Docking: Eisenhower Pier — smaller ships berth pier-side; larger vessels may anchor and tender

Best For: Belfast day trips, Giant's Causeway, Titanic history, coastal walks

Walk to centre: 5–10 min from pier to Main Street and marina promenade

- **Titanic Belfast & Titanic Quarter** — The world's largest Titanic visitor experience, built on the slipway where RMS Titanic was constructed.
- **Giant's Causeway & Antrim Coast** — Northern Ireland's only UNESCO World Heritage Site — 40,000 interlocking basalt columns sculpted by ancient volcanism.
- **Belfast Black Cab & Murals Tour** — Private black cab tours cover the Peace Walls, Falls Road and Shankill Road murals, and the story of The Troubles in a...
- **Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge** — A rope bridge spanning a 20-metre chasm and suspended around 30 metres above the rocks, leading to a tiny island off...
- **Game of Thrones Studio Tour** — Located in Banbridge, less than an hour from Belfast, this immersive tour takes fans through original sets, props...

BEST WALKS

- **Pier to Pickie Seafront Stroll** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy · Flat — Walk from Eisenhower Pier along the marina promenade past the 'Pasty Supper' sculpture and the Guillemot Kitchen Café to Pickie Fun...
- **North Down Coastal Path to Groomsport** 4 km one way · 1 hr · Easy · Coastal — Head east from the pier along the North Down Coastal Path with views over Belfast Lough and the Scottish hills on clear days.
- **Town Centre & Bangor Castle Loop** 2 km · 30 min · Easy — From the pier walk up to Main Street, then into Castle Park to see Bangor Castle and the Walled Garden.

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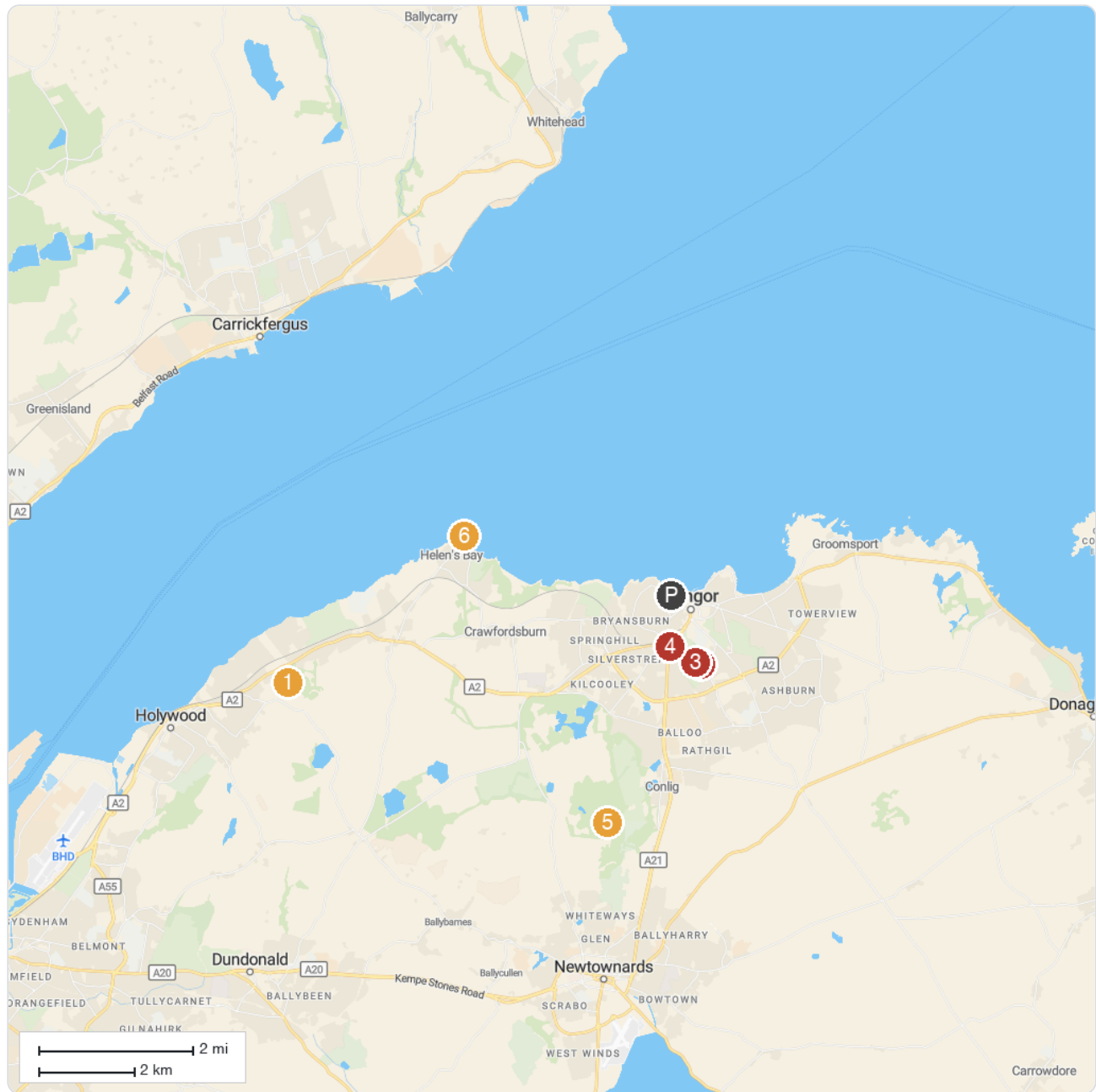
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Bangor, County Down, Northern Ireland — Port Map
