- **Kunta Kinteh Island & Juffureh** — A full-day Roots tour to the UNESCO-listed Kunta Kinteh Island and the village of Juffureh, birthplace of Kunta Kinteh.
 - **Kachikally Crocodile Pool** — Visit the sacred crocodile pool in nearby Bakau, home to dozens of West African crocodiles, plus a small museum and...

BEST WALKS

- **Local Seafood** Freshly caught fish and shellfish from the Atlantic — Try the local seafood, especially the grilled fish, at the waterfront eateries.
- **Domoda** Traditional Gambian peanut stew — A must-try dish, rich and savory, often served with rice.
- **Wonjo** Local Gambian beverage — A refreshing drink made from hibiscus flowers, often served chilled.

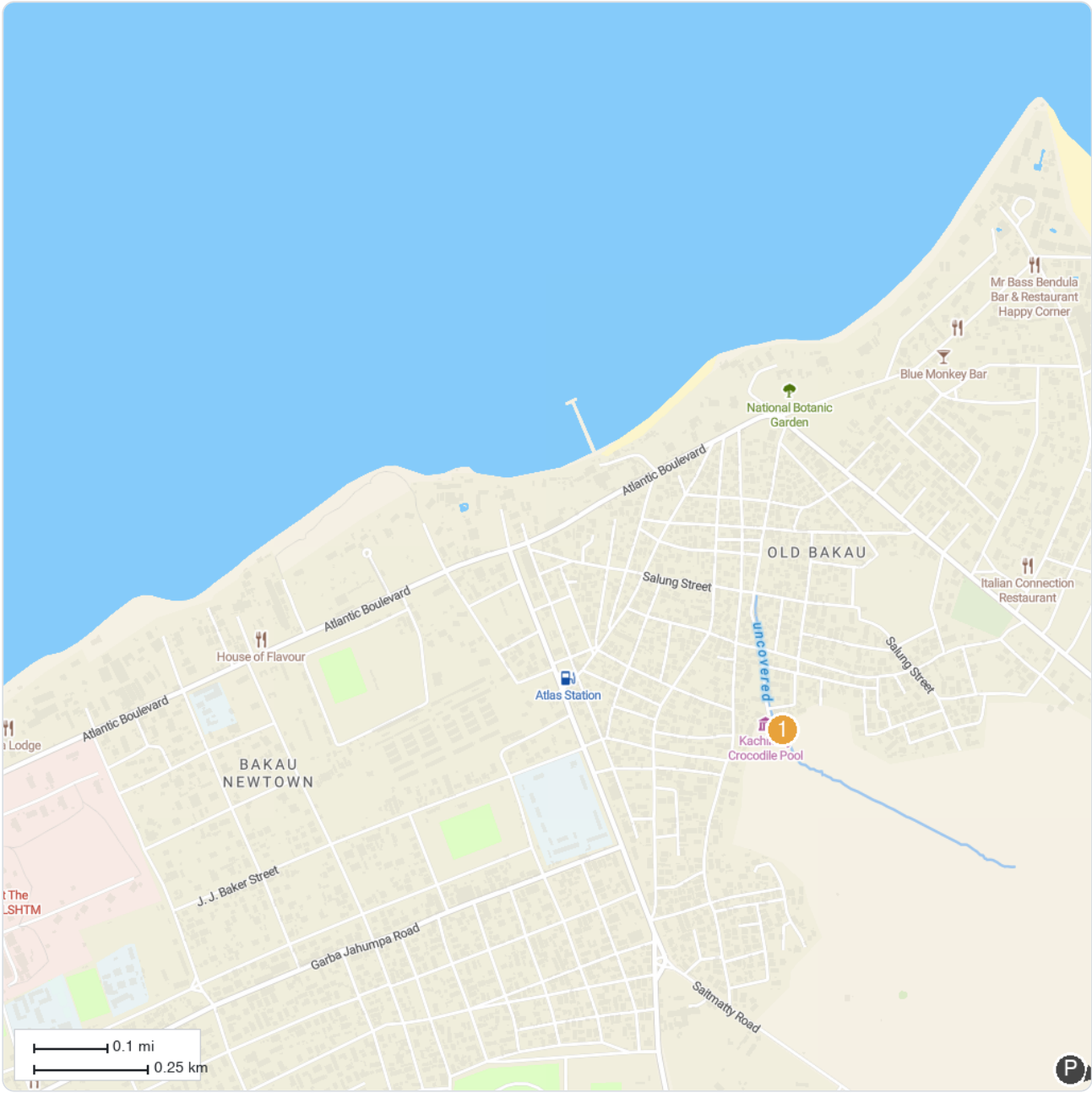
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
