Don't Miss: Cadillac Mountain sunrise/summit, Shore Path, Bar Island at low tide

- Acadia National Park & Cadillac Mountain** — Drive or shuttle the Park Loop Road to Thunder Hole, Sand Beach, and the summit of Cadillac Mountain — highest point on...
 - Whale Watching Cruise** — Head out into the Gulf of Maine with naturalist guides to spot humpbacks, finbacks, and minkes.
 - Carriage Road Biking** — Acadia's 45 miles of carriage roads are car-free and perfectly graded — rent bikes downtown and

 - Frenchman Bay Schooner Sail** — Board a traditional Maine windjammer schooner for a narrated sail around Frenchman Bay, with views of the Porcupine...
 - Abbe Museum & Downtown Walk** — The Abbe Museum on Mount Desert Street tells the story of Maine's Wabanaki people through impressive collections and...

BEST WALKS

- Shore Path** 1.5 miles round-trip · Easy · 30-45 min — Starting just east of Agamont Park, this paved coastal path hugs the rocky shoreline past Gilded Age summer cottages with constant...
- Bar Island at Low Tide** 1 mile round-trip · Easy · 1-1.5 hrs — At low tide, a natural gravel bar emerges from Bridge Street, letting you walk dry-shod to Bar Island.
- Downtown Bar Harbor Loop** 0.75 miles · Easy · 30 min — From the Town Pier, walk up Main Street past shops and restaurants, turn on Cottage Street to the Village Green, swing past the Abbe...

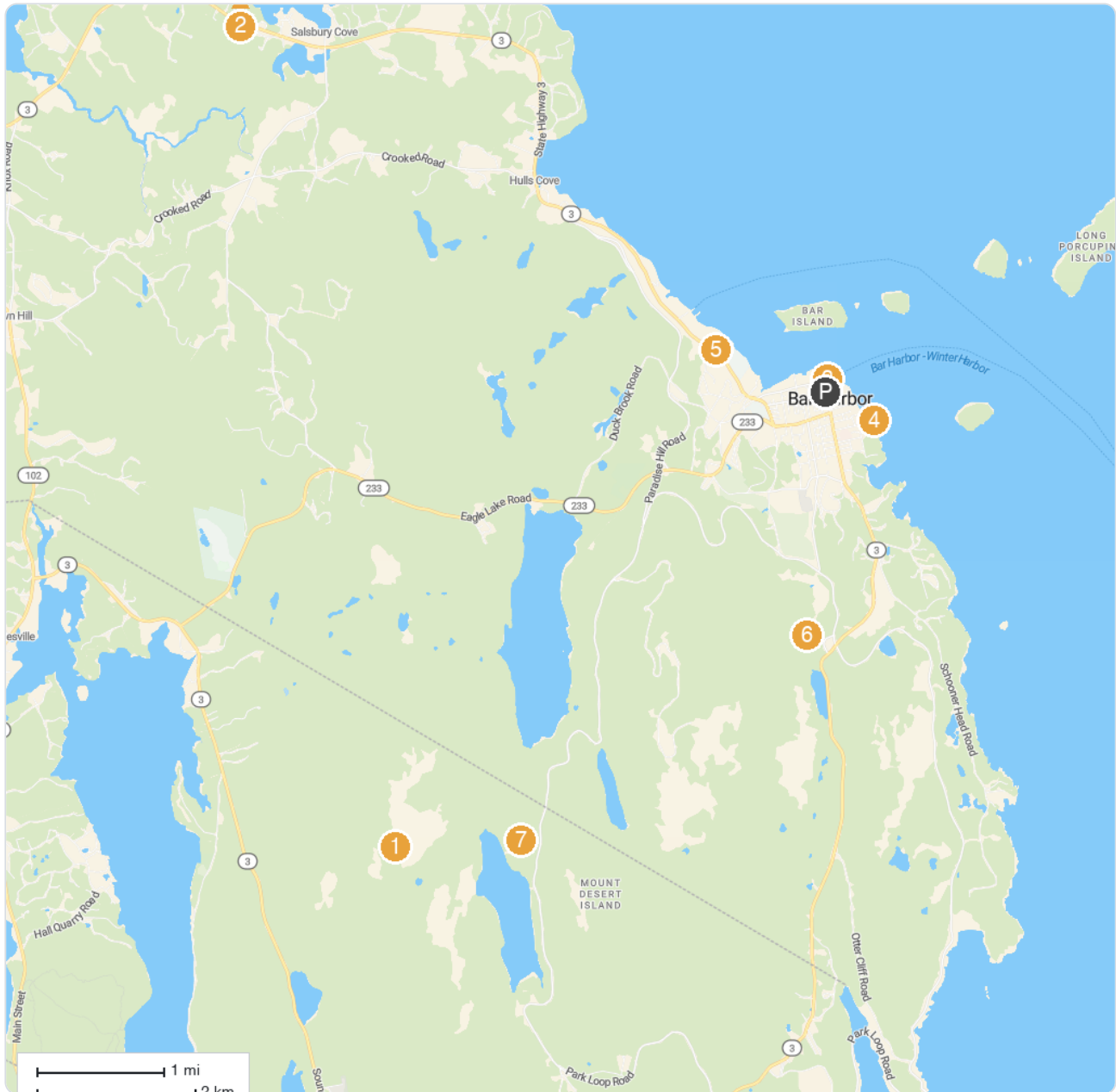
