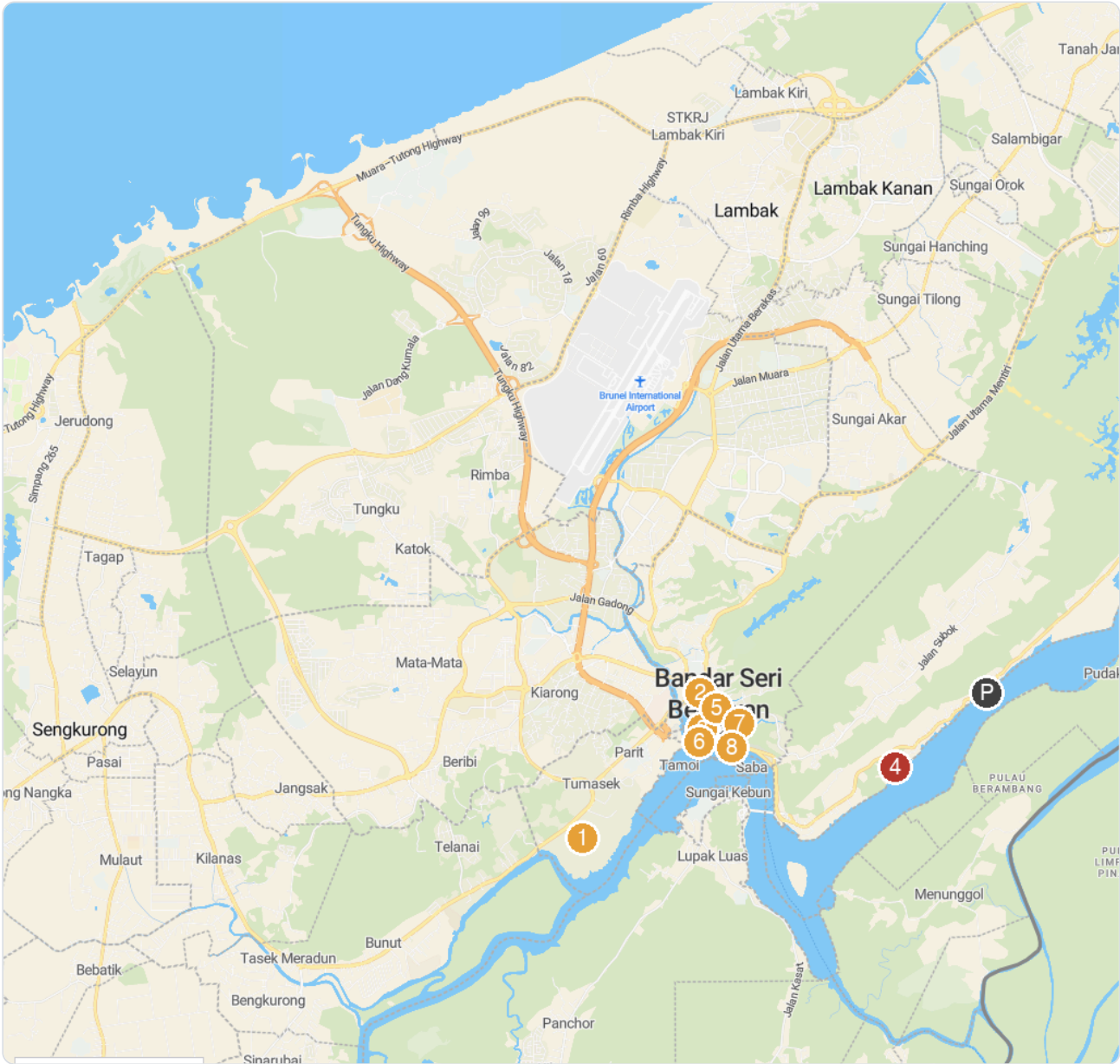
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Brunei Dollar = Singapore Dollar. ATMs at the port terminal and in BSB accept international cards. USD is rarely accepted; exchange or withdraw BND on arrival.
- Dress modestly for mosques. Long trousers/skirts and covered shoulders required. Scarves and robes are provided at the Sultan Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque.
