GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships berth directly at Port of Adria; shuttle to city waterfront (~1.5 km)

Best For: History buffs, Lake Skadar birdwatching, Adriatic coast day-trips

Walk to center: Not walkable from berth — free port shuttle drops at King Nikola's Palace

Don't Miss: Stari Bar ruins and the 2,200-year-old Old Olive Tree nearby

Getting around: **Taxi** €4–€12 · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Stari Bar — Ancient Ruined Town** — Perched on a cliff 4 km from modern Bar, the abandoned medieval city of Stari Bar is Montenegro's most dramatic ruin.
- Lake Skadar National Park** — The largest lake in the Balkans sits 35 minutes from Bar by car or train.
- King Nikola's Palace & Waterfront** — Walking distance from the shuttle drop-off, this late-19th-century royal palace (now a museum) offers a look at...
- Budva Old Town** — Montenegro's most photogenic medieval town sits about 40 km north of Bar (1 hr by taxi/tour).
- Ulcinj — Ancient Pirate Town** — Just 30 km south, Ulcinj was a notorious pirate stronghold and later an Ottoman garrison.

BEST WALKS

- Bar Waterfront Promenade** 1.5 km one-way · Flat · 20-30 min — From the shuttle drop-off at King Nikola's Palace, walk south along the palm-lined promenade past the Bar Marina.
- Stari Bar Ruins Walk** Self-guided within ruins · Easy-Moderate · 1-2 hrs — Once you taxi to Stari Bar (€5–8), explore the 16-hectare ruined town on your own.

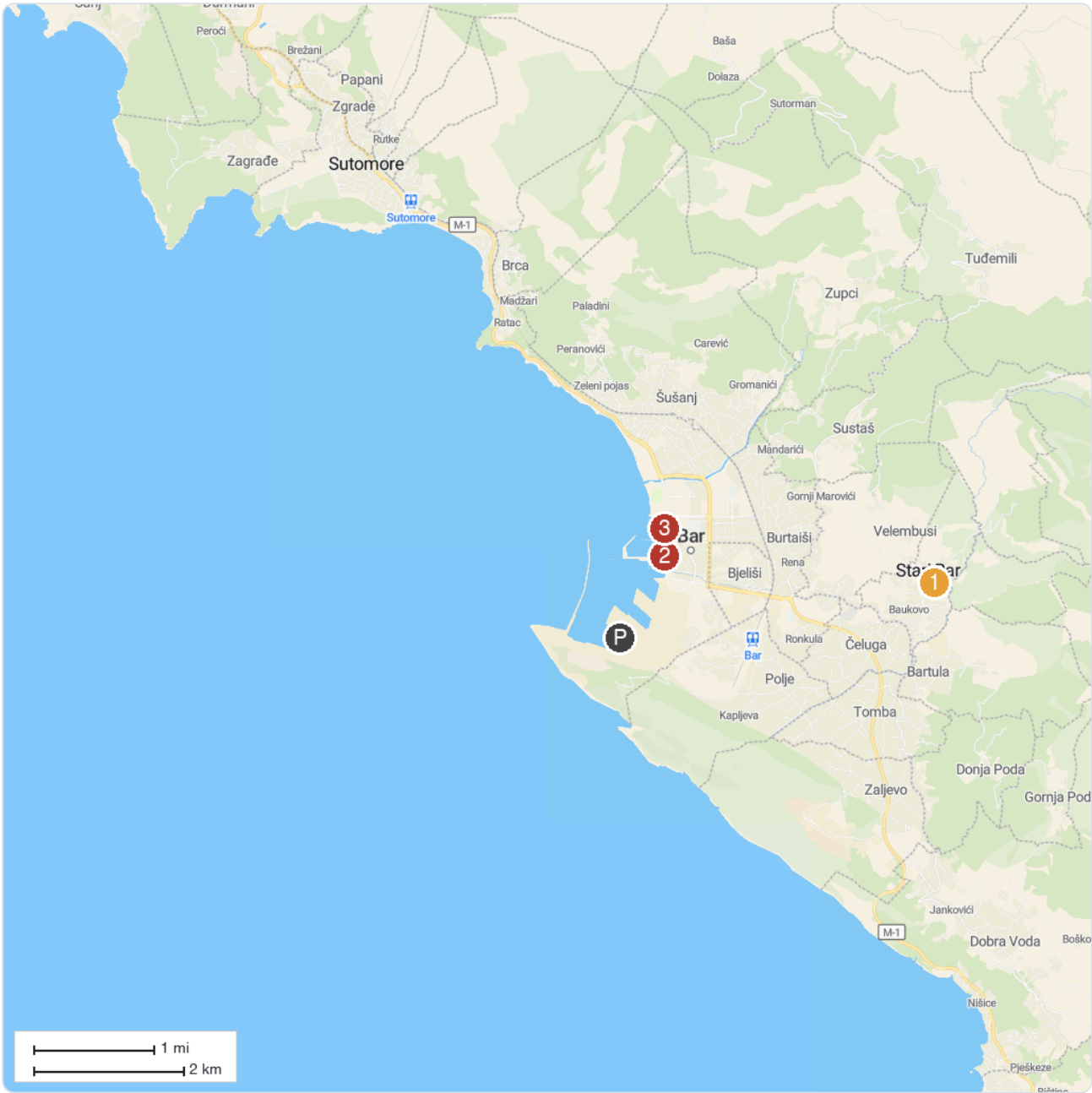

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Take the free port shuttle. You cannot walk from the cruise berth to town — the industrial port area restricts pedestrian access. The shuttle drops you right by King Nikola's...
- Taxis are your friend. Agree on a fare upfront. Stari Bar is around €5-8 each way. For Budva or Kotor, budget €25-35 one-way —
